### ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (19-16) AT TUCSON PADRES (17-20)

'TOPES TRIPPED UP IN TUCSON 7-4: Despite a pair of hits and three RBI from rehabbing shortstop Rafael Furcal, the Albuquerque Isotopes were unable to keep the Tucson Padres at bay, falling 7-4 in the series opener at Kino Stadium Saturday night. Albuquerque got on the board first in the second in the first of two Furcal-fueled rallies. With runners on first and second Furcal roped a single to left, plating A.J. Ellis from second and giving the 'Topes a 1-0 lead. It would prove to be the Isotopes' only lead of the entire contest, as the Padres roared back immediately in the bottom of the second on an RBI single by Guillermo Quiroz and a sacrifice fly that handed the Padres the lead at 2-1. Tucson doubled its run total one inning later, when Jesus Guzman delivered an RBI single and Matt Clark hit another sac fly to give the Padres a 4-1 edge. Albuquerque crept one run closer in the fourth when Ellis drew a walk, was sacrificed to second and scored on a two-out single by Furcal to bring the 'Topes to within 4-2. After Tucson added another run in the fifth on a Guzman solo homer, the Isotopes responded in the sixth in another rally ignited by Ellis. The catcher started the frame by reaching on an error and motored to third on a double by Justin Sellers. Pinch-hitter Ivan DeJesus Jr. plated Ellis with an RBI groundout to short before Furcal added his third RBI of the contest with an RBI groundout to second that sent home Sellers and brought Albuquerque back to within a single tally at 5-4. The Padres put an exclamation point on the contest in the bottom of the seventh, however, adding two insurance runs on a Anthony Rizzo two-run single to cruise to an eventual 7-4 win

BASTARDO BACK ON TRACK: Left-hander Alberto Bastardo makes the start looking to get back in the win column after suffering his first loss of the season in his last outing. On May 10 in Las Vegas, Bastardo took the defeat despite pitching a very solid six innings in which he yielded five runs, only two of them earned, on six hits while walking three and striking out four in a 7-0 Isotopes loss. Not only was it the first 'Topes first shutout of the season, the contest broke a string of exceptional run support for the southpaw. In his five appearances prior to his outing in Vegas, all Albuquerque wins, Bastardo had received an average of 7.8 runs of support per start. Even counting the shutout, the Isotopes score an average of 6.5 runs every time Bastardo makes the start.

**WIN, PLACE, SHOW:** With last night's loss, the Isotopes have fallen to third place in the PCL's American Southern Division for the first time this season. While Albuquerque is still 3.5 games behind first place Round Rock, the New Orleans Zephyrs, by virtue of a win last night vs. Tacoma, are now in second place at 2.5 games behind the Express. Albuquerque had spent 25 consecutive days in second place.

**FREE PASS:** In their last three games the 'Topes have been doing a superb job drawing walks. Since May 12, Albuquerque batters have drawn a total of 24 free passes, including a season-high 10 on May 13 in Las Vegas, two shy of a team record set in 2004. For the month, the 'Topes have coaxed 53 walks, bringing their season total to 129, tied for 13th in the PCL. Last night, A.J. Ellis drew three walks, tying a season-high set by Trent Oeltjen on night prior, when he walked three times in the Vegas series finale.

**DINGER DIATRIBE:** Through 35 games this season, it's starting to become clear that by and large when the Isotopes hit a home run, they win. The 'Topes 16-9 when they leave the yard and just 3-7 when they fail to hit a homer. Albuquerque has hit just two home runs total in its last five games, the team's biggest dinger drought of the season.

**BIG HOMESTAND BECKONS:** After three more games in Tucson and a day off, the 'Topes are back in action in Albuquerque on Thursday, May 19 for a big eight-game homestand that includes a replica jersey giveaway, 50-Cent Hot Dog night, and fireworks.
