ISOTOPES, I-CUBS POSTPONED: Rain and freezing temperatures in Des Moines, Iowa have postponed the opening game of the Albuquerque Isotopes' series with the Iowa Cubs Tuesday evening at Principal Park. After taking two of three games at Oklahoma City, the 'Topes arrived in Des Moines early Tuesday morning to a steady freezing drizzle and the threat of snow, making the thought of starting the series as scheduled impossible.

DOUBLE-E'S ON THE MOUND: Left-hander Dana Eveland takes the mound in the first game of today's doubleheader looking to become the first Isotope in team history to win each of his first three starts to begin the season. In his last outing on April 12 against Iowa at Isotopes Park, Eveland allowed just three runs on six hits in seven innings, the longest a 'Topes starter has gone all season, in an 18-3 drubbing of the Cubs. In the second game, right-hander John Ely will go for his first win as an Isotope in 2011 after taking a loss in his first outing of the season on April 15 when he allowed seven runs, five earned, on 11 hits in six innings in a 7-4 'Topes loss in Oklahoma City. Not only is the right-hander looking for his first win in 2011, he's looking to break a streak in which he's lost six straight decisions between stops with the Isotopes and Dodgers dating back to last year. Ely's last victory at either level was August 29, 2010 when he had an excellent outing at home against Oklahoma City.

LET'S PLAY TWO!!!: Albuquerque will play its first doubleheader of the season today to make up yesterday's postponement. The last time the Isotopes played a doubleheader in Iowa was on July 6 of last year when the 'Topes swept two games from the Cubs, 6-5, 5-0, which also is the last time Albuquerque swept a twin-bill. All-time, the Isotopes have played three doubleheaders in Des Moines, going 3-3.

TRAY BIEN: Outfielder Trayvon Robinson has been heating up at the plate, collecting hits in each of his last five games, a span in which he's gone 8-for-22 (.364 average). Not only has Robinson gotten hits, he's been productive as well. In his last five contests, he's driven in eight runs and scored six more. He is currently tied with Trent Oeltjen with nine runs scored for second-most on the Isotopes, behind only Dee Gordon's 12.

WELCOME MR. SMITH: Any thoughts of an offensive drop-off with the departure of Jerry Sands to the Dodgers were quickly dispelled by the auspicious Isotopes debut of Corey Smith, who went a perfect 4-for-4 with a double and three RBI in his first game in an Albuquerque uniform. Smith joins Dee Gordon as the only Isotopes to have reached four hits in a game this season. Smith, who was a first-round pick (26th overall) of the Cleveland Indians in 2000, comes in with a lot of experience but not at the Triple-A level. He has played 1,226 Minor League games in his 11-year career but only seven at Triple-A, a stint for Salt Lake in 2008 that included just 23 at-bats.

A SANDS SENSATION: Jerry Sands has taken Hollywood by storm. In two games with the Dodgers since his call-up from the Isotopes on Monday, Sands has gone 2-for-7 with two doubles and two RBI while making a pair of starts in left field.

EASTER WEEKEND AT THE LAB: Make plans to spend Easter Weekend at Isotopes Park, as the 'Topes will be hosting a number of great promotions. The fun starts on Saturday with the first fireworks show of the season and continues with a pre-game Easter egg hunt for the kids on Sunday. The short homestand also features a business person's special on Tuesday.

TODAY'S START: Lefty Dana Eveland makes the Game One start trying to become the first pitcher in Isotopes history to win his first three starts of the season. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph. Followed that up with a victory over Iowa on April 12 when he pitched 7.0 innings, the longest outing by an Isotopes pitcher so far this season, allowing three runs on six hits while walking one and striking out five in an 18-3 'Topes win.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances... A's were 5-4 (.556) in his starting assignments... tossed more than 5.0 innings in just one of his nine starts, allowed three runs or more seven times and walked three or more six times... first batters faced were 1-for-3 with a walk in his four relief appearances... with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation... compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland... married... graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.

TODAY'S START: John Ely looks to get his first win of the season in Game Two after losing his first start for the Isotopes on April 15 after allowing seven runs, five earned, on 11 hits in six innings while walking two and striking out three in a 7-4 Isotopes defeat. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Enjoyed a breakout 2009 season in his first year at Double-A with Birmingham in the Chicago White Sox organization, going 14-2 with a 2.82 ERA (49 ER / 156.1 IP) in 27 starts... tied for first in the Southern League with 14 wins and was first in strikeouts with 125... ranked third in the SL in ERA and second in innings-pitched (156.1)... was also third in the league in WHIP (1.22) and fifth in average against (.241)... averaged 7.20 strikeouts / nine-innings, third most in the SL while allowing 11 base-runners / nine-innings, third fewest in the circuit... overall, limited right-handed hitters to a .217 average (70x322)... named Southern League Mid-Season All-Star on July 13... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on July 20... named to the Southern League Post-Season All-Star team on August 31... traded from the White Sox with right-hander Jon Link for outfielder Juan Pierre on December 18.

Spent the entire 2008 season with Single-A Winston-Salem, going 10-12 with a 4.71 ERA (76 ER / 145.1 IP)... ranked among organizational leaders in strikeouts (2nd, 134), IP (5th, 145.1) and wins (T-7th, 10)... ranked among organizational leaders in strikeouts (second, 134), innings pitched (5th, 145.1) and wins (tied for seventh, 10) in 27 starts.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game... selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
