‘TOPES TRAMPLED BY TUCSON 10-4: The Albuquerque Isotopes dug themselves an early hole they couldn’t get out of, as the Tucson Padres plated seven runs in the first two innings to run away to a 10-4 win Monday night at Kino Stadium. With two down in the bottom of the first Anthony Rizzo blasted a home run to right field, giving the home team an immediate 2-0 lead. After Jesus Guzman singled, Matt Clark lifted a fly ball to left that Trayvon Robinson lost in the lights for an RBI triple that extended the advantage to 3-0 Padres. Things got worse for Albuquerque in the very next inning in a four run Tucson frame where again the damage was inflicted with two outs. With runners on first and second, Aaron Cunningham smashed an RBI double to right, increasing Tucson’s lead to 4-0. Rizzo then crushed his second home run in as many innings, this one a three-run shot, to give the home team a commanding 7-0 cushion. Albuquerque finally got up off the mat in the top of the third when A.J. Ellis led off the frame with a single and advanced to third on a base-hit by pinch-hitter Joe Becker. Rehabbing short-stop Rafael Furcal then roped a single to center, plating Ellis and cutting the deficit to 7-1. Ivan De Jesus Jr. then added an RBI groundout to second, scoring Becker to make the score 7-2 Tucson. The Padres scored one more in the bottom of the third on a lead-off homer by Matt Clark, but the ‘Topes answered in the top of the fourth courtesy of their own long ball from Robinson to move Albuquerque within striking distance at 8-3. Tucson tacked on a pair of runs in the bottom of the sixth to seize a 10-3 lead, before J.D. Closser smashed a pinch-hit solo homer in the top of the ninth to make the final margin 10-4, Padres.

ELY LOOKING FOR A WIN: Righty John Ely takes the mound looking for his first victory in nearly a month, with his last win coming back on April 20 when he nearly no-hit the Iowa Cubs in the second game of a doubleheader on April 20. The fact that he hasn’t gotten a win in four straight starts certainly shouldn’t suggest that Ely hasn’t pitched well, however, because quite the contrary is true. Over the span of his last four outings, Ely has posted a 3.75 (10 ER / 24 IP) ERA while walking nine and striking out 16. In his last start at Las Vegas on May 12, the right-hander was particularly superb, allowing just two unearned runs on three hits in seven innings while walking one and striking out three in a 4-3 ‘Topes loss. When Ely departed that contest, the game was tied 2-2, but the 51s scored a pair of runs in the bottom of the eighth en route to a 4-3 win.

EVERYBODY PLAYS: Last night, the Isotopes had every single position player who was active on the roster play in the game, a total of 13 players including the rehabbing Rafael Furcal. The ‘Topes used a total of 17 players last night, tied for a season high with a 10-inning contest at home against Omaha on April 9 and a game against New Orleans on April 24. In those games, however, the ‘Topes used 11 and 12 position players, respectively, with one player staying on the bench in both contests.

ENDING ON A HIGH NOTE: The ‘Topes take the field tonight looking to salvage a series split and avoid back-to-back series losses for the first time all season. A win would also provide a positive note to a road trip in which Albuquerque has gone 2-5 through seven games.

GREAT IN A PINCH: With a solo homer in the ninth inning of last night’s game, J.D. Closser has driven in four runs as a pinch-hitter, a team high. In fact, the entire ‘Topes team has a total of nine pinch-hit RBI. Closser’s pinch-hit homer was the first by an Isotope since Michael Restovich blasted a pinch-hit grand slam at Iowa on June 21 of last year.

DAY OFF: After tonight’s game, the ‘Topes will head back home for a day of rest and relaxation in Albuquerque. The team will bus from Tucson tonight and arrive in Albuquerque around 8:00 AM, which means most of the team will be on the first tee by noon.

BIG HOMESTAND BECKONS: After the day off, the ‘Topes are back in action in Albuquerque on Thursday, May 19 for a big eight-game homestand that includes a replica jersey giveaway, 50-Cent Hot Dog night, and fireworks.

TODAY'S START: John Ely makes the start coming off a fourth straight no-decision on May 12 at Las Vegas when he allowed just two unearned runs on a mere three hits in 7.0 innings while walking one and striking out three in an eventual 4-3 'Topes loss. When Ely departed after the seventh, the game was tied at 2-2, but Vegas scored two in the eighth to wind up with the win.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Enjoyed a breakout 2009 season in his first year at Double-A with Birmingham in the Chicago White Sox organization, going 14-2 with a 2.82 ERA (49 ER / 156.1 IP) in 27 starts... tied for first in the Southern League with 14 wins and was first in strikeouts with 125... named Southern League Mid-Season All-Star on July 13... named to the Southern League Post-Season All-Star team on August 31... traded from the White Sox with right-hander Jon Link for outfielder Juan Pierre on December 18.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/ Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game... selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
