ISOTOPES HIT THE JACKPOT IN VEGAS 8-3: Mired in a three-game losing streak, the Albuquerque Isotopes needed a solid performance at the plate as well as on the mound and ended up getting both in spades, cruising to an 8-3 win over the Las Vegas 51s Friday night at Cashman Field. The 'Topes wasted no time announcing that they had designs on putting to rest their losing streak, plating five runs in the top of the second in a rally that was completed entirely with two outs. With the bases loaded, Dee Gordon roped a double to right-center, plating a pair to give Albuquerque a 2-0 lead. Eugenio Velez then added his first of three knocks of the night, a single to right that easily plated two more to double the advantage to 4-0 'Topes. In error fielding Velez's base hit by right fielder Eric Thames allowed the speedy runner to cruise into second, from where he was picked up by a double from John Lindsey, putting Albuquerque on top 5-0 after two. That was more than enough for Isotopes starter Dana Eveland, who was brilliant while breaking a personal two-game losing streak of his own. The left-hander cruised through six innings, allowing just four hits and four walks while striking out one, to earn his first victory since April 26. Albuquerque tacked on another tally in the fifth and one more in the sixth on a sacrifice fly by Jamie Hoffmann to help the Isotopes open up a 7-0 cushion. Vegas would finally show signs of life in the seventh on a solo homer by Brett Lawrie, but Albuquerque seized the run right back in the top of the eighth on an RBI single by Lindsey to give the 'Topes an 8-1 lead. Las Vegas scored twice more in the bottom of the eighth, but it was merely cosmetic, as the Isotopes finished off the home team in the ninth to claim the 8-3 win.

REDDING ON A ROLL: Although his 1-1 record doesn't necessarily show it, right-hander Tim Redding has been dominant over his last three outings. Beginning with a win on April 28 at Nashville, Redding has posted a 1.00 ERA (2 ER / 18.0 IP) in his last three starts, a span in which he's allowed 17 total hits, while striking out 14 and walking just two. In fact, Redding's loss over this span is one that is undeserved, as the right-hander yielded four unearned runs in six innings of work in an eventual 11-4 defeat to the Omaha Storm Chasers. Further illustrating Redding's recent dominance, in his 18 innings of work since April 28, he has given up just four extra-base hits (three doubles and one home run).

TUCSON TIME: Tonight the Isotopes face the Tucson Padres for the first time since the franchise moved from Portland after last season. This is also the first time the 'Topes have traveled to Tucson since July 2007, when the city was home to the Tucson Sidewinders, Triple-A affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks. Historically, the Isotopes are 4-7 when playing in Tucson.

DEJESUS RETURNS: Today the Isotopes welcome back infielder Ivan DeJesus, Jr., who was optioned from Los Angeles to Albuquerque yesterday to make room for Juan Castro. This will be the second Triple-A stint of the season for DeJesus, who has spent the majority of the year in the Major Leagues with the exception of four games in Albuquerque from April 7-11. Since his last time in an Isotopes uniform, DeJesus has gotten his first Major League hit, a pinch-hit single off St. Louis Cardinals starter Kyle McClelland on April 16, and his first big league RBI, coming off a single on May 2 against Cubs hurler James Russell.

RAFFY REHAB: Albuquerque's infield is additionally bolstered by the arrival of All-Star shortstop Rafael Furcal, who begins his Major League rehab tonight. Furcal is on the road to recovery from a broken left thumb, suffered on a head-first slide when he was attempting to steal third base against the San Francisco Giants on April 12. When Furcal was placed on the DL, DeJesus was brought up, now both are playing for Albuquerque tonight. This is the shortstop's second rehab with the Isotopes, as Furcal played in a pair of games in Albuquerque on September 1-2 of last year while he was recovering from a lower back strain.

GOOD SIGNS FOR BIG JOHN: It's official. John Lindsey's early-season doldrums are over. Lindsey has racked up hits in seven of his last eight games, a stretch in which he's batted .346 (9x26). He's been especially hot in his last three contests, going 6-for-11 (.545) with five RBI.

BIG HOMESTAND BECKONS: After four games in Tucson and a day off, the 'Topes are back in action in Albuquerque on Thursday, May 19 for a big eight-game homestand that includes a replica jersey giveaway, 50-Cent Hot Dog night, and fireworks.

ing out three in a 5-1 'Topes win. Suffered his second loss on April 22 at Iowa when
he allowed six runs, five earned, on a season-high 10 hits in four innings of a 7-2
fog-shortened, six-inning loss to the Cubs. Took the loss in his first outing on April
10 vs. Omaha when he yielded nine runs on eight hits in four innings while walking

2010: Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Rockies organization and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the New York (AL) organization... allowed just four home runs in 109.0 combined innings... opened the season with Colorado Springs, making five starts before his release on May 6... signed by the Yankees on May 13 and assigned to Scranton/Wilkes/Barre... in 13 games (12 starts) with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, limited opposing hitters to a .221 average (68x307), including a .189 mark against right-handers (30x159)... finished the season on a five-game winning streak, going 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA (4 ER / 43.1 IP) over six games (five starts) from July 4 to July 31... released by the Yankees on August 5 and finished the season with the Samsung Lions in the Korea Baseball Organization.

Washington went 20-13 in his starts...in his first start of the year, went 7.0 innings to beat the Phillies, 1-0, at Citizens Bank Park on April 2... established career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a 6-4 victory at Florida on April 18... threw career-best 8.0 innings, his first Major League complete game, in a 1-0 loss on July 24 at San Francisco.
