‘TOPES BLANKED BY 51S, 7-0: For the first time all season, the Albuquerque Isotopes’ offense was held in check as the Las Vegas 51s blanked the ‘Topes 7-0 for a series-opening win Tuesday night at Cashman Field. Vegas starter Luis Perez was dominant, scattering five hits in eight innings while walking one and striking out six to earn the victory. At one point Perez retired eight Isotopes in a row and allowed just three balls to leave the infield his entire outing. Albuquerque was undermined by some shaky defense, committing three errors on the night that led to four unearned runs. One of the three tallies that was earned came in the bottom of the second when Adam Loewen led off the inning with a solo homer to put the 51s on the board 1-0. Las Vegas seized control of the game in the fourth in a rally that was aided by some sloppy ‘Topes play. Jason Lane started the uprising with a lead-off double before going to third on a groundout and scoring on a sacrifice fly by Ryan Budde to boost the lead to 2-0 51s. After back-to-back singles and a walk loaded the bases, Jonathan Diaz hit a grounder that was misplayed by shortstop Dee Gordon, allowing Brian Jeroloman to race home and make the score 3-0. Brett Lawrie capped the frame with a two-run single, padding the advantage to 5-0 Las Vegas. The 51s put the game on ice in the eighth, plating two more runs. With the bases loaded and one out, Diaz hit a perfect double-play ball to third, but as the ball was coming around the horn, second baseman Eugenio Velez’s relay to first was airmailed into the first base dugout, allowing two more runs to score and send Las Vegas coasting to a 7-0 win.

FINDING FELIX: Right-hander Francisco Felix makes the start coming off his longest outing of the season on May 6 vs. Memphis at Isotopes Park when he grinded through six innings, allowing seven runs on nine hits while walking two and striking out five. While his final line appears as if he struggled, a closer look reveals that most of the damage came in a five-run Memphis second and after that, Felix authored three shutout frames to keep Albuquerque in the game, which the ‘Topes eventually won 8-7. The resilient right-hander finished his outing tossing 94 pitches, 60 of them for strikes (or 64%), his most efficient start all season.

NOBODY’S PERFECT: Over their last three games, the Isotopes have committed nine errors, bringing their total number of miscues in the month of May to 16, the most in the PCL for the month (Tucson is second with 12). In fact, in nine games played this month, Albuquerque has played flawless baseball just twice (May 5 and May 7). On the season, the ‘Topes are tied with Sacramento for the second most errors with 37, behind Tucson, Colorado Springs, and Tacoma, who each have 38, but the Isotopes are last in the PCL in fielding percentage with a mark of .969.

SHOOTING BLANKS: Last night was not only the first time the Isotopes had been shutout in a game in 2011, it was one of the few times Albuquerque plated fewer than three runs. In their 31 total games played so far this year, the ‘Topes have scored three runs or fewer just four times, going 1-3 in those contests. Even with the shutout, 200 runs this year, third most to Reno (240) and Colorado Springs (190), averaging 6.5 runs a contest. Last year the Isotopes were shutout four times.

IN A CLOSS BY HIMSELF: Of the six hits the Isotopes were able to eke out last night, two belonged to J.D. Closser, who continues a solid season that has him batting .306 (19x62) on the year. While his bat certainly helps, Closser’s versatility has also been valuable. Although a catcher by trade, Closser has not started at the position since April 25, appearing in nine games at first base and one at third in the last two weeks.

BUMPS AND BRUISES: Albuquerque had a scary moment in the eighth inning of last night’s game when Corey Smith injured his hand on a base hit by Manny Mayorson. After going to the emergency room for X-Rays, it was determined Smith dislocated a finger on his left hand and there was thankfully no fracture. The hope is that Smith won’t need a trip to the DL and should be back playing soon.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Francisco Felix makes his fourth start of the season coming off his longest outing of the year on May 6 vs. Memphis at Isotopes Park when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing seven runs on nine hits while walking two and striking five in an eventual 8-7 'Topes win. Pitched 4.0 innings in his first start of the season on April 24 vs. New Orleans, allowing three runs on five hits in a 10-9 Isotopes loss. Prior to moving to the rotation, he made three excellent appearances out of the bullpen in which he posted a 1-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (1 ER / 5.0 IP). Joined Albuquerque on April 11 from Extended Spring Training and earned a victory in his first appearance for the 'Topes in 2011, pitching 2.1 innings of relief on April 13 vs. Iowa, allowing a run on two hits while walking one and striking out two in a 10-7 Albuquerque win.

2010: Spent the majority of the season on loan to Saltillo of the Mexican League after making his first appearance at Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee... went 1-3 with a 6.28 ERA (43 ER / 61.2 IP) in 17 games (12 starts) for Saltillo... added to Albuquerque on August 28 and made two starts for the Isotopes, going 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP)... pitched through the sixth in both outings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2009 season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 4-2 with a 3.07 ERA (26 ER / 76.2 IP) in a total of 43 appearances... started the season at Chattanooga, going 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA and two saves in 29 games... was 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER / 18.2 IP) and a save in nine appearances in May... made a pair of starts for Lookouts, his first since 2007, and went 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (3 ER / 6.2 IP)... went 3-1 with two saves and a 2.77 ERA (15 ER / 48.2 IP) while holding opponents to a .222 batting average in 27 relief appearances... transferred to Albuquerque on July 25... went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (8 ER / 21.1 IP) in 14 appearances... earned his only win for the Isotopes in the second game of a doubleheader after pitching a perfect seventh in a 2-1 Albuquerque win... his only save was of the two-inning variety on August 8 vs. Portland... pitched a 0.1 inning of scoreless relief in Game 3 of the Isotopes' playoff series vs. Memphis... pitched for Culiacan of the Mexican Winter League for the fourth straight season, going 2-1 with a 2.43 ERA (11 ER / 40.2 IP) in 32 appearances (one start).

Split 2008 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Triple-A Las Vegas, going a combined 5-4 with a 4.27 ERA and three saves in 40 total games... began season at Inland Empire, posting a 5-3 record with a 3.31 ERA and two saves... was 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA and two saves in 12 games at home, 1-2 with a 4.13 in 13 games on the road... ranked fifth among all California League relievers by holding batters to a .198 average... was 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA in seven games in June... yielded just two hits over 11 straight scoreless innings from June 6 to June 18... held left-handed hitters to a .145 average, while righties batted .238... transferred to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 8 and finished the season going 0-1 with a 5.81 ERA and a save in 15 appearances.
