**'TOPES BEGIN NEW ERA IN TONIGHT:** After months of eager anticipation, the Albuquerque Isotopes finally begin their first season as Triple-A partner of the Los Angeles Dodgers tonight against the Omaha Royals. The 'Topes spent the previous six seasons as top affiliate of the Florida Marlins before entering a partnership with the Dodgers that renewed a relationship between the Major League team and the City of Albuquerque that spanned from 1967 (as a Double-A entrant in the Texas League) to 2000.

**PINANGO TO MAKE HISTORIC START:** Getting the ball on this special night is right-hander Miguel Pinango, who went 5-9 with a 5.16 ERA in 27 games (24 starts) with Triple-A Las Vegas a year ago. The 26-year old native of Venezuela established himself as the 51s work-horse a year ago, leading the team in starts and innings-pitched (136.0) while striking out 93. While this is Pinango's first Opening Day start in Albuquerque, he's no stranger to the electricity that comes with starting the first game of the season. Last year, Pinango was the Opening Day starter for Las Vegas against Salt Lake and pitched well, giving up two runs on four hits in six innings while striking out five and walking one. The right-hander left that game with the scored tied at 2-2 and saw the 51s grab a 3-2 lead in the seventh before the Bees rallied for four runs in the ninth to take 6-3 win.

**THE BAZOOKA'S BACK!:** While the 2009 Isotopes roster is made up almost entirely of new faces, 'Topes fans will be delighted to see the familiar visage of Valentino Pascucci, a fan-favorite in 2007 who spent last year killing the Isotopes as a member of the New Orleans Zephyrs. In 2008 Pascucci batted .304 (14x46) with three doubles, four homers, and 12 RBI in 15 games against the Isotopes, including a walk-off home run in New Orleans on May 23. Of course, fans won't soon forget Pascucci's last appearance in a 'Topes uniform, when he set a then-franchise record with 34 homers and was named PCL Star of the Game in the 2007 Triple-A All-Star Game at Isotopes Park.

**EXPERIENCE COUNTS:** The 'Topes enter the 2009 season with some serious mega-watt Major League experience, especially on their pitching staff. Albuquerque hurlers bring with them into the season a combined 56 years of Big League time, with 1,469 total games, and 344 combined wins. Left-hander Shawn Estes has 13 years in the Majors with 283 games and 101 wins, Scott Strickland has logged 236 games in six years, reliever Tanyon Sturtze has 12 years with 272 games and 40 wins, Eric Milton has 10 years with 266 games and 87 wins, and Jeff Weaver adds nine Major League seasons with 284 games and 93 wins. Charlie Haeger and Stephen Randolph also have Big League time.

**OPENING STRONG:** While Opening Day is always a treat, it's even sweeter when the 'Topes begin the year with a win. All-time, the Isotopes are 5-1 on Opening Day and are 2-0 when starting the year at home. This will also be the third straight year Albuquerque has opened the season against the Omaha Royals (2007 and 2009 in Albuquerque; 2008 in Omaha)

**IN THE PRESENCE OF ROYALTY:** Albuquerque's first opponent of the 2009 season, the Omaha Royals, is one against whom the Isotopes have enjoyed success. All-time, the 'Topes are 59-37 against the O-Royals, and 29-19 against them at home. Last year, Albuquerque went 10-6 against Omaha, 5-3 at Isotopes Park.

**WELCOME TOMMY!:** Adding to the thrill of Opening Day at The Lab is a special appearance by Baseball Legend Tommy Lasorda, who is here to throw out the first pitch and spread goodwill throughout the ballpark. The Isotopes also would also like to welcome Dodgers Assistant GM / Player Development De Jon Watson and Dodgers Press Coordinator Colin Gunderson. Thanks for sharing Opening Day with the Isotopes!

**TODAY'S START:** Right-hander Miguel Pinango officially ushers in a new era of Isotopes baseball, becoming the first starter in the first game since the 'Topes became Triple-A partner with the Los Angeles Dodgers. While this will be Pinango's first Opening Day start in Albuquerque, the right-handed did pitch Opening Day for the Las Vegas 51s on April 3 last year vs. Salt Lake, allowing two runs on four hits in six innings while striking out five and walking one. Pinango pitched well but did not figure in the decision as the Bees plated four runs in the ninth to win 6-3.

**2008:** Spent season with Triple-A Las Vegas, going 5-9 with a 5.16 ERA in 27 games (24 starts)... led the 51s in starts and innings-pitched (136.0)... struck out 93 while walking 38... fanned 34 over six starts (32.1 innings) in April... went 2-2 with a 2.55 ERA and 23 strikeouts in six games (five starts) in May... logged more seven-inning outings than any other member of 51s pitching staff (went seven innings five different times)... struck out a season-high 10 in five innings of work in a no-decision vs. Colorado Springs on April 8... in his very next start, twirled seven shutout innings in which he allowed just three hits in a no-decision at Sacramento on April 13... tied team season-highs by allowing nine runs in a game vs. Albuquerque on April 30 and 12 hits in a game vs. Tucson on June 6.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Signed by the Dodgers as a free agent on January 30, 2007 and split his first season in the Los Angeles organization between Single-A Inland Empire and Triple-A Las Vegas, combining for an 11-10 record and a total 113 strikeouts... started the season at Inland Empire but was promoted to Triple-A on May 12... appeared in 23 games (all starts) and led 51s in starts, wins (10), innings-pitched (126.2) and tied for the team lead with 92 strikeouts... his 4.12 ERA for Las Vegas was eighth lowest in the Pacific Coast League... compiled a 6-3 record with a 3.90 ERA in 11 games at home and 4-4 with a 4.35 ERA on the road.

Compiled a record of 10-7 in 2006 with a 4.44 in his first season at Double-A Binghamton in the New York Mets organization... appeared in 28 games while setting career-highs in starts (27- also third highest in the Eastern League) and innings-pitched (152.0).

Split 2005 season between Gulf Coast League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie in injury-plagued season, going 3-2 in a total of 13 games (12 starts)... made one appearance for the GCL Mets on June 27 allowing just three hits in four innings... transferred to St. Lucie on July 2 and went 3-2 with 4.13 ERA in 12 games (11 starts)... walked 11 batters in 61.0 innings.
