### ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (79-63) AT IOWA CUBS (71-71)

**CORCORAN, ISOTOPES CLUB CUBS 8-3:** For the second straight night, the Albuquerque Isotopes benefited from stellar starting pitching, as Tim Corcoran worked seven strong innings to lead the 'Topes to an 8-3 win over the Iowa Cubs Saturday night at Principal Park. Corcoran allowed just one run on three hits through seven innings, his longest outing of the year at any level, while walking two and striking out seven to win his second game in a row. The Isotopes grabbed a quick lead in the top of the third when Blake DeWitt roped a double and immediately scored on a single by Mitch Jones to give Albuquerque a 1-0 edge. Corcoran's only blemish of the night came in the bottom of the third and was somewhat self-inflicted. After Darwin Barney singled and was moved to second on a sacrifice, Corcoran slipped off the rubber for a balk that allowed the runner to advance to third, from where he was promptly cashed in by a single by So Taguchi, knotting the game at 1-1. The 'Topes grabbed control of the contest immediately, however, scoring a run in the fourth on an RBI double by J.D. Closser before erupting for five runs in the sixth. Tony Abreu ignited the rally with a two-run, bases-loaded single, giving the Isotopes a 4-1 lead. Luis Maza plated another run with a sacrifice fly before DeWitt hammered a triple that scored another run and then trotted home himself when the relay from the outfield escaped third baseman Nate Shields, capping the inning's scoring with Albuquerque opening up a 7-1 advantage. Chin-Lung Hu then added another run for good measure in seventh, opening up an 8-1 lead. Iowa plated two in the bottom of the eighth, but it wasn't enough as the Isotopes ended up cruising to an 8-3 triumph.

**DURBIN'S DUE:** Right-hander J.D. Durbin makes his final regular season start for the Isotopes hoping to break into the win column after five straight defeats. Durbin came maddeningly close to breaking through in his last outing on September 1 vs. Round Rock at Isotopes Park. After allowing six runs, only two of which were earned, in the first two innings, Durbin settled in and pitched extremely well, posting four straight scoreless innings while his offense scored six runs to tie the game. Albuquerque did seize a lead after Durbin exited the contest only to have the Express score six late to win 12-7. The right-hander's six innings in the contest was his longest outing since he worked seven vs. Tacoma on August 9 and his 110 pitches thrown in his last start were the second most he's thrown all year (118 vs. Iowa on July 25).

**RECORD WINS:** With a win total of 79, the 2009 Isotopes have won more games than any other team in franchise history. One more win would put the 'Topes in the 80-win club, a pretty select group. Only Sacramento (85 wins) has won as many games in the PCL this year and with two teams in the International League with 80 wins or more (Louisville-83; Durham-82), there are only three teams in all of Triple-A baseball to have reached that rarified air. In 29 years, the Albuquerque Dukes won 80 games or more 12 times, winning the PCL title in six of those seasons. Another win would also give the Isotopes a record for road victories in a season with 38.

**DOUBLIN' DEE:** Thanks to a pair of two-baggers last night, Dee Brown is in sole possession of the Isotopes franchise record of doubles in a season with 35, fifth most in the PCL this season. If he really goes on a doubles binge, he could threaten the Albuquerque professional baseball record of 40 doubles, racked up by Candy Maldonado for the Dukes in 1981.

**TRIPLE DIGITS:** With 101 RBI this season, Mitch Jones is just the second Isotope in team history to reach 100 runs batted in. Scott Seabold holds the team record with 105 in 2007.

**IT'S MEMPHIS!!:** The seven-day wait to see who the Isotopes would play in the PCL's American Conference Final is finally over, by virtue of a doubleheader sweep by Memphis over Okie City that gives the Redbirds the North Division title. The 'Topes and 'Birds just finished a five game set at Isotopes Park a week ago, with Albuquerque taking three. On the season, the Isotopes are 10-6 against Memphis.

**PLAYOFF TICKETS ON SALE!:** Tickets for the Pacific Coast League Playoff Games at Isotopes Park are on sale at the Isotopes Park Box Office, Ticketmaster.com, and Ticketmaster outlets. The Isotopes will host the winner of the Memphis Redbirds at The Lab on Wednesday, September 9 and Thursday, September 10, with both games starting at 7:05 PM.

