'TOPES FINISH REGULAR SEASON WITH 7-2 WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes finished a record regular season in style, beating the Iowa Cubs 7-2 Monday afternoon at Principal Park. The win helped elevate the 'Topes to franchise records in road wins and total wins, while combining with the team's already established home wins record. The Isotopes jumped out on top first, scoring a run in the top of the fourth when Blake DeWitt led off the frame with an infield single, advanced to third on a single by Hector Luna, and scored on wild pitch by Cubs starter Jeff Samardzija to give Albuquerque a quick 1-0 lead. Iowa would respond with a run in the bottom of the fourth, but the 'Topes roared back with four in the fifth to take control of the game. With runners on second and third and one out, Xavier Paul hammered a double to left, easily scoring both and putting the Isotopes back on top 3-1. Mitch Jones then smashed a two-run homer to left-center, cashing in Paul and putting Albuquerque ahead 5-1. The 'Topes struck again in the seventh, scoring two when DeWitt roped an RBI triple and was quickly brought home by a pinch-hit RBI double by Sergio Garcia, increasing the advantage to 7-1. The I-Cubs would plate one in the bottom of the seventh, but the 'Topes' lead was never in question, as Albuquerque closed out the 2009 regular season campaign with a 7-2 win.

STULTS STARTS GAME ONE: The Isotopes will look to get off to a quick start in the PCL American Conference Finals behind lefty Eric Stults, who will take the ball in game one. This season against the 'Birds, Stults is 1-1 with a 4.09 ERA in a pair of starts, one at home and one on the road. In his last start against Memphis at Isotopes Park, on August 29, the southpaw yielded a season-high seven runs, only three of which were earned, on nine hits in five innings while walking two and striking out two in an 11-9 Isotopes loss. The outing proved to be an anomaly, however, as Stults closed out his season with a solid no-decision against Round Rock, allowing just three runs on nine hits in six innings while walking one and striking out three in a game the 'Topes would win 5-4. Of Stults's 11 starts this season, six have been of the quality variety.

'TOPES BACK IN THE POST-SEASON!: For the first time in six long years, Isotopes Park will host post-season baseball, as the 'Topes are back in the PCL playoffs for the first time since 2003. In that series, Albuquerque dued the Nashville Sounds and split the first two games in the Music City, before finally succumbing with two straight losses at Isotopes Park. It's been a long drought for the Redbirds as well, who last tasted the playoffs in 2000, beating the Albuquerque Dukes in the first round three-games to two on their way to a Pacific Coast League championship.

'BIRD BATHS: The Isotopes enter the best-of-five game series with Memphis having won the season series 10-6, going 6-2 at Isotopes Park. The 'Topes have batted .292 (163x559) as a team against Memphis, with 23 home runs in 16 games, more dingers than Albuquerque has hit against any other PCL club this season.

JONES ON THE JOB: Albuquerque will enter the playoffs with one of the most formidable lineups in the Pacific Coast League, with slugger Mitch Jones serving as the centerpiece. Jones finished the regular season by belted his 35th home run of the year, tied for the most hit in Minor League Baseball this year. Plus, the outfielder enters playoff action red-hot with hits in each of his last nine games, batting a blistering .471 (16x34) with eight runs, four doubles, two homers, and 14 RBI.

PLAYOFF TICKETS STILL ON SALE!: Tickets for the Pacific Coast League Playoff Games at Isotopes Park are still on sale at the Isotopes Park Box Office, Ticketmaster.com, and Ticketmaster outlets. The Isotopes will host the Memphis Redbirds at The Lab tonight and tomorrow, with both games starting at 7:05 PM.

TODAY'S START: Eric Stults makes the start in the Isotopes' first playoff game since 2003, coming off a solid season in which he went 5-4 with a 5.20 ERA in 12 games, 11 starts. The last time he faced Memphis at Isotopes Park. Stults allowed seven runs, three earned, on nine hits in five innings in an 11-9 loss the Redbirds on August 29. The defeat was Stults's last of the regular season and the 'Topes' last loss to Memphis.

Had a one-game stint with the Dodgers, when he made a start on August 9 in the place of Jason Schmidt, who was forced back on the DL on August 7 with a right shoulder issue. Stults was recalled on August 9 and made the start that day against Atlanta, suffering the loss after yielding three runs on five hits in five innings while walking one and striking out three in an 8-2 Dodgers loss. Was limited to just three innings in a start for the Isotopes on August 6 in preparation for his recall to Los Angeles, but was in the game long enough to belt a two-run double.

Won four straight starts from July 11 to July 27, posting a 3.37 ERA (9 ER / 24.0 IP) in that span. Earned his third victory of the year on July 22 after allowing two runs on six hits in six innings while walking four and striking four. in a 5-2 Isotopes win. Enjoyed a triumph against New Orleans on July 17 at Isotopes Park when he allowed three runs on eight hits while walking one and striking out five in a 12-3 'Topes win. Got the win on July 11 at Memphis, when he allowed two runs on five hits in six innings while walking two and striking out eight in a 7-2 'Topes win. Made technically a relief outing on July 6 in the resumption of a suspended game in Nashville from July 4. Stults started the resumption and pitched three innings, allowing three runs on six hits while walking two and striking out four.

Reinstated from the Dodgers' Disabled List and optioned to Albuquerque on July 2. Placed on the DL on May 31 after spraining his left thumb while making a sprawling play on a bunt at Florida on May 15. Missed one start and tried to pitch through the injury, making a start at Colorado on May 25 and at Chicago (NL) on May 31 allowing a total of eight earned runs in 7.1 total innings (10.14 ERA). Before the injury, he was 4-1 with a 3.82 ERA.

Pitched a brilliant, four-hit, complete-game shutout vs. San Francisco on May 9, the second complete-game shutout of his career. Did not walk a batter while striking out five in the 8-0 Dodgers win.

Began the season on the Isotopes' roster but was recalled to Los Angeles on April 11 before appearing for Albuquerque. Joined the Dodgers' rotation in the place of Hiroki Kuroda, who was placed on the DL with a strained left oblique.

2008: In three stints with the Dodgers, went 2-3 with a shutout and a 3.49 ERA in seven starts... spent the majority of the year with Triple-A Las Vegas, where he went 7-7 with a 3.82 ERA in 20 starts... tossed a four-hit shutout against the Chicago White Sox on June 25 at Dodger Stadium... started the Sept. 25 game vs. San Francisco in place of Greg Maddux after the Dodgers had clinched the National League West title earlier in the day with Arizona's 12-3 loss at St. Louis... went 2-2 with a 3.18 ERA (12 ER/34.0 IP) in six starts during his first stint... after winning his first two starts, June 19 at Cincinnati and June 25 vs. Chicago White Sox, was winless in his next four starts from June 30-July 21, going 0-2 with a 5.21 ERA (11 ER/19.0 IP)... was optioned back to Las Vegas on July 22, when Clayton Kershaw was recalled from Double-A Jacksonville... returned to the Dodgers on August 14 to pitch out of the bullpen... his June 25 shutout of the White Sox came in just his ninth career start... the last Dodger to fire a shutout with fewer Major League starts under his belt was Darren Dreifort, who blanked Arizona in his seventh career start on May 22, 1998.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Eric William Stults... he and his wife, Stephanie, have a daughter, Madeline (1/22/06) and a son, Luke (7/2/08)... pitched and played centerfield for Bethel College (Indiana), which won the 2002 National Christian Collegiate Athletic Association Division I championship.
