I-CUBS SLIP 'TOPES 3-1: After rattling off three straight wins, the Albuquerque Isotopes were finally stymied, falling to the Iowa Cubs 3-1 on a sunny Sunday afternoon at Principal Park. The I-Cubs jumped out on top first with a pair of run in the bottom of the opening stanza. Matt Camp and John-Ford Griffin each roped back-to-back singles in front of Matt Craig, who lined a single to right that plated Camp and allowed Griffin to scamper into third when right fielder Scott Van Slyke overran the ball. Brad Snyder then lifted a pop up to shallow left that deflected off the glove of shortstop Chin-Lung Hu, who recovered to get Craig at second as Griffin scored, putting the unlucky 'Topes in a 2-0 hole. The 'Topes cut into the lead in fourth courtesy of a solo homer by J.D. Closser that made the score 2-1, but Iowa got the run right back in the bottom of the frame when Snyder led off the inning with a single and scored on a triple by Mark Johnson, extending the advantage to 3-1. The two run cushion was plenty for starter Jay Jackson, who cruised through six innings, allowing one run on five hits while walking three and striking out four en route to his first win. Albuquerque starter J.D. Durbin took the loss, his sixth straight, but deserved better, allowing just three runs, two earned, on eight hits through six solid frames, while walking one and striking out five.

BONILLA AGAIN ON THE SPOT: Henry Bonilla makes his second straight spot start hoping to avoid a pair of dubious distinctions. With six straight defeats and 11 overall, the right-hander is just one loss from tying a franchise record for consecutive losses and total losses in a season. In 2003, Sean Bergman started the season by losing seven straight games while his teammate that year Justin Wayne ended the year with a franchise record 12 set-backs. Only five other players in team history have lost 11 games in a season, with the most recent coming last year when Dallas Trahern and Bobby Keppel each suffered 11 defeats. Bonilla hopes the fact that the game is on the road will help him reverse the trend. In his two starts away from Isotopes Park, Bonilla has an ERA of 1.12 (1 ER / 8.0 IP) as opposed to an 8.85 ERA in his two starts at home. Overall, the right-hander is 1-7 with an 8.44 ERA (36 ER / 37.0 IP) at home and 2-4 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER / 37.2 IP) on the road.

GREAT STARTS: A hallmark of the 2009 Isotopes all season has been superb starting pitching, a trend that continues as the team heads into the post-season. In their last four games, 'Topes starters are 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA (5 ER / 25.0 IP) and 20 strikeouts. Each starter in the last four games has turned in a quality start, providing some additional rest for Isotopes relievers as the post-season approaches.

DAYDREAM BELIEVERS: The Isotopes will not only be playing their final regular season game but also their final day regular season contest, in which they have a record of 9-17 this year. In seven seasons, the 'Topes have finished with a winning record in day games just twice, 2006 (15-8) and 2004 (17-12).

CLOSS-TERPHOBIC: Since assuming every day catching duties with the call-up of A.J. Ellis to the Dodgers, J.D. Closser has been excellent. Since September 1st, Closser is batting .333 (7x21) with four runs scored, two doubles, a homer, and two RBI in six games. Even when he's not playing catcher, Closser is still in the lineup. Yesterday, he played first base and went 2-for-3 with his second homer of the season.

THAT'S A WRAP!: The 2009 regular season will go down as one of the best in the history of the Albuquerque Isotopes franchise, both on and off the field. The 'Topes set a record for wins in a season, made the post-season for the second time ever, and established a new attendance record by welcoming 602,129 to Isotopes Park. Now, the Isotopes hope to take the momentum from a great regular season into the 2009 PCL Playoffs.

PLAYOFF TICKETS ON SALE!: Tickets for the Pacific Coast League Playoff Games at Isotopes Park are on sale at the Isotopes Park Box Office, Ticketmaster.com, and Ticketmaster outlets. The Isotopes will host the Memphis Redbirds at The Lab on Wednesday, September 9 and Thursday, September 10, with both games starting at 7:05 PM.

TODAY'S START: Henry Bonilla makes a second consecutive spot-start trying to snap a season-high six-game losing streak the longest for a 'Topes pitcher this season. Bonilla tries to avoid two dubious records, having lost six in a row and 11 overall. The Isotopes record for consecutive losses is seven set by Sean Bergman in 2003. Justin Wayne has the team mark for most losses in season with 12, also set that season.

Is 0-6 with an 7.78 ERA (32 ER / 37.0 IP) in 16 appearances (four starts) over July, August, and September.

Lost four straight decisions from May 29 to June 15, the longest losing streak by an Isotopes pitcher this year. Bonilla did log a save in the middle of the streak in the second game of a doubleheader at New Orleans, his second save of the season. Went a season-high 4.1 innings on May 16 at Fresno, getting the victory in a 6-2 'Topes win after allowing a run on two hits while walking one and striking out a season-high five.

Saved his first game of the season on May 7 at Oklahoma City, tossing 3.0 perfect innings in which he struck out one. Earned first win of the 2009 season after pitching out of a bases-loaded, no-out jam- part of two scoreless innings on April 18 at Omaha.

2008: Spent 2008 season at Triple-A Salt Lake in L.A. Angels organization, going 5-2 with a 4.67 ERA and three saves... led the Bees in appearances with 51 (one start)... was a perfect 3-0 with two saves and a 4.46 ERA at home... went 2-2 with one save and a 4.94 ERA on the road... allowed 11 home runs in 71.1 innings-pitched, with seven of them coming at home... held left-handers to a .238 average while righties batted .269... earned first win in relief outing on April 12 vs. Portland, after going two innings, allowing three runs, two earned, on four hits... struck out a season-high five out of 10 batters faced in two innings of work on May 7 vs. Albuquerque... earned first save on May 30 vs. Colorado Springs after going two innings in which he allowed just one hit (a ninth inning homer by Joe Koshansky)... made his only start of the season in the second game of a doubleheader on June 14 vs. Las Vegas, going three innings (his longest outing of the season), and allowing four runs, one earned, on six hits while getting the no-decision... held opposing batters to a .192 average (10x52) with runners on base and two outs... played for Tiburones de La Guaira of the Venezuelan Winter League and was used exclusively as a starter, going 3-2 with a 3.21 ERA in 13 games.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Went 12-8 with a 5.78 ERA in 29 starts for Triple-A Salt Lake in 2007 after signing with the Angels as a free agent on December 20, 2006... led the Pacific Coast League with 29 games started and tied for second with 12 victories... finished second on the Bees and fourth in the League with 165.0 innings-pitched... fanned a season-high seven in six innings of work in a no-decision at Oklahoma on May 29... won four straight starts from July 28 to August 13... suffered the loss in his only complete game of the season on August 18 at Fresno after allowing two runs on five hits in eight innings of work in a 2-0 Grizzlies win... appeared in nine games (eight starts) for Tigres de Aragua of the Venezuelan Winter League, going 1-2 with a 2.72 ERA.

Spent 2006 season with Triple-A Rochester in the Minnesota Twins organization, going 3-7 with a 4.26 ERA in 35 games (eight starts)... finished third on the Red Wings in appearances... after four appearances out of the bullpen, moved to the rotation on April 18 and made six straight starts, going 1-5... lost his only complete game of the season on May 13 at Syracuse after allowing five runs on seven hits in five innings of a 5-2 Chiefs win shortened by weather... granted free agency on October 15.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Vincente Enrique (Henry) Bonilla... married to Leslie Grubb and has three children Zack, Julia, Daylen... played college baseball at Tulane where he was a two-year letterman.
