# ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (12-8) AT NASHVILLE SOUNDS (8-12)

ISOTOPES SLIP SOUNDS 5-1: Starting pitcher Tim Redding enjoyed his best outing of the season by far, and was bolstered by a pair of home runs, as the Albuquerque Isotopes earned a 5-1 series-opening win over the Nashville Sounds Thursday night at Greer Stadium. The big league veteran Redding was in control from the outset, scattering three hits through the first five shutout innings while retiring 10 of 11 batters from the second frame to the fifth. Redding (1-2) tossed an efficient 79 pitches on the night, 53 of them for strikes while earning his first victory of the season and breaking a personal two-game losing streak. Albuquerque got on the scoreboard in the top of the fourth, when Corey Smith hammered a two-out solo home run to center that broke a scoreless tie and handed the Isotopes a 1-0 lead. The one run cushion would be doubled with one swing of the bat, as Jay Gibbons belted a two-out solo blast to right that extended the advantage to 2-0. Nashville answered in the bottom of the sixth with its only run of the contest when Brendan Katin led off the frame with a double, advanced to third on a groundout and scored on a sacrifice fly to trim the 'Topes lead to 2-1. A pitcher's duel would turn into a comfortable Albuquerque win in the ninth, however, as the Isotopes added three insurance runs to put the game out of reach. With the bases loaded and two out, pinch-hitter J.D. Closser drew a walk, plating Smith and extending the lead to 3-1 'Topes. After Dee Gordon reached on a fielding error that allowed another run to score, Trayvon Robinson capped the inning with an RBI single, giving the Isotopes a 5-1 lead.

THE VENZUELAN VORTEX: Left-hander Alberto Bastardo, a native of Aragua, Venezuela, takes the mound looking to win his second straight start after earning a solid win in his last outing on April 23 vs. New Orleans at Isotopes Park. In that performance, Bastardo allowed the Z's just four runs on nine hits in six strong innings while striking out a season-high seven and walking none. While that was the south-paw's first victory, Bastardo has given his team a chance to win in all three of his outings so far this season. The Isotopes are a perfect 3-0 in games Bastardo has started, the best record among all 'Topes starting pitchers.

THE STREAK: In the eighth inning of last night's game, Robinson came to the plate having gone 0-and-3 and quite possibly facing his last at-bat and promptly roped a single to left-center, extending his team-high hitting streak to 14 straight games. Robinson is now tied with four other players for the second-longest batting streak in the PCL this season behind Reno's Wily Mo Pena, who had a 16-game hitting streak end yesterday. Robinson's current 18-game on-base streak (he's gotten on base in every game he's played so far at the Triple-A level) is also tied for second in the PCL, behind Las Vegas' David Cooper, who has reached base in 20 straight games. Over the course of his hitting streak,

which began on April 12, Robinson is batting .411 (23x56) with 13 runs, a double, two triples, four homers, and 19 RBI. This is also Robinson's longest streak in his career, having blown by his previous high of 10 games, set three different times.

THE GREAT GIBBY: The days of Jay Gibbons in an Isotopes uniform may be numbered as the outfielder has been heating up. In the last four games of his Major League rehab assignment, Gibbons has racked up seven hits in 18 at-bats (.389 average) with four runs, a double, and three RBI. Last night Gibbons belted the first home run of his rehab assignment in a place that doesn't give up dingers easily, blasting a solo homer to the opposite field. In 11 total games with the Isotopes, Gibbons is batting .310 (13x42) with nine runs, two doubles, a home run, and nine RBI

**GREAT STARTS:** After a slow start to the season, Isotopes starting pitchers are starting to settle in. In the last three games, 'Topes starters have gone 2-0 with a 2.64 ERA (5 ER / 17.0 IP). As goes the rotation, so goes the pitching staff as a whole, as Albuquerque's team ERA has gone from 5.66 to 5.40 in just three games.

ON A ROLL: For the second time this season, the Isotopes have won three games in a row, with the last coming in three straight home wins from April 11 to April 13 vs. Iowa. If the 'Topes win tonight, it would be their longest winning streak of the 2011 season.

BARK IN THE PARK: The Isotopes are teaming up with Animal Humane of New Mexico to bring "Bark In The Park" to The Lab on a busy Mother's Day on Sunday, May 8. Fans can bring their four-legged pals to enjoy a 'Topes game from the Creamland Berm, where Animal Humane will set up water stations and waste receptacles. Dogs must arrive with proof of rabies vaccination, identification, valid license and must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older.
