ALBUQUERQUE SWEEPS ZEPHYRS WITH 5-3 WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes used a quintet of pitchers to hold the New Orleans Zephyrs to three runs in a 5-3 'Topes win Monday afternoon at Isotopes Park. Starter Eric Milton tossed two scoreless frames before handing things over to Albuquerque's bullpen, which was superb, allowing three runs on four hits throughout the remaining seven innings. Meanwhile, the Isotopes' offense kicked into gear right out of the gate, scoring a run in the bottom of the first when Jason Repko led off with a triple and scored on a base hit by Hector Luna to make the score 1-0 'Topes. Albuquerque would add a pair of additional runs in the second when A.J. Ellis led off with a walk, advanced to second on a sacrifice by the pitcher Milton, and raced home on a single by Repko to increase the lead to 2-0. Luis Maza then slapped a triple that scored Repko from first and gave the 'Topes a 3-0 lead. New Orleans would rally in the third off of Albuquerque reliever Nick DeBarr as Dave Matranga lined the second pitch of the inning over the centerfield wall before Michael Ryan laced a two-out, two-run single to tie the game at 3-3. The Isotopes would surge ahead in the fourth thanks to yet another three-bagger, this time off the bat of Danny Ardoin, who trotted home two batters later on a Repko single to give Albuquerque a 4-3 lead. Dee Brown would then chip in an RBI double in the fifth to score Blake DeWitt and give the 'Topes a 5-3 edge. That was enough for the Isotopes' pen, who shut down the Z's the rest of the way. DeBarr settled down to get the win after three innings in which he allowed the three runs on three hits before Brian Mazzone added two scoreless innings in which he allowed just one hit. Dwayne Pollok then tossed a perfect eighth before Scott Strickland closed the door with a one-two-three ninth to earn his third save in as many days.

CHARLES IN CHARGE: Right-hander Charlie Haeger takes the mound riding a two game winning streak and hoping to continue a team winning streak that he kick-started on May 6. After the Isotopes had lost four straight games, Haeger took the mound in Oklahoma City and threw 5.2 solid frames, allowing three runs on six hits while walking five and fanning three in a 9-3 Albuquerque win. The Isotopes haven't lost since. That triumph came on the heels of the knuckleballer's complete-game masterpiece on April 30 vs. Round Rock. After posting an ERA of 8.44 in his first four starts, Haeger has racked up an earned run average of 2.53 (4 ER / 14.2) in his last two outings.

LOOKING FOR LUCKY SEVEN: With six straight wins, the Isotopes continue to boast the Pacific Coast League's longest current streak, and are just three wins from tying the franchise record of nine straight victories set in 2006. The current streak is also the longest by any team in the Pacific Coast League so far this season, surpassing the five game winning streaks achieved by Fresno, Nashville, Round Rock, and Salt Lake at different points this year.

RIVER CATS REDUX: Albuquerque today begins a four game series against the Sacramento River Cats at Raley Field, a place the Isotopes haven't visited since 2007. While the overall series between the two teams is pretty even (Sacramento leads 13-11 all-time), Albuquerque has won three of its last four meetings against the Cats after the 'Topes won three of a four-game set at Isotopes Park last year. The converse was true the last time Albuquerque visited Raley Field, as the River Cats took three of four from the 'Topes in 2007. Albuquerque is 5-7 all-time in Sacramento.

INTER-CONFERENCE PLAY BEGINS!: Tonight is the first of 16 straight games the Isotopes will play against teams from the PCL's Pacific Conference with games forthcoming at Sacramento and at Fresno before the team returns to Albuquerque to take on Salt Lake and Colorado Springs in what will be the 'Topes' only meeting with those clubs all year. The Isotopes will play Portland, Tacoma, Las Vegas, and Reno in August. Last year, the 'Topes were 14-18 against teams from the Pacific Conference.

A TOUGH LOSS: Isotopes outfielder Jason Repko strained his left hamstring making a running play on a ball hit to centerfield and has been placed on the Disabled List, a huge loss for the Albuquerque offense as Repko had hit in a team-high 11 straight games before getting hurt. In that span, Repko batted .422 (19x45) with 12 runs, three doubles, two triples, four homers, and 14 RBI. Taking Repko's slot will be outfielder Jamie Hoffmann, who arrives from Double-A Chattanooga, where he batted .307 (31x101) with 25 runs, nine doubles, two triples, two homers, and 16 RBI in 29 games.

