COLORADO SPRINGS SKY SOX (17-26) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (24-18)

'TOPES BLANKED BY RENO 4-0: John Ely fired a nine-inning complete game, allowing just one run on three hits to lead the Albuquerque Isotopes to a 3-1 win over the Reno Aces on a spectacular Sunday afternoon at Isotopes Park. Ely (2-1) was dominant from the very outset, retiring the first eight batters he faced and 15 of the last 16 batters to end the game. When it was all said and done, Ely had allowed just one run on three hits while walking one and striking out seven. Albuquerque got on the scoreboard in the fourth, when Dee Gordon led off the inning with a triple and was immediately plated by a sacrifice fly from Ivan De Jesus Jr. to give the 'Topes a 1-0 edge. Eugenio Velez then smashed a solo homer to right, immediately doubling the advantage to 2-0 Albuquerque. Ely's only mistake the entire game came in the top of the fifth, when Cody Ransom launched a solo homer leading off the fifth to trim the lead 2-1 Isotopes. That's where Ely decided to slam the door, however, retiring the next 14 batters in a row after the home run to effectively douse any hopes of an Aces comeback. Although they didn't need it, the Isotopes manufactured one more insurance run in the eighth. Gordon led off the frame with a single, advanced to second on a perfect sacrifice by De Jesus, scampered into third on fly-out, and scored on single by Trent Oeltjen to make the score 3-1 Albuquerque and send Ely comfortably to the victory.

TRIPLE-A TIM: For the second time in three games, the Isotopes will start a Triple-A rookie, as 23-year old right-hander Tim Sexton will make his Triple-A debut tonight. Sexton arrives after having started the season at Single-A Great Lakes, where he was 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP) in eight starts. The right-hander was especially solid right before his promotion, allowing one run in each of his last two starts, posting a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in that span. Sexton has also been making a habit of getting batters to swing and miss. In his 47 innings with the Loons, Sexton has fanned 49 batters and walked just 12.

YOU COMPLETE ME: Ely's complete-game masterpiece yesterday was just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game the right-hander has thrown in his five-year career (he has three seven-inning complete games to his credit, including his complete game one-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20). The last nine-inning complete game thrown at Isotopes Park was authored by knuckleball specialist Charlie Haeger, who allowed two runs while scattering 11 hits over nine innings in a 6-2 win over Oklahoma City on July 28. 2009. Ely's three hits were the fewest ever given up in a nine-inning complete game in Isotopes history.

GET YOUR SOX OFF: The 'Topes tonight open up a four-game series with regional rival Colorado Springs, as the Sky Sox are making their first visit to The Lab since 2009. Dating back to that series split, the 'Topes have prevailed in four of their last six games against the Sox. Overall, the Isotopes are 25-29 against their neighbors to the north and 12-16 against the Sky Sox at Isotopes Park. Colorado Springs arrives with some familiar faces in pitcher Eric Stults, who pitched for the Isotopes in 2009, and catcher Jordan Pacheco, who never played for the 'Topes but who starred at La Cueva High School and the University of

THE MIGHTY CASEY: Today Casey Blake will be starting a Major League rehabilitation assignment with the Isotopes after being out since April 29 with a staph infection in his left elbow. Blake has already had two stays on the DL this season. After returning from a lower back strain on April 6, the third baseman batted .321 (17x53) with 15 runs, two homers, and six RBI in 14 games before having to go back on the shelf with the elbow infection. The

veteran will be the third Dodger to join the 'Topes on a rehab assignment this year, joining outfielder Jay Gibbons and shortstop Rafael Furcal.

HIGH WATER: With a record of 24-18, the Isotopes are six games over .500 for the second time this season, tying their high-water mark this year. On May 9, the 'Topes were 18-12.

TODAY'S START: Twenty-three year-old right-hander Tim Sexton makes his Triple-A debut after spending the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP).

Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20.

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played a second full season at Single-A Inland Empire in 2009, going 8-14 with a 3.96 ERA (69 ER / 157.0 IP) in 27 games (22 starts)... tied for the club lead with eight wins and 22 starts... ranked third on the team with a career-high 100 strikeouts... tossed a career-high 157 innings, tops in the Dodger organization and second in the California League... selected to the California League mid-season All-Star Team, posting a 3.21 ERA (27 ER / 75.2 IP) in 13 games (10 starts) before the All-Star break... won the July Dodger Pride Award for Inland Empire, going 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA (14 ER / 36.1 IP) in six July starts... threw 7.0 innings or more in seven of his outings.

Spent the full 2008 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 5-12 with a 6.04 ERA (95 ER / 141.2 IP) in 28 games (26 starts)... struck out 92 while walking 36 in his 141.2 innings... named California League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 14-20 when he went 2-0 with an 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP).

Began his professional career in 2007 with Single-A Great Lakes, going 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP) in five games (no starts)... rated as the 24th best prospect in the Dodger organization and as having the fifth-best pro debut among all Junior College players from the 2007 draft by *Baseball America*
