# RENO ACES (25-15) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (21-17)

'TOPES TOP TUCSON 11-9 IN 12 INNINGS: The Albuquerque Isotopes erased a three-run deficit in the eighth before surging ahead in the 12th for a thrilling 11-9 win over the Tucson Padres Tuesday night at Kino Stadium. With the score tied 8-8 deep into the desert night, Albuquerque loaded the bases in the 12th on two hit-by-pitches and a single for Ivan De Jesus Jr., who slapped a groundout to second that scored A.J. Ellis and gave the 'Topes a 9-8 lead. John Lindsey then knocked a single to left, scoring a pair of runs and extending the visitor's lead to 11-8. The insurance runs proved vital, as Tucson scored a run in the bottom of the 12th before reliever Jon Link shut the door to preserve the 11-9 win. As dramatic as the 12th frame was, the real drama occurred four innings earlier, when Albuquerque erased a three-run deficit in the eighth to climb into a tie. With runners on first and second and the Isotopes trailing 8-5, Jamie Hoffmann laced a one out single to left, scoring J.D. Closser to cut the deficit to 8-6. Dee Gordon and De Jesus then added back-to-back RBI singles to knot the game at 8-8 and send the contest eventually into extra innings.

EVELAND ON THE HILL: Lefty Dana Eveland takes the mound looking for his fifth victory of the season, which would tie him with Round Rock's Derek Hankins and Fresno's Andrew Kown for the PCL lead. The southpaw comes into his eighth start of the season riding some momentum after a dominating outing on May 13 at Las Vegas, when he tossed six shutout innings in which he yielded just four hits while walking four and striking out one in an 8-3 Isotopes win. Although he's got a winning record of 3-2 at Isotopes Park, Eveland takes the mound looking to snap a two-game home losing streak after suffering defeats in his last two starts at The Lab, May 3 vs. Omaha and May 8 vs. Memphis.

IT'S TIME FOR RENO ACEBALL: Albuquerque welcomes the Reno Aces to Isotopes Park for the second time in as many years, deviating from the usual routine of inter-conference foes alternating between each team's home ballpark every other season. When the Portland team moved to Tucson, it forced the Pacific Conference divisions to realign slightly, which meant Reno would move from the Pacific Southern to the Pacific Northern, joining Salt Lake, Colorado Springs, and Tacoma. Therefore, the Aces are back for a second series in Albuquerque in as many years. Last year, the Aces and 'Topes played a memorable set that featured three straight shutouts, an Isotopes Park first. After Reno scored a 3-0 shutout in the second game of the series, Albuquerque responded with 2-0 and 8-0 blankings. The two teams have only played two series all-time, with Albuquerque winning both, amassing a 6-2 record all-time against the Aces (3-1 at Isotopes Park, 3-1 at Reno). Reno also brings a familiar face in infielder Tony Abreu, who helped lead the Isotopes to the playoffs in 2009.

**HOME COOKIN':** Tonight Albuquerque returns to the friendly confines of Isotopes Park, where the 'Topes have not only been playing their best baseball, but some of the best baseball of any team in the PCL at home. With a home mark of 13-7 and a winning percentage of .650, Albuquerque trails only Omaha for the PCL's best home winning percentage (the Storm Chasers are 11-5 at Werner Park, a .688 percentage). The 'Topes come into tonight's game having won four of their last five games at The Lab and are 3-0-2 in all five series played at Isotopes Park so far this year.

**IN A CLOSS BY HIMSELF:** J.D. Closser has found his power stroke, belting homers in back-to-back games to close out the series in Tucson (the first of the two was a pinch-hit blast on May 16). With three homers on the year, Closser in 29 games this year has already equaled the amount of homers he hit in 92 games with Albuquerque last year.

FOUR HIT SELLS: In the 'Topes extra-inning win on Tuesday, Justin Sellers collected four hits, becoming just the sixth Isotopes hitter to rack up four hits in a contest, joining Eugenio Velez, Trayvon Robinson, Damaso Espino, Dee Gordon, and Corey Smith.

BIG HOMESTAND HERE!!: The 'Topes are back for an eight-game homestand packed with great promotions and giveaways. Tomorrow, the Isotopes will be giving away their extremely popular replica jersey courtesy of Bank of the West. Be sure to get the park early, though, because only 2,500 will be given away and sizes are limited.

TODAY'S START: Dana Eveland looks to make it two wins in a row after earn-
ing a victory in his last start on May 13 at Las Vegas when he fired six shutout in-
nings, allowing just four hits and four walks while striking one in an 8-3 Isotopes
win, the only win the 'Topes were able to muster in the series. Had a complete
game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the
first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just
three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on
the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when
he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two
and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

<b>2010:</b> Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go
3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh
Pirates traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February
6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when
he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo opened the season with
Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting
traded to Pittsburgh on June 1 in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER /
20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67) allowed just two earned
runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned
wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago
(AL)) threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while
striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6 went 0-1
with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates be-
fore getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A
Indianapolis on July 1 was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games
(five starts) with Indians traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a
player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation...compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
