'TOPES ENDURE INJURIES, CUBS IN 10-7 WIN: Despite losing three players to injury and having to play a pitcher in right field for three innings, the Albuquerque Isotopes managed to persevere and earn a hard-fought 10-7 win over the Iowa Cubs Wednesday night at Isotopes Park. Everything was going fine for Albuquerque until the fourth, when Justin Sellers was hit by a pitch in the right hand, forcing him to leave the game with a contusion. Three batters later, Juan Castro strained his left oblique fouling off a pitch and also had to be removed from the game. J.D. Closser was moved from catcher to third to fill in for Castro, but ended up taking a hard hit grounder to the eye in the seventh, forcing his removal from the game. As a result of the injuries, Albuquerque was forced to play the remainder of the game with Jerry Sands at third, where he had played once prior in his professional career, and pitcher Tim Redding in right field. Luckily for the Isotopes, they were able to stay healthy long enough to build a healthy lead. After Sands and Closser roped back-to-back singles in the bottom of the second, Trayvon Robinson hammered a three-run shot to left center, his second three-run bomb in as many nights, to give the 'Topes a quick 3-0 lead. Trent Oeltjen joined the hit-parade in the third, crushing a solo homer that extended the advantage to 4-0 and proved to be a prelude to a huge night for the Australian native. Iowa plated a pair of runs in the top of the fourth to draw within 4-2, but Albuquerque responded in the bottom of the frame, even amidst the injuries, to take a commanding lead. Closser and Robinson ignited the rally with back-to-back singles to lead off the inning before Sellers was beamed and replaced by pinch-runner Joe Becker to load the bases. Reliever Francisco Felix then smashed a two-run single to left, putting the Isotopes on top 6-2. Dee Gordon followed with an RBI fielder's choice to make the score 7-2 before Oeltjen belted a two-run homer deep over the fence in right to give Albuquerque the 9-2 advantage. The Cubs scored one in the fifth, but even with a two homer night, Oeltjen wasn't finished, adding an RBI single in the sixth to put the Isotopes on top 10-3. Iowa would keep chipping away, plating a run in the seventh, two in the eighth, and one more in the ninth to draw within three, but the 'Topes would hang on for the 10-7 win.

RANDY'S READY: Randy Keisler makes his second start for the Isotopes this season coming off a tough-luck no-decision in his 'Topes debut on April 9 vs. Omaha. The left-hander fired five strong frames, allowing the Storm Chasers just two runs, one earned, on five hits, while walking one and striking two. When Keisler left the game, he had a 3-2 lead, but Omaha tied the game with a run in the top of the eighth and plated seven in the 10th to cruise to an eventual 10-4 win. The final result notwithstanding, Keisler pitched well enough to grab the victory. As it stands, his next triumph will be his first in affiliated baseball since August 3, 2008 when he was pitching for Norfolk.

BRING OUT THE BROOM?: The Isotopes today have a chance to complete their first four-game series sweep of the season and their first sweep since July 16-19, 2009 when they took four in a row from the New Orleans Zephyrs at Isotopes Park. The last time Albuquerque swept the I-Cubs was June 30-July 3 2007, also at Isotopes Park.

DOUBLE-DOWN TRENT: After getting off to a 1-and-10 start, Trent Oeltjen has been scorching hot, going 5-for-7 with four runs scored, three homers, and eight RBI in his last two games. As a result, the outfielder has raised his average on the season from .100 to .353 in just two days. Last night, Oeltjen belted two homers in a game for the first time since he hit two for Reno in the Diamondbacks organization on June 30, 2009 vs. Tacoma.

INJURY UPDATE: With the all bumps and bruises the 'Topes have incurred of late, it's amazing there have been no broken bones. Russ Mitchell, who was hit by a pitch on the left forearm on Tuesday, has responded well to treatment and could be back as early as this weekend in Oklahoma City. Sellers also was hit by a pitch but did not suffer a break, which means he could be out just a few days. Closser is also considered day-to-day with a black left eye and Castro's strained left oblique is being examined further and appears at the outset to be the most serious of the bunch, meaning a possible trip to the Disabled List.

SET YOUR ALARMS FOR A.M. BASEBALL!: The 'Topes today are holding their first School Day Matinee/Business Person's Special of the 2011 season, which features an earlier than usual start time. First pitch is scheduled for 11:05 AM, making it first game played before at Isotopes Park in team history.

TODAY'S START: Randy Keisler takes the mound for his second start of the season after a solid outing on April 9 vs. Omaha when he allowed two runs, one earned, on five hits in five innings while walking one and striking out two. He left the game with a 2-1 lead, but Omaha tied the game in the eighth and scored seven in the 10th to take a 10-4 victory. Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3.

2010: Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlantic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings... opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore... went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

Starte the 2006 season at Triple-A Sacramento... won three consecutive starts, going 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER / 18.0 IP) from April 22 to May 2... contract was selected on May 12 and made 11 relief appearances with the A's before being optioned on June 9... had a four-game winning streak from July 4 to August 11... recalled on July 26 and optioned again on July 28... outrighted to Sacramento on August 8.

In 2005, began the season at Triple-A Louisville... named International Pitcher of the Week from April 18 to April 24... had his contract selected on May 23 and appeared in 24 games (four starts) for the Reds... was 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA (3 ER / 14.0 IP) in four appearances from May 24 to June 7... had career-high six strikeouts and homered off Mark Hendrickson for first Major League home run on June 7 vs. Tampa Bay... placed on Disabled List with left elbow inflammation from June 20 to July 15... did not allow a run in five of seven appearances from August 19 to September 20.
