'TOPES SPLIT WITH STORM CHASERS AFTER 9-6 LOSS: Despite being buried in an early six-run hole, the Albuquerque Isotopes clawed to within three, but that's where the momentum stalled as the Omaha Storm Chasers held on for a 9-6 win on a windy Sunday afternoon at Isotopes Park. Things started well enough for Albuquerque in the bottom of the first, when Dee Gordon led off the inning with a single and Ivan De Jesus Jr. followed with a walk to put two on with nobody out. After a perfectly executed double-steal, Jamie Hoffmann laced a double that hugged the third base line, allowing both runners to score easily and put the Isotopes on top 2-0. It quickly went south from there, however, as Omaha scored four times in the second and four more times in the third to grab an 8-2 lead. Albuquerque would answer quickly, however, to the tune of three runs in the bottom of the third thanks in part to some sudden control problems from Chasers starter Vin Mazzaro. Trent Oeltjen and John Lindsey started the frame by drawing back-to-back walks before Hoffmann was hit by a pitch in the center of his back, loading the bases for Russ Mitchell, who drew another free pass that pushed across a run and cut the lead to 8-3. Jerry Sands then added a sacrifice fly deep to right that plated Lindsey before Justin Sellers drew yet another walk to again load the bases with just one out. That brought an Omaha pitching change and J.D. Closser to the plate, who roped a line drive up the middle off reliever Luis Mendoza to help the 'Topes draw within 8-5. Omaha added a run of insurance with a solo homer by Mike Moustakas in the fourth but the blast was answered in the bottom of the fifth by Sands, who cracked an opposite-field solo homer to right, his second opposite field dinger in as many days, to bring Albuquerque to within 9-6.

BASTARDO BACK ON THE BUMP IN 'BURQUE: Left-hander Alberto Bastardo takes the mound for his first start of 2011, the third straight season he's seen time in an Isotopes uniform. After making one relief appearance for the 'Topes in 2009, Bastardo joined Albuquerque on June 10 of last season and was hot out of the gate, winning his first three decisions (including both of his first two starts at home) while posting a 3.12 ERA over his first four career Triple-A starts. As the season wore on, however, Triple-A hitters eventually caught up with the young left-hander, especially at Isotopes Park. In his last three starts at home last year, Bastardo went 0-3 with a 39.46 ERA (19 ER / 4.1 IP). Although he started the season on the Ogden roster, Bastardo essentially begins the 2011 season at the Triple-A level for the first time in his career.

THE BEAR NECESSITIES: For the first time in 2011, the Isotopes welcome the Iowa Cubs to Albuquerque for a four-game series and if history is any indication, the games should be hard fought, and high-scoring. Last year, the Isotopes went 7-9 against the I-Cubs, actually faring better on the road (4-4) than at home (3-5). In those eight games at Isotopes Park last year, the two teams averaged a total of 19 runs per game. All-time, the 'Topes are 61-67 vs. the I-Cubs, while posting a 35-29 mark at home.

HOFF PICKS UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF: The reigning PCL hit-king Jamie Hoffmann has wasted little time getting back into the groove. In four games played so far this young season, Hoffmann has already collected five hits in 11 at-bats (a .455 average), the second-most knocks on the team to Jerry Sands' six. Last year Hoffmann led the PCL with 169 hits.

BULLIES: The Isotopes' bullpen has continued to be strong through the season's first four games. The 'pen has posted a 1.92 ERA so far this year, allowing just four earned runs even with an increased work-load. 'Topes relievers have logged a third of an inning more than the starters have so far (18.2 to 18.1).

HOT DOG HANKERINGS: Time to search the closet for the sweat pants and put off that gastric bypass surgery until tomorrow because tonight is the first 50-Cent Hot Dog Night of the season. In fact, for the first time in team history the Isotopes will be holding three such nights this year, (April 11, May 23, and August 22). The Isotopes' season-opening homestand continues with games against Iowa tomorrow and Wednesday before wrapping up with the first business person's special / School Day Matinee on Thursday.

TODAY'S START: Left-hander Alberto Bastardo takes the mound for his first start of the season after splitting last year between Albuquerque and Chattanooga. Bastardo has now spent parts of each of the last three seasons with the Isotopes.

2010: Split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 12-8 with a 5.68 ERA in 27 starts... tied for the Dodger organizational lead with 12 wins and 27 starts... won the May Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga, going 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/31.2 IP) in five starts in the month... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of May 17-23, going 2-0 and allowing only an unearned run with 14 strikeouts in 14.0 innings in his two starts... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on May 17 at Mobile before giving up a one-out single... ended up pitching seven shutout innings, giving up the one hit while walking two and striking out seven in a 7-0 Lookouts win... transferred to Albuquerque on June 10 and won three straight decisions... transferred back to Chattanooga on August 13 and finished the year in Chattanooga... following the season, played for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Winter League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Saw action in 2009 at three levels of Dodgers system, starting in Single-A Inland Empire, stoppnig at Double-A Chattanooga and ending the season with an appearance at Triple-A Albuquerque... combined to go 12-5 with a 4.01 ERA (66 ER / 148.1 IP) in all three stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA (32 ER / 75.0 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... selected to the California League Mid-Season All-Star team on June 23... transferred to Chattanooga on June 25 and went 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA (34 ER / 72.1 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... tossed a complete-game on August 5 vs. West Tenn., allowing two runs on three hits in nine innings while striking out eight... transferred to Albuquerque on September 6 and made a relief appearance in the last game of the regular season at Iowa on September 7, firing a scoreless inning... was on the Isotopes' playoff roster and was slated to start game four of the first round but did not pitch as the 'Topes were swept in three games.

Spent the entire 2008 season with Single-A Inland Empire of the California League, going 5-8 with a 5.19 ERA (76 ER / 131.2 IP) in 30 appearances (21 starts)... went 5-8 with a 4.70 ERA (55 ER / 105.1 IP) in 21 starts and 0-0 with a 7.18 ERA (21 ER / 26.1 IP) in nine relief appearances... following the season, played in the Venezuelan Winter League for Caribe and Margarita.

Played the entire 2007 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 6-5 with a 4.57 ERA (35 ER / 69.0 IP) in 16 appearances (13 starts)... was 5-2 with a $2.89\ ERA\ (15\ ER\ /\ 46.2\ IP)$ at home and 1-3 with an $8.06\ ERA\ (20\ ER\ /\ 22.1$ IP) on the road... posted a 3-1 record and a 2.08 ERA (5 ER / 21.2 IP) in four starts in the month of June... held opposing batters to a .218 average over that span... spent two stints on the DL (lasting a month apiece) with a leg injury... played for Caribes in the Venezuelan Winter League.
