# RENO ACES (26-17) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (23-18)

'TOPES BLANKED BY RENO 4-0: The Albuquerque Isotopes found themselves in an unlikely pitcher's duel, as the Reno Aces held the 'Topes offense scoreless to claim a 4-0 win Saturday night at Isotopes Park. Reno starter Kevin Mulvey (3-3) was in control throughout the entire night, throwing seven strong innings in which he allowed seven hits while walking two and striking out five to earn his third win of the season. A trio of Aces pitchers held Albuquerque to nine hits the entire night, all of them singles. Meanwhile, the Aces jumped on the scoreboard in a hurry, plating two runs within the game's first two batters. Evan Frey led off the game by drawing a walk and was immediately cashed in by a two-run homer off the bat of Collin Cowgill to give the visitors a lightening quick 2-0 lead. Reno struck again with the long ball in the fourth, when Cody Ransom blasted a solo homer to increase the lead to 3-0 Aces. That three-run lead would be bolstered in the very next inning when Frey reached on a bunt single, stole second, and scored two batters later on a double by Brandon Allen to give Reno a 4-0 edge. All four runs were scored on Isotopes starter Mario Alvarez (0-1), who was making his Triple-A debut after coming up from Double-A Chattanooga. The young right-hander allowed four runs on four hits, two of them homers, in 4.2 innings of work while walking five and striking out two to suffer his first defeat as an Isotope. While Albuquerque's offense was largely stymied, Ivan De Jesus Jr. was able to scratch out three hits and, along with John Lindsey in the fourth, came the closest to scoring by reaching third base, but that's as close as the Isotopes would get to reaching home plate.

**THE DECISION:** John Ely takes the mound riding a streak of five consecutive starts without a decision, tied for the longest such drought in his career. In 2009, when the right-hander was pitching for Double-A Birmingham in the White Sox organization, he went five straight appearances without garnering a decision of any kind from June 7 to June 30 before promptly going 8-1 the rest of the season. As is the case with no-decisions, it's not necessarily indicative of pitching poorly, but rather a series of variables that conspire to keep a pitcher without a win or a loss. Over the course of his current streak, Ely has posted an ERA of 4.74 (16 ER / 30.1 IP), but has only allowed just three home runs that entire span while walking 10 and striking out 20. Moreover, he's keeping balls on the ground. This season Ely has yielded 1.67 groundouts for every out recorded through the air, tops among Isotopes starters.

ACE OF ZEROES: In the last two years combined, there have been a total of six shutouts tossed at Isotopes Park, yet amazingly four of them have involved the Reno Aces, a team the 'Topes have played just seven times at The Lab in franchise history. Last year, Reno blanked Albuquerque once before having the favor returned in back-to-back games to end the series. With last night's Aces shutout win over the 'Topes, each team has shut the other out twice at Isotopes Park over the last two seasons.

**GETTING DEFENSIVE:** After starting the month of May with 19 errors in their first 11 games, the Isotopes have just three gaffes in their last eight contests. A throwing error by starter Mario Alvarez in last night's game broke a streak of four straight without a miscue, the 'Topes' longest stretch of perfect defense this season.

**THINKING SERIES-LY:** A win today would give the Isotopes' their fourth series win in six played at Isotopes Park so far this season. The only two sets Albuquerque didn't take three games in were both splits against Omaha. Overall, the 'Topes have won six of their last eight home games.

SANDS HITS A MILESTONE: Congratulations to former Isotope Jerry Sands, who belted his first career Major League home run yesterday off Chicago White Sox ace Mark Buerhle. In the sixth inning, Sands hammered a two-out homer to left field that accounted for half of the Dodgers' runs in a 9-2 loss to the Pale Hose.

**TODAY'S START:** John Ely makes the start coming off a fifth straight nodecision on May 17 at Tucson when he allowed a season-high six earned runs on 10 hits in 6.1 innings while walking one and striking out four in a game eventually won by the Isotopes in 12 innings 11-9.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Enjoyed a breakout 2009 season in his first year at Double-A with Birmingham in the Chicago White Sox organization, going 14-2 with a 2.82 ERA (49 ER / 156.1 IP) in 27 starts... tied for first in the Southern League with 14 wins and was first in strikeouts with 125... named Southern League Mid-Season All-Star on July 13... named to the Southern League Post-Season All-Star team on August 31... traded from the White Sox with right-hander Jon Link for outfielder Juan Pierre on December 18.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/ Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
