TOUGH TENTH TROUBLES 'TOPES IN 10-4 LOSS: After clinging to a one-run lead through most of the game, the Albuquerque Isotopes watched the Omaha Storm Chasers plate seven runs in the top of the 10th inning to claim a 10-4 victory on a blustery Saturday night at Isotopes Park. The setback, Albuquerque's first of the 2011 season also came in the team's first extra-inning contest of the young campaign. With the game knotted at 3-3 heading into the 10th, the Chasers plated seven runs on just two hits to seize control of the contest. Lance Zawadzki led off the frame with a walk and was sacrificed to second by David Lough. After Zawadzki stole third and Eric Hosmer drew another walk, giving the Storm Chasers runners on the corners and one out, Mike Moustakas bounced a come-backer to 'Topes pitcher Jon Huber, who wheeled around and fired to second in an attempt to start an inning-ending 1-6-3 double-play. Huber's throw drew shortstop Dee Gordon off the bag, however, allowing Hosmer to slide in safely while Zawadzki streaked home with the go-ahead run. Gordon's subsequent attempt to get Moustakas at first ended up skittering past Jerry Sands, allowing Hosmer to take third while the batter cruised into second. With runners on second and third and still just one away, Huber intentionally walked Clint Robinson to load the bases, but also immediately issued two more bases-loaded free passes that helped Omaha score twice more and take a 6-3 lead. Reliever Oscar Villarreal then entered the game, but things didn't get much better for the home team, as Paulo Orlando roped a two-run single and Zawadzki smashed a two-run double to give the visitors a 10-3 lead. Albuquerque managed to score once in the bottom of the 10th, but it wasn't enough as the Chasers cruised to their first win of the season.

SEEING REDD: Major League veteran right-hander Tim Redding makes the start coming off an excellent Spring Training in which he made a strong run at the Dodgers' fifth starter position. In five games (four starts) for Los Angeles in Spring Training, Redding posted a perfect 1-0 record and a 3.60 ERA (6 ER / 15.0 IP). Granted it's a small sample size, but in his 15 innings of spring work, the right-hander fanned nine and walked just three, continuing what has been a trend of pinpoint control. Last season while splitting time between Triple-A Colorado Springs (Rockies organization) and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (Yankees), Redding combined to walk just 22 batters while striking out 83 in 109.0 innings of work before he finished the season with the Samsung Lions in Korea. Redding also brings more Major League experience than any other pitcher on the 2011 Isotopes pitching staff, appearing in a total of 179 games (144 starts) for the Houston Astros, San Diego Padres, New York Yankees, Washington Nationals, and New York Mets over his 13-year career.

DAY BASEBALL!: For the first time in 2011, the Isotopes will play day baseball, the first of two day games to be played in the next five days. Last year, Albuquerque posted a winning record under the sun, going 18-13.

THE SANDS OF TIME: The only player to play and collect a hit in each of the Isotopes' three games so far this season is Jerry Sands, who has four hits in 13 at-bats (.308 average). Of his four hits, two have gone for extra bases, including a two-run homer Saturday night, an opposite-field blast that was the first round-tripper of his Triple-A career. It may have been his first, but 'Topes fans can probably expect a lot more where that came from. Last season, he blasted a combined 35 homers between stops at Single-A Great Lakes and Double-A Chattanooga.

TO ERR IS HUMAN: The Isotopes and Storm Chasers each have committed six errors on the season, tied for the most in the Pacific Coast League so far. Colorado Springs and Tucson are next on the list with five errors apiece. Albuquerque has committed two miscues in each of its three games played this season.

SALUTE TO PUBLIC SAFETY: Today the Isotopes honor all of those who keep us safe on a daily basis including police, fire, and other emergency personnel. Their tireless dedication allows us to enjoy pursuits like baseball in a safe environment. So, as Fletch would say, "Hug a Cop!"

HOT DOG HANKERINGS: Time to search the closet for the sweat pants because tomorrow is the first 50-Cent Hot Dog Night of the season. In fact, for the first time in team history the Isotopes will be holding three such nights this year, (April 11, May 23, and August 22).

TODAY'S START: Veteran right-hander Tim Lincecum takes the mound making his first start of the 2011 season after a solid Spring Training that saw him go 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (6 ER / 15.0 IP) in five games (four starts) with the Dodgers.

2010: Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Rockies organization and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the New York (AL) organization... allowed just four home runs in 109.0 combined innings... opened the season with Colorado Springs, making five starts before his release on May 6... signed by the Yankees on May 13 and assigned to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre... in 13 games (12 starts) with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, limited opposing hitters to a .221 average (68x307), including a .189 mark against right-handers (30x159)... finished the season on a five-game winning streak, going 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA (4 ER / 43.1 IP) over six games (five starts) from July 4 to July 31... released by the Yankees on August 5 and finished the season with the Samsung Lions in the Korea Baseball Organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the 2009 season in New York (NL) organization, making 30 appearances (17 starts) for the Mets... made two starts in Spring Training on March 8 and March 12 before landing on the 15-Day Disabled List April 5th (retroactive to March 27th) with a strained right rotator cuff... had two rehabilitation starts (no decisions) with Triple-A Buffalo... made his Mets debut on May 18 at Los Angeles (NL) after being activated from the 15-Day DL earlier in the day... picked up his first hit in a Mets uniform, a single to right field in the fifth inning... picked up his first win as a member of the Mets on June 22 at home vs. St. Louis... tied his season-high with 7.0 innings and allowed 4 runs and 5 hits (the last Mets pitcher to go winless in his first six starts was Hideo Nomo in 1998)... moved to the bullpen after his start on July 2 in Pittsburgh... as a reliever, compiled a 5.63 ERA (15 ER / 24.0 IP) in 13 games and lost his only decision... moved back to the rotation for a start on August 22 vs. Philadelphia... in his first two starts after moving back into the rotation, he was 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA (3 ER / 11.2 IP).

Established career highs in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts with the Washington Nationals in 2008... following the season, had calcium deposit removed from the joint of his second toe on his left foot... finished tied for ninth in the NL with 33 starts... did not miss his turn in the rotation the entire season... matched his career-high in wins with 10 (also won 10 games for Houston in 2003)... became first Nats pitcher to record double figures in victories since the 2006 season... Washington went 20-13 in his starts... in his first 12 starts of the year, he went 6-3 with a 3.71 ERA... in his first start of the year, went 7.0 innings to beat the Phillies, 1-0, at Citizens Bank Park on April 2... established career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a 6-4 victory at Florida on April 18... on May 19, worked 6.1 scoreless frames and combined with three relievers to shut out the Phillies, 4-0, at Washington... threw career-best 8.0 innings, his first Major League complete game, in a 1-0 loss on July 24 at San Francisco.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Timothy James Redding... is married to Jaime with a daughter, Shea (11/13/01), and son, Brennan (9/15/03)... graduated from Monroe Community College in Rochester, NY, where his No. 17 jersey became the first in school history to be retired on Feb. 1, 2008... his great aunt, Joyce Randolph, played Trixie Norton on the Honeymooners.
