**'TOPES SWEEP TWIN-BILL FROM SOUNDS** The Albuquerque Isotopes used excellent pitching performances to propel them to a doubleheader sweep of the Nashville Sounds 4-1, 2-1 Sunday night at Greer Stadium. Charlie Haeger set the tone of the night, allowing just one hit in six innings while giving up a single unearned run, walking three, and striking out eight to claim his 11th win of the season. The 'Topes leaped out to a quick lead in support of Haeger, scoring a pair of runs in the first on a two-run single by Jamie Hoffmann to take a 2-0 advantage. The Sounds responded with a run in the third when pitcher Sam Narron reached second on a throwing error by Hector Luna and scored on a double by Johnny Raburn, the only hit of the contest, but the 'Topes answered with a run in the fifth. Mitch Jones chased home a run with a bases loaded walk to give Albuquerque a 3-1 lead before the Isotopes scored once more in the sixth when Luna aggressively took home on a sacrifice by Haeger to put the 'Topes up 4-1. Scott Strickland sealed the game-one victory with a perfect ninth to claim his 23rd save of the year. In the night-cap, Henry Bonilla continued the pitching prowess in a spot-start, allowing a first inning run before tossing three shutout frames. After Albuquerque tied the game on a sacrifice fly by A.J. Ellis in the second, the Isotopes bullpen took over, with Josh Lindblom, Brent Leach, and Francisco Felix each tossing a shutout frame to send the game into an extra inning. With runners on second and third and one out, Blake DeWitt lifted a sacrifice fly that scored Sergio Garcia with the go-ahead run 2-1. Strickland again was pressed into duty in the bottom of the eighth and, after giving up a pair of two-out walks, surrendered a base hit to Mat Gamel, but Hoffmann picked up the base hit in right and fired a laser to the plate, catching Joe Koshansky trying to score and ending the contest.

**POLLOK ON THE SPOT:** One day after Henry Bonilla made his third spot-start of the season, Dwayne Pollok will make his third start of 2009 and his first away from Isotopes Park. The right-hander takes the mound after a solid outing of relief on July 29 when he tossed a season-high 4.2 innings in which he gave up two runs on four hits while walking none and striking out three in a 6-2 defeat to the Oklahoma City RedHawks. The solid outing against the 'Hawks helped put a stop to a pair of appearances in which Pollok surrendered five runs apiece. After yielding five runs on four hits in two innings in his last start on July 19 vs. New Orleans, the righty allowed five runs on five hits in just an inning and a third on July 24 vs. Iowa. In fact, Pollok hopes to turn the page on what has been a tough July. In five appearances in the month, he gave up 13 ER in 11.1 innings (10.32 ERA) while in the three previous months combined, he'd given up 24 earned runs.

**SUPER STRICK:** Closer Scott Strickland continues to be nearly automatic out of the bullpen, racking up a team-record 24 saves, which surpasses the previous mark of 23 set by Brad Clontz in 2006. With 35 games remaining, the Pacific Coast League record of 33 saves, set by Ryan Speier of Colorado Springs in 2007 is definitely in jeopardy. Last night, Strickland joined Toby Borland as the only Isotopes to record two saves in the same day as part of a doubleheader sweep, with Borland achieving the feat on April 26, 2004.

**WELCOME BACK:** The Isotopes today welcomed back a familiar face with the arrival of relief pitcher Harvey Garcia, who is the player to be named in a trade between the Pirates and Dodgers for outfielder Delwyn Young on April 15. The last time 'Topes fans saw Garcia was 2007 when he went 4-1 with a 6.19 ERA for Albuquerque before making his Major League debut as a September call-up. Last year, Garcia sat out the entire season after undergoing rotator cuff surgery and, although healthy, was released by the Marlins in Spring Training of this year. On June 23, he was signed to a Minor League contract by the Pirates and appeared in two games for the GCL Pirates and 10 for Single-A Lynchburg, going a combined 1-0 with a save and a 3.60 ERA (6 ER / 15.1 IP).

**NEXT HOMESTAND NEAR:** This Wednesday, the Isotopes return home for an action-packed eight game homestand against the Portland Beavers and Tacoma Rainiers. The fun kicks off with an appearance by Birdzerk! on Friday before an Orbit Bank Giveaway on Saturday. Don't forget Saturday is also the team's second and final Youth Skills Clinic!

**TODAY'S START:** Dwayne Pollok makes a spot-start, his third of the season, after spending most of the season in the bullpen. In his last start, on July 19 vs. New Orleans, allowed five runs on four hits in two innings while walking two and striking out two. Pitched a season-high 4.2 innings in his last outing on July 29 vs. Oklahoma City, allowing two runs on four hits while striking out three in a 6-2 loss to the RedHawks.

Suffered losses in back-to-back appearances on June 19 and June 24. Took a defeat in his first start of the season on June 19 vs. Omaha, his first start since he made eight in a row for Las Vegas from May 25 to July 5, 2008.

In 26 appearances out of the bullpen this season, is 2-3 with a 5.63 ERA (29 ER / 46.1 IP).

Suffered the loss in his first decision on May 17 at Fresno, allowing four runs on four hits in two-thirds of an inning in a 6-3 walk-off win for the Grizzlies. Earned his first win of the year on May 23 vs. Salt Lake after pitching a then season-high 3.1 innings in which he allowed just one hit while fanning three. Three nights later, won his second game of the year vs. Colorado Springs after tossing a scoreless 10th in a 10-7 walk-off win for the "Topes."

**2008:** Spent entire season at Triple-A Las Vegas, where he posted a 10-5 record with a 4.61 ERA and four saves in 40 appearances (eight starts)... earned Most Valuable Pitcher honors as voted by the 51s' coaching staff... was second on the club and fifth in the Pacific Coast League in victories... logged a career-high 105.1 innings and struck out a career-high 63... went 7-2 with four saves and a 3.69 ERA in 32 games out of the bullpen while going 3-3 with a 6.00 ERA in eight starts... struck out 35 while walking nine as a reliever... was dominant in April, posting a perfect 2-0 record with a save and a 1.93 ERA in nine appearances... fanned 14 and walked just one in 23.1 innings-pitched in the month... moved to the rotation on May 25 and made all eight of his starts in succession between May 25 and July 5... allowed two hits and an unearned run in five innings of work en route to a win in his first start on May 25 vs. Fresno... returned to the bullpen on July 10 and finished the year pitching in relief... at the plate, collected four hits in 21 at-bats (.190 average) including two doubles.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** In 2007 he saw action in two different Triple-A leagues and two different organizations, splitting his season between Triple-A Charlotte in the Chicago White Sox chain and Las Vegas... started the season in Charlotte, where he went 1-1 with a 3.33 ERA and one save in 18 games (one start)... traded to Dodgers on May 26 for infielder Tomas Perez and assigned to 51s, for whom he went 1-2 with a 5.71 ERA and one save in 28 games (five starts)... picked up his only PCL save on June 16 at Sacramento after tossing three scoreless innings... earned his only victory for Las Vegas on August 7 after three innings of relief at Iowa.

During the 2006 season he played the entire season at Double-A Birmingham in the White Sox organization, going 4-5 with a 3.16 ERA... was second on his club and tied for third in the Southern League in appearances with 54... did not give up a run in his first eight appearances (10.1 innings) to start the season... posted a 1.61 ERA and 1-1 record with a save in 12 appearances in the month of May... allowed just 10 of 35 inherited runners score.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Dwayne J. Pollok... graduated from East Central (Texas) High School... lettered in baseball three years and earned All-State honors his senior season... played collegiately at Texas A&M.