**TODAY'S START:** J.D. Durbin makes the start trying to snap a five-game losing streak, the longest by an Isotopes starter this season. Got a no-decision in his last outing on September 1 vs. Round Rock, allowing six runs, only two of which were earned, on seven hits in six innings while walking five and striking out a season-high seven in a 12-7 Isotopes loss.

Took a short turn on the Disabled List from August 22 to August 29 while recovering from a right ankle sprain. Took his fifth consecutive defeat on August 21 at Reno, giving up five runs on four hits in 3.1 innings in a 7-3 Isotopes defeat. Pitched a season-high seven-plus innings on August 9 vs. Tacoma, in which he cruised through seven innings before giving up three runs in the eighth in a 6-4 'Topes loss. Suffered his second loss of the season when he allowed four runs, three earned, (all of them in the first inning) while walking six and striking out two in an 11-2 loss to Iowa on July 25 at Isotopes Park. Had a solid outing in his 'Topes debut on July 20 at Round Rock, suffering the loss after allowing three runs on seven hits in six innings while walking two and striking out three. Spent most of the season with Double-A Chattanooga, where he split time between the rotation and the bullpen, going 2-3 with a 2.05 ERA and three saves.

Spent most of the season working out of the bullpen, going 0-1 with three saves and a 1.66 ERA in 15 games. Saved his first game of the season on May 12 at Huntsville, beginning a streak of three straight saves from May 12 to May 19.

Made a spot-start on May 23 at Carolina, suffering the loss after allowing a run on three hits in four innings of work while walking one and striking out three in an eventual 10-3 loss, Durbin's first defeat of the season.

Moved into the rotation on June 28 and made four straight starts, going 2-1 with a 2.33 ERA (7 ER / 27.0 IP). Was 2-2 with a 2.32 (8 ER / 31.0 IP) in five total starts with the Lookouts. Earned his first win of the season in a start on July 3 vs. Carolina, allowing two runs on five hits in seven innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-3 Chattanooga win. Pitched eight shutout innings at Carolina on July 15, walking none and striking out three to earn his second win of the year.

Transferred to Albuquerque on July 17.

**2008:** Split season between Triple-A Lehigh Valley and Double-A Reading in the Phillies organization, going a combined 5-14 with a 5.81 ERA in 34 total appearances (21 starts) between both levels. Started the year in the Lehigh Valley rotation and suffered defeats in each of his first starts from April 6 to April 26... moved to the bullpen and made four more appearances before being transferred to Reading... pitched mostly out of Reading's rotation, going 5-7 with a 4.31 ERA (45 ER / 94.0 IP) in 19 games (15 starts)... won four straight starts from June 28 to July 13... transferred back to Lehigh Valley for six more appearances in the bullpen from August 1 to August 17 before finishing the season in Reading... went a total of 0-7 with a 9.75 ERA (39 ER / 36.0 IP) in 15 games (six starts) between his two stints in Lehigh Valley.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Spent the 2007 in the Arizona, Boston, and Philadelphia organizations, seeing Big League time with the Diamondbacks and Phillies... finished eighth among National League rookies with six wins and was the only MLB pitcher with both a shutout and a save... claimed off waivers from Arizona on March 3 and appeared in one game before being designated for assignment on April 5... claimed off waivers by Boston on April 9 but was designated for assignment the next day... claimed by the Phillies on April 10 and designated for a third time on April 6 and outrighted to Triple-A Ottawa... allowed three earned runs or less in eight of his 10 starts with Lynx and posted a 3.38 ERA in his final four starts... had contract purchased by Phillies on June 29 and started that day in the first game of a doubleheader vs. New York (NL)... made three relief appearances following the start before being moved back into the rotation... earned his first professional shutout on July 22 at San Diego, allowing five hit in nine innings while walking two and striking out five... earned his first Major League save on August 7 vs. Florida after firing three shutout innings.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Joseph Adam Durbin... has one daughter, Skylar Adalynn (10/18/07)... was a 2000 graduate of Coronado High School (AZ) where he played football and baseball... 2000 Arizona High School Player of the Year... named to Arizona All-State teams in baseball and football in 2000.
