HOMERS RALLY 'TOPES PAST REDHAWKS 6-5: The Albuquerque Isotopes used a pair of dramatic, late-inning home runs by Russ Mitchell and Trent Oeltjen to erase a two-run deficit and overcome the Oklahoma City RedHawks by the score of 6-5 on a beautiful Saturday afternoon at Bricktown Ballpark. Down 5-3 in the eighth inning, the 'Topes started their comeback when Jamie Hoffmann roped a one-out double in front of Mitchell, who belted a two-run shot to left, his first of the year, to bring Albuquerque instantly into a 5-5 tie. The long ball momentum was carried into the ninth, when Oeltjen, who was a late defensive replacement for Jay Gibbons in left, led off the inning with a solo homer to right, giving Albuquerque the improbable 6-5 lead. Lefty Scott Elbert would make sure the lead held in the bottom of the ninth. After surrendering a lead-off walk, Elbert coaxed a double-play and a pop-out to short to seal the win and earn his first save of the season. While Albuquerque's comeback reached its climax in the late innings, the 'Topes had to chip away at a RedHawks lead throughout the entire contest. After the Isotopes scored a run in the third on a sacrifice fly by Dee Gordon to take a 1-0 lead, the 'Hawks roared back with a run in the fourth and three in the fifth to grab the 4-1 advantage. The 'Topes responded in the sixth in a rally ignited by a one-out walk to Jerry Sands, who was immediately followed by a single from Hoffmann. Mitchell then drew another walk to load the bases for Trayvon Robinson, who smashed a two-run single to left, bringing Albuquerque back to within a single run at 4-3. Oklahoma City seemed to add an insurance run in the seventh when Locke added an RBI single to make the score 5-3 RedHawks, which ultimately only served to give Albuquerque another run to erase in the eighth.

ALBERTO BACK IN ACTION: It's been six full days, but left-hander Alberto Bastardo is back on the mound looking to follow up on a terrific outing on April 11. Due to the return of John Ely to the rotation and the scheduled off day yesterday, Bastardo has had six days of rest to get ready for tonight's start. In his last outing, the left-hander allowed the Iowa Cubs just one run on three hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out two in a game eventually won by the 'Topes in walk-off fashion in the 10th, 6-5. Bastardo was particularly tough on lefties, allowing just one hit in seven at-bats (.143 average) while walking one and striking out one

OELTJEN'S POWER SURGE: In 49 games with the Isotopes last year, Trent Oeltjen belted five home runs, a total he's almost eclipsed in just the span of five games this season. With his eventual game-winning homer on Saturday, Oeltjen has now hammered four

homers in five games beginning on April 12, second-most on the team to Jerry Sands's five. After a slow start in which he went hitless in his first three games. Oeltjen has gone 7-for-19 (.368) in his last six contests.

CLOSS IS BOSS: Not even a black eye can slow down JD Closser who continues to start the 2011 campaign at a torrid pace. Closser has gotten a hit in each of the five games he's played this year, accumulating multiple hits in each of his last three, a span in which he's gone 8-for-12. On the season, the veteran catcher is batting .588 (10x17) with four runs, two doubles, and an RBI

FIRST KNOCK: Congratulations to former Isotope Ivan DeJesus, Jr., who got his first Major League hit on Saturday in the Dodgers' 9-2 loss to the St. Louis Cardinals. In the seventh inning, DeJesus Jr. came on as a pinch-hitter and ripped a single off Kyle McClellan for his first big league knock.

TRON GONE: Right before Saturday's game, reliever Ramon Troncoso was called up to the Dodgers, replacing Hong-Chih Kuo, who was placed on the Disabled List with a stiff back. Troncoso was thrown right into the fire that night against the Cardinals, entering the game in the eighth and allowing three runs on seven hits in two innings. The season is just 10 games old, but already the Isotopes have had four players get called up to Los Angeles this year (John Ely, Ivan DeJesus Jr., Jamie Hoffmann, and now Troncoso).

EASTER WEEKEND AT THE LAB: Make plans to spend Easter Weekend at Isotopes Park, as the 'Topes will be hosting a number of great promotions. The fun starts on Saturday with the first fireworks show of the season and continues with a pre-game Easter egg hunt for the kids on Sunday. The short homestand also features a business person's special on Tuesday.

TODAY'S START: Left-hander Alberto Bastardo makes the start after six days of rest due to the return of starter John Ely to the rotation and Sunday's scheduled off day. In his last outing Bastardo was excellent, allowing one run on three hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out two in a 6-5 Isotopes 10-inning, walk-off win.

2010: Split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 12-8 with a 5.68 ERA in 27 starts... tied for the Dodger organizational lead with 12 wins and 27 starts... won the May Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga, going 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/31.2 IP) in five starts in the month... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of May 17-23, going 2-0 and allowing only an unearned run with 14 strikeouts in 14.0 innings in his two starts... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on May 17 at Mobile before giving up a one-out single... ended up pitching seven shutout innings, giving up the one hit while walking two and striking out seven in a 7-0 Lookouts win... transferred to Albuquerque on June 10 and won three straight decisions... transferred back to Chattanooga on August 13 and finished the year in Chattanooga... following the season, played for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Winter League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Saw action in 2009 at three levels of Dodgers system, starting in Single-A Inland Empire, stoppnig at Double-A Chattanooga and ending the season with an appearance at Triple-A Albuquerque... combined to go 12-5 with a 4.01 ERA (66 ER / 148.1 IP) in all three stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA (32 ER / 75.0 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... selected to the California League Mid-Season All-Star team on June 23... transferred to Chattanooga on June 25 and went 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA (34 ER / 72.1 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... tossed a complete-game on August 5 vs. West Tenn., allowing two runs on three hits in nine innings while striking out eight... transferred to Albuquerque on September 6 and made a relief appearance in the last game of the regular season at Iowa on September 7, firing a scoreless inning... was on the Isotopes' playoff roster and was slated to start game four of the first round but did not pitch as the 'Topes were swept in three games.
