ISOTOPES HANDCUFFED BY 'HAWKS 7-4: The powerful Albuquerque Isotopes offense ran into a trio of hot pitchers as the Oklahoma City RedHawks stymied the 'Topes for a 7-4 series-opening win Friday night at Bricktown Ballpark. The game didn't appear to be a pitching masterpiece early, as the 'Topes surged to a quick 3-0 lead in the top of the first inning. With runners on first and second, Jerry Sands roped a single to right, easily plating Dee Gordon and putting the Isotopes on the board, 1-0. Russ Mitchell added an RBI single scoring Jamie Hoffmann before Joe Becker capped the rally with a single that sent home Sands and increased the early Albuquerque lead to 3-0. The advantage would prove brief, as Oklahoma City rallied for three of its own in the bottom of the frame on an RBI triple by Tommy Manzella and a two-run homer by Kody Clemens, son of former big league pitcher Roger Clemens, that knotted the game at 3-3 after one. Albuquerque led off the second inning with two straight singles before RedHawks starter Fernando Nieve took over, retiring the next 13 Isotopes in a row, seven by strikeout. Sergio Escalona took over with one out in the sixth and continued to dominate, retiring five straight 'Topes, three of them by strikeout, before the string was finally broken when Escalona hit Hoffmann with a pitch leading off the eighth. Oklahoma City's offense grabbed a lead in the fifth when Brian Bogusevic hit an RBI double to give the home team a 4-3 edge. Clemens then crushed a double to left, plating Bogusevic and increasing the lead to 5-3. One inning later, Oklahoma City would tack on two insurance runs but the 'Topes would add one more run in the eighth thanks to the red-hot Sands, who smashed his fifth home run of the young season to cut the advantage to just three at 7-4.

MR. VERSATILITY: Tim Redding makes the start hoping to rebound from a tough outing in his Isotopes debut on April 10 vs. Omaha when he allowed nine runs, the most by a 'Topes pitcher so far this season, on eight hits in four innings while walking three and striking out five in a 9-6 Isotopes loss. Between starts, Redding has still found a way to get into the box score, showing the versatility of a little leaguer who plays every position on the diamond. On April 13, when the Isotopes lost three infielders due to injury, Redding entered the game and played right field. The next day, with the 'Topes still short-handed, he made a pinch-hit appearance, meaning in just a four-game span, Redding has appeared as a starting pitcher, rightfielder, and pinch-hitter.

TRIPLE-A, SHMIPLE-A: Dee Gordon and Jerry Sands, both of whom are making their Triple-A debuts this season, have been making the jump to the highest classification in Minor League Baseball look awfully easy. Gordon has hit in every game he's played, eight straight, batting .342 (13x38) while tying for the PCL lead with 11 runs scored. He's tied with Sands, who has hit in every game period, a span of nine straight in which he's batting .432 (16x37). Sands also leads the circuit in homers (five), RBI (17), hits (16), and total bases (35).

WALKIN' ON SUNSHINE: Albuquerque plays its third day game of the 2011 season hoping to turn around a day-time losing streak. The Isotopes have dropped their two previous games played in the sunshine, allowing a combined total of 19 runs in the two contests.

STAYING OFFENSIVE: With 74 runs scored, the Isotopes have plated more players than any other team in the PCL so far this season. While that's not particularly surprising, what is notable is that it's not even close. The next closest team is Colorado Springs with 62, a dozen runs fewer than the 'Topes through just nine games played.

'TOPES ON THE MEND: Slowly but surely, the ailing Isotopes are getting healthy. Russ Mitchell started last night's game, his first action since getting hit by a pitch on the left forearm last Tuesday. Good news also for Damaso Espino, who started at catcher yesterday just one day after a scary incident that saw him get hit in the helmet with a pitch. Either today or Monday will also see the return of JD Closser and Justin Sellers, who are steadily improving from a black eye and bruised right hand, respectively. Unfortunately, John Lindsey was placed on the DL yesterday to allow his strained calf to heal.

DAY OFF!: Tomorrow the Isotopes will get a rare, mid-series day off due to the University of Oklahoma, Oklahoma State Bedlam Baseball Series which will take place at Bricktown Ballpark on Saturday night and Sunday afternoon. The 'Topes and 'Hawks will resume play on Monday, April 18.

TODAY'S START: Tim Redding makes his second start of the season coming off a loss in his first outing on April 10 vs. Omaha when he yielded nine runs on eight hits in four innings while walking three and striking out five in a 9-6 'Topes loss.

Made an appearance in right field on April 13 vs. Iowa when the Isotopes ran out of position players due to injuries. Played three innings at the position but did not face any chances. Also made one appearance as a pinch-hitter on April 14 vs. Iowa (grounded out to third).

2010: Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Rockies organization and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the New York (AL) organization... allowed just four home runs in 109.0 combined innings... opened the season with Colorado Springs, making five starts before his release on May 6... signed by the Yankees on May 13 and assigned to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre... in 13 games (12 starts) with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, limited opposing hitters to a .221 average (68x307), including a .189 mark against right-handers (30x159)... finished the season on a five-game winning streak, going 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA (4 ER / 43.1 IP) over six games (five starts) from July 4 to July 31... released by the Yankees on August 5 and finished the season with the Samsung Lions in the Korea Baseball Organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the 2009 season in New York (NL) organization, making 30 appearances (17 starts) for the Mets... made two starts in Spring Training on March 8 and March 12 before landing on the 15-Day Disabled List April 5th (retroactive to March 27th) with a strained right rotator cuff... had two rehabilitation starts (no decisions) with Triple-A Buffalo... made his Mets debut on May 18 at Los Angeles (NL) after being activated from the 15-Day DL earlier in the day... picked up his first hit in a Mets uniform, a single to right field in the fifth inning... picked up his first win as a member of the Mets on June 22 at home vs. St. Louis... tied his season-high with 7.0 innings and allowed 4 runs and 5 hits (the last Mets pitcher to go winless in his first six starts was Hideo Nomo in 1998)... moved to the bullpen after his start on July 2 in Pittsburgh... as a reliever, compiled a 5.63 ERA (15 ER / 24.0 IP) in 13 games and lost his only decision... moved back to the rotation for a start on August 22 vs. Philadelphia... in his first two starts after moving back into the rotation, he was 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA (3 ER / 11.2 IP).

Established career highs in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts with the Washington Nationals in 2008... following the season, had calcium deposit removed from the joint of his second toe on his left foot... finished tied for ninth in the NL with 33 starts... did not miss his turn in the rotation the entire season... matched his career-high in wins with 10 (also won 10 games for Houston in 2003)... became first Nats pitcher to record double figures in victories since the 2006 season... Washington went 20-13 in his starts...in his first start of the year, went 7.0 innings to beat the Phillies, 1-0, at Citizens Bank Park on April 2... established career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a 6-4 victory at Florida on April 18... threw career-best 8.0 innings, his first Major League complete game, in a 1-0 loss on July 24 at San Francisco.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Timothy James Redding... is married to Jaime with a daughter, Shea (11/13/01), and son, Brennan (9/15/03)... graduated from Monroe Community College in Rochester, NY, where his No. 17 jersey became the first in school history to be retired on Feb. 1, 2008... his great aunt, Joyce Randolph, played Trixie Norton on the Honeymooners.
