SEVENTH INNING RALLY HELPS 'TOPES DERAILED EXPRESS 6-4: The Albuquerque Isotopes erupted for five runs in the seventh inning to surge past the Round Rock Express 6-4 Monday night at Isotopes Park. Trailing 4-1 in the bottom of the bottom of the seventh, Jamie Hoffmann ignited a rally by drawing a lead-off walk and scampering into third on a double by Jason Repko. After A.J. Ellis walked to load the bases, pinch-hitter Mitch Jones roped a two-run double that kissed the third base line, trimming the lead to 4-3. A wild pitch then scored Ellis from third and moved Jones 90 feet closer for Tony Abreu, who lifted a sacrifice fly to right, scoring Jones and giving Albuquerque a 5-4 edge. Chin-Lung Hu then roped a double and scored on a double by Hector Luna, the fourth two-bagger of the inning, to put the Isotopes ahead 6-4. That was all the 'Topes bullpen would need as Brent Leach fired a scoreless eighth before the closer Scott Strickland nailed down his League-leading 32nd save with a perfect ninth. Prior to the seventh-inning uprising, the Isotopes were stymied by Express pitchers Billy Sadler and Andy Van Hekken, who held Albuquerque to just one run through six innings. Round Rock built a lead with two in the top of the second before the 'Topes answered with a run in the bottom of the third when Ellis walked, advanced to second on a single by Abreu and scored on a base hit by Hu to cut the lead to 2-1. The Express would bolster the lead to three in the sixth courtesy of a two run homer by Mark Saccomanno that lifted Round Rock to a short-lived 4-1 advantage.

DURBIN'S TURN: The 'Topes take the field tonight behind right-hander J.D. Durbin who is looking to break a five-game losing streak and earn his first victory as an Isotope this season. After his last defeat at Reno on August 21, the right-hander spent a week on the disabled list with a right ankle sprain before making a relief appearance in a loss against Memphis on August 29. The five-game skid is the longest by an Albuquerque pitcher since Bobby Keppel lost five in a row from June 27 to July 25 last year. The longest losing streak by an Isotopes pitcher in team history is seven, set by Sean Bergman in 2003. The right-hander has pitched better than his record indicates, however, especially at home. Durbin has allowed just one home run in 17 innings of work at Isotopes Park in his last start at The Lab on August 9 vs. Tacoma, he cruised through seven innings before things unraveled in the eighth in a 6-4 defeat.

HOME SWEET HOME: With their comeback triumph last night, the Isotopes have tied a team record for home victories with 41 with three home games still to be played. Albuquerque won 41 games at The Lab in both 2005 and 2007. The 'Topes are also threatening the team record for total wins in a season. At 76 triumphs heading into tonight, the Isotopes need two wins in their next seven games to tie the team record of 78 wins in a season set in 2005.

HECTOR SPECTRE: Hector Luna has quietly racked up a hit in 12 of his last 13 home games, a span in which he's batted .360 (18x50). On this current 13-game homestand, Luna is batting .400 (14x35) with seven runs, two doubles, three homers, and 10 RBI in nine games.

GETTING THE CALL: As part of Major League active rosters expanding to 40 players, the Dodgers have called up catcher A.J. Ellis, left-handed pitcher Scott Elbert, and outfielder Jason Repko. While Ellis and Elbert have bounced back and forth between Albuquerque and L.A., this will be Repko's first trip back to the Big Leagues since he was a September call-up last season.

EXPRESS LANE: Last night's win over Round Rock was the Isotopes' fourth in a row against their division rival and their sixth win against the Express in their last seven games. Albuquerque's longest winning streak against Round Rock is seven, set from April 27 to August 25, 2007.

TODAY'S START: J.D. Durbin makes the start trying to snap a five-game losing streak, the longest by an Isotopes pitcher this season. This will be the right-hander's first start since a short turn on the Disabled List from August 22 to August 29 while recovering from a right ankle sprain. Took his fifth consecutive defeat on August 21 at Reno, giving up five runs on four hits in 3.1 innings in a 7-3 Isotopes defeat. Pitched a season-high seven-plus innings on August 9 vs. Tacoma, in which he cruised through seven innings before giving up three runs in the eighth in a 6-4 'Topes loss. Suffered his second loss of the season when he allowed four runs, three earned, (all of them in the first inning) while walking six and striking out two in an 11-2 loss to Iowa on July 25 at Isotopes Park. Had a solid outing in his 'Topes debut on July 20 at Round Rock, suffering the loss after allowing three runs on seven hits in six innings while walking two and striking out three. Spent most of the season with Double-A Chattanooga, where he split time between the rotation and the bullpen, going 2-3 with a 2.05 ERA and three saves.

Spent most of the season working out of the bullpen, going 0-1 with three saves and a 1.66 ERA in 15 games. Saved his first game of the season on May 12 at Huntsville, beginning a streak of three straight saves from May 12 to May 19.

Made a spot-start on May 23 at Carolina, suffering the loss after allowing a run on three hits in four innings of work while walking one and striking out three in an eventual 10-3 loss, Durbin's first defeat of the season.

Moved into the rotation on June 28 and made four straight starts, going 2-1 with a 2.33 ERA (7 ER / 27.0 IP). Was 2-2 with a 2.32 (8 ER / 31.0 IP) in five total starts with the Lookouts. Earned his first win of the season in a start on July 3 vs. Carolina, allowing two runs on five hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 Chattanooga win. Pitched eight shutout innings at Carolina on July 15, walking none and striking out three to earn his second win of the year.

Transferred to Albuquerque on July 17.

2008: Split season between Triple-A Lehigh Valley and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization, going a combined 5-14 with a 5.81 ERA in 34 total appearances (21 starts) between both levels. Started the year in the Lehigh Valley rotation and suffered defeats in each of his first starts from April 6 to April 26... moved to the bullpen and made four more appearances before being transferred to Reading... pitched mostly out of Reading's rotation, going 5-7 with a 4.31 ERA (45 ER / 94.0 IP) in 19 games (15 starts)... won four straight starts from June 28 to July 13... transferred back to Lehigh Valley for six more appearances in the bullpen from August 1 to August 17 before finishing the season in Reading... went a total of 0-7 with a 9.75 ERA (39 ER / 36.0 IP) in 15 games (six starts) between his two stints in Lehigh Valley.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the 2007 in the Arizona, Boston, and Philadelphia organizations, seeing Big League time with the Diamondbacks and Phillies... finished eighth among National League rookies with six wins and was the only MLB pitcher with both a shutout and a save... claimed off waivers by Arizona on March 3 and appeared in one game before being designated for assignment on April 5... claimed off waivers by Boston on April 9 but was designated for assignment the next day... claimed by the Phillies on April 10 and designated for a third time on April 6 and out-righted to Triple-A Ottawa... allowed three earned runs or less in eight of his 10 starts with Lynx and posted a 3.38 ERA in his final four starts... had contract purchased by Phillies on June 29 and started that day in the first game of a doubleheader vs. New York (NL)... made three relief appearances following the start before being moved back into the rotation... earned his first professional shutout on July 22 at San Diego, allowing five hit in nine innings while walking two and striking out five... earned his first Major League save on August 7 vs. Florida after firing three shutout innings.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Joseph Adam Durbin... has one daughter, Skylar Adalynn (10/18/07)... was a 2000 graduate of Coronado High School (AZ) where he played football and baseball... 2000 Arizona High School Player of the Year... named to Arizona All-State teams in baseball and football in 2000.
