ISOTOPES SUCCUMB TO SOUNDS 7-6: The Albuquerque Isotopes held a lead for eight innings until the Nashville Sounds rallied for two runs and a 7-6 victory Saturday night at Greer Stadium. For the third straight game in this series, the Isotopes drew first blood, plating a pair of runs in the top of the second. With the bases loaded and nobody out, pitcher Francisco Felix lifted a sacrifice fly to right, plating Trent Oeltjen and giving Albuquerque a 1-0 lead. Dee Gordon followed with a single to left, sending home Damaso Espino and boosting the lead to 2-0 'Topes. The visitors added another tally in the third when Espino lined a single to right, scoring Jamie Hoffmann and boosting the lead to 3-0 Albuquerque, but Nashville answered emphatically in the bottom of the frame on a two-run homer by Mat Gamel, cutting the three-run deficit to 3-2. Oeltjen ignited the next Isotopes rally in the top of the fifth with a one-out double and was immediately cashed in when Espino jacked a two-run homer to left, extending the cushion back to three runs at 5-2 'Topes. Nashville again answered immediately in the bottom of the fifth on a two-out RBI double by Luis Figueroa to cut the lead to 5-3, but Albuquerque added one more tally in the top of the sixth on an RBI single by Jay Gibbons to make the score 6-3 Albuquerque. The rest of the game belonged to the Sounds, who scored twice in the sixth on a two-run double by Gamel to trim the lead to 6-5 Albuquerque before taking the lead with two more tallies in the eighth. Brendan Katin started the game-winning rally with a solo homer to left off Albuquerque reliever Jon Link to knot the game at 6-6. Brett Carroll then drew a walk in front of the scorching hot Gamel, who smashed his third double of the night, scoring Carroll and giving Nashville its first lead of the game at 7-6.

ELY'S ELECTRIC: Making his fourth start today, right-hander John Ely is starting to find a groove, which is not good news for PCL opponents. In his last two outings Ely is 1-0 with a 2.07 ERA (3 ER / 13.0 IP), including a no-decision in his last appearance at Isotopes Park when he was as solid as it gets, allowing three runs on six hits in six innings while walking two and striking out three. The right-hander departed that outing with a 5-3 lead only to see the Zephyrs climb into an eventual 6-6 tie, forcing the Isotopes to win it in the bottom of ninth on a walk-off sacrifice fly by J.D. Closser to hand Albuquerque a 7-6 triumph. Including Ely's one-hitter at Iowa on April 20, the right-hander has given up just seven hits in his last two games, holding opponents to a .159 batting average (7x44) in that span.

STILL STREAKING!: It's now been over two weeks and the amazing hitting streak of Trayvon Robinson continues. The outfielder got a base knock in the top of the sixth inning to extend his streak to 16 games, tied with Reno's Wily Mo Pena for the longest hitting streak in the PCL this season. Throughout the streak, Robinson is batting .385 (25x65) with 13 runs, a double, two triples, four homers, and 19 RBI. The

outfielder is just three games shy of tying the franchise record of 19 games, set by Eric Reed in 2006 and equaled by Jamie Hoffmann last season. Robinson is also tied for the PCL lead for the longest consecutive on-base streak of 20 games with Las Vegas' David Cooper, who was called up to Toronto on Friday. Hitting streaks seem to be pervasive throughout the Dodgers system as Andre Ethier has hit in 26 straight games for Los Angeles.

SEARCHING FOR A SERIES WIN: A win today would give the 'Topes their fourth series win of the season, second on the road, and second in a row. This year Albuquerque has won every series its played but two, a series-split vs. Omaha to open the season from April 7-10 and a series loss at Iowa from April 20-22.

MAY DAY: The 'Topes enter May riding some momentum after recording their fifth winning April and posting the third most April victories in franchise history. With an April record of 13-9, the 2011 Isotopes are behind only the 2006 team that went 17-7 in the season's first month and the 2008 club that posted a 15-10 April.

AWESOME AUSSIE: Trent Oeltjen has heated up the plate, racking up hits in each of his last five games, a stretch in which he's gone 7-for-19 (.368) with a double and a triple. The Australian has quietly racked up the second most extra base hits on the Isotopes with eight, behind only Jamie Hoffmann's nine.

BARK IN THE PARK: The Isotopes are teaming up with Animal Humane of New Mexico to bring "Bark In The Park" to The Lab on a busy Mother's Day on Sunday, May 8. Fans can bring their four-legged pals to enjoy a 'Topes game from the Creamland Berm, where Animal Humane will set up water stations and waste receptacles. Dogs must arrive with proof of rabies vaccination, identification, valid license and must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older.

TODAY'S START: John Ely takes the hill for his fourth start of the season coming off a solid no-decision on April 25 vs. New Orleans, when he allowed just three runs on six hits in six innings while walking two and striking out three in an eventual 7-6 Isotopes win.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Enjoyed a breakout 2009 season in his first year at Double-A with Birmingham in the Chicago White Sox organization, going 14-2 with a 2.82 ERA (49 ER / 156.1 IP) in 27 starts... tied for first in the Southern League with 14 wins and was first in strikeouts with 125... named Southern League Mid-Season All-Star on July 13... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on July 20...named to the Southern League Post-Season All-Star team on August 31... traded from the White Sox with right-hander Jon Link for outfielder Juan Pierre on December 18

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/ Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
