ISOTOPES TROUNCE T-PADS 10-5: Taking out an entire road trip's worth of offensive frustration in one night, the Albuquerque Isotopes poured it on the Tucson Padres, winning by the score of 10-5 Sunday night at Kino Stadium. Albuquerque wasted no time jumping on the Padres, scoring a run in the top of the first when rehabbing shortstop Rafael Furcal led off the game with a double, advanced to third on a groundout, and scored on an RBI single by Eugenio Velez to give the 'Topes an immediate 1-0 lead. Tucson tied the game with a run in the bottom of the first, but Albuquerque seized control in the top of the second. Trayvon Robinson started the uprising with a one-out double and was immediately cashed in by a single off the bat of J.D. Closser to give the 'Topes the lead for good at 2-1. Damaso Espino then unloaded a mammoth two-run homer to left to increase the Isotopes lead to 4-1. The second inning proved to be just a warm-up act for the third, as Albuquerque kept the pressure on Tucson with three more tallies. With the bases loaded and two down, Closser dumped a single to center, scoring a pair to increase the lead to 6-1 Isotopes. For the second straight frame, Espino once again capped the rally, this time with an RBI single that extended the advantage to 7-1. After the Padres added another run in the third, the 'Topes got it right back in the top of the sixth to make the score 8-3. Tucson tacked on a run in the seventh, but the Isotopes answered with two more tallies in the ninth on a two-run single by Trayvon Robinson to give Albuquerque a 10-3 advantage. Tucson got a two-run homer from Matt Clark in the bottom of the ninth to close out the scoring, but it was not nearly enough as the Isotopes cruised to a 10-5 win.

MORE ACTION FOR JACKSON: Right-hander Steven Jackson makes his second start in an Isotopes uniform after suffering the loss in his 'Topes debut on May 11 at Las Vegas. Making his first appearance since recovering from a strained ligament in the middle of finger of his right hand, Jackson worked 3.2 innings in which he allowed four runs, three earned, on four hits while striking out one in a 7-4 Albuquerque loss to the 51s. What proved to be the right-hander's undoing was some understandable wildness while making his first appearance in game action in exactly three weeks. Of the 66 pitches Jackson tossed at the 51s, only 32 were for strikes, and the right-hander finished his 3.2 innings by walking four of the 19 total batters he faced.

VOLCANIC VELEZ: Eugenio Velez continues to wield a hot bat for the Isotopes, batting .410 (16x39) in 10 games with Albuquerque since recovering from an ankle sprain suffered near the end of Spring Training. Of those 10 contests, Velez has gotten a hit in eight, with four of those being multi-hit performances. Last night, Velez tied a team high with four hits, bringing his average on the current road trip to a rather scorching .375 (9x24) with four runs scored, three doubles and four RBI in six games.

CASE OF THE MONDAYS: So far this season, the Isotopes are perfect 5-0 in games played on Monday, the only day of the week on which the 'Topes have not lost in 2011. In an attempt to counteract the inevitable jinx of that last sentence, the Isotopes have played in Tucson on a Monday just twice in team history, losing both games (3-7, May 30, 2005; 3-4, July 30, 2007).

QUARTER POLE: The Isotopes are exactly a quarter of the way through the 2011 season and with a record of 20-16, are tied with the second-most wins at this juncture of the season in team history. In 2006, the Isotopes had a 22-14 mark through the first 36 games, while the 2004 'Topes were 20-16 in that season's first quarter.

BIG HOMESTAND BECKONS: After two more games in Tucson and a day off, the 'Topes are back in action in Albuquerque on Thursday, May 19 for a big eight-game homestand that includes a replica jersey giveaway, 50-Cent Hot Dog night, and fireworks.

TODAY'S START: Steven Jackson makes his second start for the Isotopes after suffering the loss in his 'Topes debut on May 11 at Las Vegas when he allowed four runs, three earned, on four hits and four walks in 3.2 innings of a 7-4 Albuquerque defeat.

Signed with the Dodgers as a free agent on March 10 and started the season at Double-A Chattanooga. Made three starts for Lookouts, going 0-1 with a 7.15 ERA (9 ER / 11.1 IP). Placed on the DL with a sprained ligament in his right middle finger on April 23. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 11 after rehabbing in Arizona.

2010: Split the season between Triple-A Indianapolis and Pittsburgh... appeared in 11 games (all in relief) for the Pirates over four different stints, going 0-1 with an 8.74 ERA (11 ER / 11.1 IP)... appeared in a career-high 41 games for the Indianapolis Indians, all in relief, going 4-0 with a 3.51 (22 ER / 56.1 IP)... was 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3 ER / 13.0 IP) in nine appearances for the Indians in May before his first call-up of the season on May 28... optioned back to Indy on June 2 after making one appearance for the Pirates on May 28 at Atlanta (1.2 IP, 1 H, 2 SO)... rejoined Pittsburgh on June 24 when lefty Dana Eveland was designated for assignment and made one appearance that night at Texas, suffering the defeat in his only Major League decision of the year after giving up a run in 0.2 innings... optioned back to Indianapolis on June 26... recalled for a third time on July 27 and made four appearances for the Pirates, posting a 15.43 ERA (8 ER / 4.2 IP) over that span... designated for assignment on August 4, cleared waivers and was outrighted to Indianapolis on August 9... finished the season strong for the Indians, going 1-0 with a 2.13 ERA (3 ER / 12.2 IP) in his last 10 outings, earning his fourth call-up on September 7... finished the season in Pittsburgh, posting a 4.15 ERA (2 ER / 4.1 IP) in five appearances to close out the year.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2009 season between the New York (AL) and Pittsburgh organizations, making his Major League debut with the Pirates... began season with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the Yankees chain, going 0-0 with a 1.74 ERA (2 ER / 10.1 IP) and one save in six relief appearances and 0-0 with a 2.25 ERA (1 ER / 4.0 IP) in one start... was recalled by the Yankees on April 19 but did not appear in a game before being optioned to Scranton on April 28... designated for assignment by the Yankees on May 8 and was claimed off waivers by the Pirates on May 18 and assigned to Triple-A Indianapolis... recalled by Pittsburgh on June 1 and made his Major League debut that night vs. New York Mets... picked up his first big league win in his second game with the Pirates on June 4 vs New York... gave up three runs in 1.1 innings and suffered his first loss in his next outing on June 7 at Houston... was optioned to Indianapolis on July 10 and made seven appearances for Indians before returning to Pittsburgh on August 2.

Attended spring training in 2008 as a non-roster invitee with the Yankees... split the season between Double-A Trenton and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 4-3 with a 4.18 ERA (37 ER / 79.2 IP) and one save in 49 combined games (one start).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Steven Nash Jackson... he and his wife Lindsey have a daughter Holly (10/8/09)... attended Clemson University from 2001-04, where he went 19-8 with a 4.62 (113 ER / 220.0 IP) in 67 games... 34 starts... is a 2000 graduate of Summerville (SC) High School where he lettered in baseball and football.