TODAY'S START: Charlie Haeger takes the mound riding a two-game winning streak after getting the win in his last start at Oklahoma City on May 6 when he allowed three runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking five and striking out three in a 9-3 Isotopes win. Tossed a complete game gem on April 30 vs. Round Rock in which he allowed two runs, one earned, on six hits while walking two and striking out five in a 6-2 Isotopes win. The performance was the first complete game thrown by an Isotopes pitcher this season, the first nine-inning complete game in the PCL this year, and the eighth nine-inning complete game thrown at Isotopes Park in team history. Endured his second defeat of the season on April 22 at Iowa when he allowed six runs on six hits (including three homers) with one walk and six strikeouts. Had a solid outing on April 17 at Omaha in which he got the victory after allowing just two runs on five hits in a season-high six innings while striking out three, but walking a team-high seven in an 8-4 'Topes triumph. On April 12, he suffered his first defeat after allowing seven runs on 11 hits in four-plus innings while walking four and striking out one in a 10-4 loss to Omaha at Isotopes Park.

2008: Spent most of the season with Triple-A Charlotte in the Chicago White Sox organization, going 10-13 with a 4.45 ERA in 28 games (25 starts)... struck out 117 batters while walking 77... led the International League in complete games (3) and innings-pitched (178.0)... went 3-2 with a 2.76 ERA in five games (three starts) in June, holding the opposition to a .221 average in that month... in his last start for Charlotte on September 1 vs. Durham, tossed a nine-inning complete-game in which he allowed one run on six hits while striking out a season-high-tying seven and not walking a batter... designated for assignment on September 6 and was claimed off waivers by the San Diego Padres on September 10... appeared in four games for San Diego, giving up eight earned runs in 4.1 innings (16.62 ERA).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Appeared in eight games with the Chicago White Sox in 2007, posting a 7.15 ERA (9 ER/11.1 IP)... was recalled from Triple-A Charlotte on July 12 and made his debut on July 14 at Baltimore (1 ER/0.2 IP)... went 5.0 scoreless innings over three appearances from July 17-21... recorded a 12.71 ERA (8 ER/5.2 IP) over his last four appearances from July 22-August 1 before being optioned to Charlotte... began the season with the Knights... went 5-16 with a 4.08 ERA (67 ER/167.2 IP) in 24 appearances (23 starts) with Charlotte... posted a 6.19 ERA (47 ER/68.1 IP) with 57 strikeouts over his first 12 starts, compared to a 2.27 ERA (20 ER/79.1 IP) with 69 strikeouts over his final 12 appearances (11 starts)... led the International League in losses and tied for second in complete games (three)... struck out a season-best 10 batters in a loss on June 29 at Syracuse... allowed one earned run in three of his final four starts.

In 2006, was 14-6 with a 3.07 ERA (58 ER/170.0 IP) in 26 games (25 starts) with Triple-A Charlotte... led the International League in wins and ranked fourth in ERA, strikeouts (130) and IP... Threw 15 wild pitches... was the starting pitcher at the Triple-A All-Star Game, tossing 2.0 perfect IP... went 1-1 with a 3.44 ERA (7 ER/18.1 IP) and one save in seven games (one start) over two stints with the White Sox.

Combined to go 14-5 with a 3.50 ERA (65 ER/167.1 IP) and 112 strikeouts in 27 games (26 starts) between Single-A Winston-Salem (A) and Double-A Birmingham in 2005... led all Sox farmhands in victories and IP, ranked fifth in strikeouts and sixth in ERA... began the season at Winston-Salem, where he went 8-2 with a 3.20 ERA (29 ER/81.2 IP) in 14 games (13 starts)... was named to the Carolina midseason All-Star team... tied for the Southern League lead in complete games (three) and shutouts (two).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Charles Wallis Haeger... graduated in 2001 from Catholic Central High School in Plymouth, MI... was named to All-Catholic Team as a senior after going 7-2 with a 1.88 ERA and 101 strikeouts... hit .364 (36x99) with 34 RBI... was the winning pitcher in the state championship game as a sophomore... brother Greg played in Detroit Tigers organization and is currently the baseball coach at Madonna University in Livonia, MI... refined his knuckleball with Dodger great and current Inland Empire coach Charlie Hough in 2006.
