ALBUQUERQUE FALLS TO ROYALS 9-5: Despite banging out 11 hits, the Albuquerque Isotopes were outpaced by the Omaha Royals 9-5 on a blustery Friday night at Isotopes Park. The defeat is the first for the 'Topes on the infant 2009 season. The O-Royals struck first with a run in the second, but Albuquerque answered with a sacrifice fly by Jason Repko that chased home Hector Luna from third and tied the game at 1-1. Omaha would surge ahead again in the fourth courtesy of a solo home run by Chris Lubanski before plating four in the fifth to grab a 6-1 lead. After Mitch Maier roped an RBI double, Kila Ka'aihue capped the inning's scoring by belting a three-run homer to give the Royals a five-run cushion. Albuquerque immediately started chipping away, thanks to a solo homer by Repko to make the score 6-2, but Omaha responded with a run in the sixth, seventh, and eighth to stay just ahead of the 'Topes, who scored a run in the seventh and two in the eighth before ultimately falling 9-5. Starting pitcher Giancarlo Alvarado took the defeat for Albuquerque while O-Royals righty Luke Hochevar earned the victory.

MILTON- PARADISE FOUND?: Left-hander Eric Milton takes the mound tonight for the first time since May 8, 2007 when he was a starter for the Cincinnati Reds. Since that no-decision against the Houston Astros at Great American Ballpark, the southpaw has undergone Tommy John surgery and is now diligently working his way back into the pitching form that made him a Major League All-Star. To say it's been a long road for Milton is an understatement, as the left-hander's last injury-free year was with the Reds in 2005.

REPKO RAKING: Outfielder Jason Repko is off to a torrid start, going 3-for-6 in his first two games to begin the season, with five runs scored, a double, three RBI and a pair of homers. Repko has also been a terror on the basepaths, leading the PCL with three stolen bases already on the young season.

MAKING MOVES: The early season stability of the Isotopes roster lasted all of one day, as the last 24 hours has brought three transactions that impact the 'Topes roster. Yesterday, outfielder Delwyn Young joined Albuquerque on a Major League rehabilitation assignment while he works his way back from a right elbow impingement. After getting into the lineup as a DH last night (0-for-3), Young is expected to play the outfield tonight. The injury bug also bit Dodgers right-hander Hiroki Kuroda, who has been placed on the 15-day DL retro-active to April 7 with a mild left oblique strain. Taking Kuroda's spot in the rotation is former Isotopes left-hander Eric Stults, who will make the start for the Dodgers today in Arizona. Right-hander Scott Strickland will be active on the Isotopes roster after being transferred from Ogden.

SEEING DOUBLE: In just two games, the Isotopes have pounded out a PCL-high eight doubles. The Pacific Coast League leader in two-baggers is Xavier Paul, who tied a franchise record last night with three doubles in a single game, raising his early season total to four.

PINK POWER NIGHT: Tonight the Isotopes will be wearing pink and black hats in recognition of Pink Power Night, sponsored by the American Cancer Society, NM Department of Health BCC, and Blue Cross / Blue Shield. After tonight's game, the Isotopes will sign each hat and they will be auctioned off to raise funds for Making Strides Against Breast Cancer. The auctions will be held on three different occasions; The Hope In Bloom Gala on April 18 at the Bishops Lodge in Santa Fe, the Coaches Vs. Cancer Gala at Tamaya Resort on May 2, and the Anita Salas Breast Cancer Conference in September.

TODAY'S START: Left-hander Eric Milton makes his first appearance in almost two years as he continues the long road back from Tommy John surgery. The last time Milton took the mound was on May 8, 2007 when he made the start for the Cincinnati Reds against the Houston Astros.

2008: Signed a minor league contract with New York (AL) on July 11, and was assigned to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre... did not appear in a game while rehabbing left elbow from Tommy John surgery... declared free agency on November 3.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Went 0-4, with a 5.17 ERA in six starts for Cincinnati in 2007... on May 9 went on the 15-day Disabled List with a sore left elbow that was diagnosed as a torn ulnar collateral ligament... on June 15 had Tommy John Surgery.

In a 2006 season interrupted by a pair of surgeries, ranked third on the Reds pitching staff – behind Bronson Arroyo and Aaron Harang – in starts (26), innings pitched (152.2) and strikeouts (90)... on September 22 had season-ending surgery to clean out his left elbow... began the season 2-1 with a 6.50 ERA in three starts before he went on the 15-day DL with a left knee injury... on April 24 had arthroscopic surgery to clean up the meniscus in that knee... returned on May 20 and in his last 26 starts of the season went 6-7 with a 5.01 ERA and had 12 quality appearances... in his season debut on April 7 vs. Pittsburgh, earned the 7-6 victory and recorded the 1000th strikeout of his career (Jason Bay).

Led the 2005 Cincinnati pitching staff with 34 starts, tying his career high... produced 13 quality starts... as a batter, hit his first two career home runs (May 8 vs. LA off Jeff Weaver. July 26 at LA off Odalis Perez).

In his first season in the National League, led the Phillies in wins (14), starts (34), innings pitched (201.0) and strikeouts in 2004... became the first Phillies pitcher to win 13 of his first 15 decisions since Steve Carlton in 1980... on July 25 vs. Chicago (NL) took a no-hitter into the ninth inning before Michael Barrett hit a bloop double to lead-off the frame.

Spent most of the 2003 season on the 60-day disabled list while recovering from surgery to repair the torn lateral meniscus in his left knee... from September 14-26 went 1-0, 2.65 ERA in his three starts for the Minnesota Twins... made one relief appearance during the ALDS vs. NYY, received no decision in the 8-1 loss at MIN in Game Four... traded to Philadelphia for RHP Carlos Silva, SS Nick Punto, and a player to be named (RHP Bobby Korecky), on December 3.

In 1999, led the Twins' pitching staff in starts (34), complete games (four), shutouts (two) and strikeouts (163)... ranked among the American League pitching leaders in starts (tied for second), shutouts (tied for second), complete games (tied for fourth), opposing batting average (.243, fifth) and strikeouts (ninth)... tossed the fifth no-hitter in Twins history on September 11 vs. the Angels on while posting a career-high 13 strikeouts in a 7-0 win.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Eric Robert Milton... attended the University of Maryland, where in 1996 he was a pre-season All-American.
