### RENO ACES (25-16) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (22-17)

**HOFFMANN THE HERO IN 3-2 'TOPES WIN:** Jamie Hoffmann belted a solo homer leading off the bottom of the ninth to deliver the Albuquerque Isotopes a 3-2 walk-off win over the Reno Aces on a chilly Thursday night at Isotopes Park. Hoffmann led off the bottom of the ninth in a 2-2 game and immediately fell into an 0-2 hole to Aces reliever Jason Urquidez. After working the count to 3-2 Hoffmann deposited Urquidez's eighth pitch of the at-bat over the fence in left to give Albuquerque a dramatic 3-2 win. It was clear from the outset that runs would be at a premium as Albuquerque jumped on the board in the first when Dee Gordon manufactured the first run of the game. After leading off with a single, Gordon swiped second, motored into third on a groundout, and raced home on a wild pitch to put the 'Topes on top 1-0 after one. Reno tied the game in the top of the second but the Isotopes got the tally right back in the bottom of the frame in nearly the same fashion they did in the first inning. This time it was Hoffmann leading off the inning with a single, stealing second, moving to third on a groundout, and scoring on a single by Justin Sellers to give Albuquerque a 2-1 edge. The Aces answered in the fifth when Hallberg led off with a double, advanced to third on a sacrifice by the pitcher, and scored on a single by Cole Gillespie to knot the game at 2-2. That's where the game would stand until Hoffmann's heroics in the bottom of the ninth.

**REDDING RIPPING:** Tim Redding makes the start looking to build on two exceptional home outings. Over his last two appearances at Isotopes Park, Redding has posted a 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP), yet due to some bad luck has an 0-1 record over those starts to show for it. At least if the right-hander needs some run support, he can chip in himself. Over his last two games, a start on May 14 in Tucson and his last outing at Isotopes Park on May 9 vs. Memphis, Redding is 3-for-4 at the plate. On May 9, Redding ripped a pair of singles, becoming the first 'Topes pitcher this season to get two hits in a game. On the season, Redding is batting .333 (3-for-9).

**BULLPEN BULLIES:** In the month of May, Isotopes relievers have been racking up wins. In 17 games played this month, and out of nine 'Topes win over that span, Albuquerque relief pitchers are 7-1. Leading the way is Travis Schlichting, who has racked up three wins in the month of May, including last night's victory. With three victories on the season, Schlichting is now tied with Alberto Bastardo for the second-most on the club behind Dana Eveland's four.

**ONE RUN WONDERS:** With last night's 3-2 win, Albuquerque's record in one-run games is now 8-3, the highest winning percentage in one-run contests in the Pacific Coast League. The 'Topes are 7-1 in one-run contests played at Isotopes Park.

**DIRECTLY TO THE DODGERS:** With Ramon Troncoso joining the Dodgers, with whom he pitched a perfect ninth in last night's loss to the Giants, the Isotopes have had nine call-ups to the Los Angeles over the course of the season. It's only the 40th game and, including rehab assignments, 11 different players have suited up for Albuquerque and Los Angeles this year.

**MISTERS UTILITY:** With the start last night in right field, his first outfield start in his professional career, Justin Sellers has now started games at four different positions (2B, SS, 3B, RF), tying him with J.D. Closser, who has also seen action at four different positions this season (C, 1B, 3B, LF)

**BIG HOMESTAND HERE!!:** The 'Topes continue their eight-game homestand with the extremely popular replica jersey giveaway courtesy of Bank of the West. Be sure to get the park early, though, because only 2,500 will be given away and sizes are limited. Tomorrow, the Isotopes will light the skies with their second fireworks show of the month!

**TODAY'S START:** Right-hander Tim Redding makes his seventh start of the year coming off his team-high fourth defeat on May 14 at Tucson when he allowed five runs on seven hits in five innings while walking one and striking out two in a 7-4 'Topes loss. Suffered a hard-luck loss on May 4 vs. Omaha when he allowed four runs, all of them unearned, on eight hits in six innings while walking one and striking out three in an 11-4 'Topes loss. Earned his first win of the season on April 28 at Nashville, when he allowed just one run on just four hits in six innings while walking none and striking out three in a 5-1 'Topes win. Suffered his second loss on April 22 at Iowa when he allowed six runs, five earned, on a season-high 10 hits in four innings of a 7-2 fog-shortened, six-inning loss to the Cubs. Took the loss in his first outing on April 10 vs. Omaha when he yielded nine runs on eight hits in four innings while walking three and striking out five in a 9-6 'Topes loss.

Made an appearance in right field on April 13 vs. Iowa when the Isotopes ran out of position players due to injuries. Played three innings at the position but did not face any chances. Also made one appearance as a pinch-hitter on April 14 vs. Iowa (grounded out to third). Collected two hits in three at-bats on May 9 vs. Memphis.

**2010:** Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Rockies organization and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the New York (AL) organization... allowed just four home runs in 109.0 combined innings... opened the season with Colorado Springs, making five starts before his release on May 6... signed by the Yankees on May 13 and assigned to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre... in 13 games (12 starts) with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, limited opposing hitters to a .221 average (68x307), including a .189 mark against right-handers (30x159)... finished the season on a five-game winning streak, going 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA (4 ER / 43.1 IP) over six games (five starts) from July 4 to July 31... released by the Yankees on August 5 and finished the season with the Samsung Lions in the Korea Baseball Organization.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Spent the 2009 season in New York (NL) organization, making 30 appearances (17 starts) for the Mets... made two starts in Spring Training on March 8 and March 12 before landing on the 15-Day Disabled List April 5th (retroactive to March 27th) with a strained right rotator cuff... had two rehabilitation starts (no decisions) with Triple-A Buffalo... made his Mets debut on May 18 at Los Angeles (NL) after being activated from the 15-Day DL earlier in the day... picked up his first hit in a Mets uniform, a single to right field in the fifth inning... picked up his first win as a member of the Mets on June 22 at home vs. St. Louis... tied his season-high with 7.0 innings and allowed 4 runs and 5 hits (the last Mets pitcher to go winless in his first six starts was Hideo Nomo in 1998)... moved to the bullpen after his start on July 2 in Pittsburgh.

Established career highs in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts with the Washington Nationals in 2008... following the season, had calcium deposit removed from the joint of his second toe on his left foot... finished tied for ninth in the NL with 33 starts... did not miss his turn in the rotation the entire season... matched his career-high in wins with 10 (also won 10 games for Houston in 2003)... became first Nats pitcher to record double figures in victories since the 2006 season... Washington went 20-13 in his starts... in his first start of the year, went 7.0 innings to beat the Phillies, 1-0, at Citizens Bank Park on April 2... established career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a 6-4 victory at Florida on April 18... threw career-best 8.0 innings, his first Major League complete game, in a 1-0 loss on July 24 at San Francisco.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Timothy James Redding... is married to Jaime with a daughter, Shea (11/13/01), and son, Brennan (9/15/03)... graduated from Monroe Community College in Rochester, NY, where his No. 17 jersey became the first in school history to be retired on Feb. 1, 2008... his great aunt, Joyce Randolph, played Trixie Norton on the Honeymooners.
