PITCHING PROPELS 'TOPES TO 3-1 WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes got a pair of stellar pitching performances from Shawn Estes and Jeff Weaver en route to a masterful 3-1 win over the Iowa Cubs Monday night at Isotopes Park. Estes got the start and threw four excellent innings in which he allowed just one run on three hits while walking one and striking out three. The left-hander's only blemish came in the fourth, when Jake Fox was hit by a pitch, advanced to third on a single by Luis Rivas, and scored on a sacrifice fly by Nate Spears to give Iowa a 1-0 lead. After the fourth, Estes gave way to Weaver, who added three scoreless, hitless innings of his own while walking just two. With the pitching in control, Albuquerque's offense got to work in the bottom of the seventh, when Jason Repko smashed a lead-off solo homer to tie the game at 1-1. Valentino Pascucci immediately followed with a triple, before scoring on a single by Mitch Jones to give the 'Topes a 2-1 lead, their first advantage since last Thursday. After Chin-Lung Hu sacrificed Jones to second, Hector Luna roped a single into center that scored Jones and capped the seventh-inning rally with Albuquerque ahead 3-1. A two-run cushion was plenty for the Isotopes' bullpen, as Weaver, who ended up with the win, gave way to Nick DeBarr, who threw a scoreless eighth. The ninth inning then belonged to Tanyon Sturtze, who finished off the I-Cubs to claim the first save by an Isotopes pitcher this season.

PINPOINT PINANGO Coming off their second win of the season, the Isotopes will now turn to the man who earned the team's first victory in right-hander Miguel Pinango. On Opening Day, April 9, Pinango turned in a solid five innings of work in which he allowed four runs (only one of which was earned) on four hits in the 14-8 Albuquerque triumph. Perhaps as notable as the victory in the right-hander's outing is the fact he did not allow one walk, exhibiting perfect control in a ballpark where extra base runners can come back and hurt a pitcher. In fact, of the 78 pitches he tossed in the win over Omaha, 52 were thrown for strikes.

MESSRS. HITS: Jason Repko and Dee Brown have gotten a hit in each game they've played, with Repko hitting in all five of the Isotopes' games so far this season. In four appearances, Brown is batting a robust .500 (7x14) with a double and four RBI, while Repko is hitting at a .316 (6x19) clip with a team-high six runs scored, a double, and four RBI. He is also tied with Salt Lake's

Brandon Wood for the PCL lead in home runs with three, is tied for second in the League with three stolen bases, and is fourth in the PCL in slugging percentage with a mark of .842.

MORE MOVIN': Yesterday, the Isotopes roster went through some more changes as Juan Castro had his contract purchased by the Dodgers and infielder Blake DeWitt was optioned from Los Angeles to Albuquerque. To make room for Castro on the Major League 40-man roster, Delwyn Young, who was with the 'Topes on a Major League rehab, was taken off rehab and designated for assignment. DeWitt was one of the break-out stars for the Dodgers a year ago, making the Opening Day roster after not even being invited to Big League camp and playing 117 games. The infielder started the season at third, playing in 95 games there before becoming the Dodgers' everyday second baseman, including starting all eight of LA's post-season games at the position. So far this season, DeWitt has not seen much playing time with Los Angeles, appearing in just three games (one start) and batting .167 (1x6). The former Duke Castro goes to the Dodgers after batting 182 (2x11) in three games with the 'Topes.

NEGRO LEAGUES / JACKIE ROBINSON TRIBUTE: Tomorrow is the 62nd anniversary of Jackie Robinson breaking the color barrier for the Brooklyn Dodgers and in tribute to him and all the players who toiled in anonymity in the Negro Leagues, the 'Topes are holding a special night of recognition. Pacific Coast League Branch Rickey, whose grandfather was the man who signed Robinson, will give some pre-game remarks before the teams take the field in throwback Negro Leagues uniforms. Robinson's number 42 will also be permanently added to the outfield wall at Isotopes Park.

TODAY'S START: Miguel Pinango takes the mound coming off his first win of the season in the Isotopes' 14-8 win over the Omaha Royals on Opening Night, April 9. In that contest, the right-hander allowed four runs (only one of which was earned) on four hits in five innings while walking none and striking out five.

2008: Spent season with Triple-A Las Vegas, going 5-9 with a 5.16 ERA in 27 games (24 starts)... led the 51s in starts and inningspitched (136.0)... struck out 93 while walking 38... fanned 34 over six starts (32.1 innings) in April... went 2-2 with a 2.55 ERA and 23 strikeouts in six games (five starts) in May... logged more seven-inning outings than any other member of 51s pitching staff (went seven innings five different times)... struck out a season-high 10 in five innings of work in a no-decision vs. Colorado Springs on April 8... in his very next start, twirled seven shutout innings in which he allowed just three hits in a no-decision at Sacramento on April 13... tied team season-highs by allowing nine runs in a game vs. Albuquerque on April 30 and 12 hits in a game vs. Tucson on June 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Signed by the Dodgers as a free agent on January 30, 2007 and split his first season in the Los Angeles organization between Single-A Inland Empire and Triple-A Las Vegas, combining for an 11-10 record and a total 113 strikeouts... started the season at Inland Empire but was promoted to Triple-A on May 12... appeared in 23 games (all starts) and led 51s in starts, wins (10), innings-pitched (126.2) and tied for the team lead with 92 strikeouts... his 4.12 ERA for Las Vegas was eighth lowest in the Pacific Coast League... compiled a 6-3 record with a 3.90 ERA in 11 games at home and 4-4 with a 4.35 ERA on the road.

Compiled a record of 10-7 in 2006 with a 4.44 in his first season at Double-A Binghamton in the New York Mets organization... appeared in 28 games while setting career-highs in starts (27- also third highest in the Eastern League) and innings-pitched (152.0).

Split 2005 season between Gulf Coast League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie in injury-plagued season, going 3-2 in a total of 13 games (12 starts)... made one appearance for the GCL Mets on June 27 allowing just three hits in four innings... transferred to St. Lucie on July 2 and went 3-2 with 4.13 ERA in 12 games (11 starts)... walked 11 batters in 61.0 innings.
