DISASTROUS NINTH DOOMS 'TOPES IN 15-6 LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes carried a one run lead into the ninth only to watch it disappear and then some as the Colorado Springs Sky Sox scored 10 times in the ninth to coast to a 15-6 win Tuesday night at Isotopes Park. With the 'Topes clinging to a 6-5 lead heading into the ninth inning, the Sky Sox scored 10 times by sending 13 men to the plate and collecting eight hits, as many as they had racked up in the eight previous innings combined. The way the game started, it appeared it would be rout in the opposite direction as the Isotopes erupted out of the gate with four runs in the first inning. Trent Oeltjen roped an RBI single left to give Albuquerque a 1-0 edge. J.D. Closser then smashed a towering three-run homer that reached the top of the berm in right field to put the home team on top 4-0. Colorado Springs would chip away with two runs in the third and another in the fourth to draw within 4-3, but Albuquerque continued to find a way to keep the visitors at arms-length when Dee Gordon roped an RBI double in the bottom of the fourth to extend the lead to 5-3 Isotopes. In the sixth, pinch-hitter John Lindsey made it a three-run contest with an RBI double that helped the 'Topes seize a 6-3 advantage. It would prove painfully fleeting, however, as Colorado Springs scored twice in the seventh to make the score 6-5 and set up the run deluge that was the ninth.

READY FOR REDDING: Tim Redding takes the hill looking to finally break through with a win after two consecutive solid home outings in which he wound up with a no decision each time. After allowing three runs, one earned, on five hits in six innings in an eventual 4-3 'Topes win over Memphis on May 9, Redding battled through a season-high 6.2 innings in his last outing on May 20 vs. Reno, allowing five runs while scattering eight hits, walking four and striking out three in a game won by Albuquerque in walk-off fashion in the bottom of the ninth 7-6. Over those two home outings, Redding has posted a solid 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP) and fanned 11 while walking five. The veteran right-hander also comes in with a three-game hitting streak, which he extended with a single in his last start. Over his last three games, Redding has gone 4-for-6 (.667) at the plate.

10 SPOT: Last night's 10-run ninth tied a franchise record for most runs surrendered by Isotopes pitching in an inning, which was set in back-to-back games in 2008 and not without a little irony. On April 29 and April 30, the 'Topes allowed 10 runs in the ninth and seventh innings, respectively, to the Las Vegas 51s, a squad managed by current Isotopes skipper Lorenzo Bundy. Key players in both of those rallies included Xavier Paul, who had five hits and five RBI on April 29 and John Lindsey, who had three hits the next game to lead the 51s. Even more crazy, in the April 30 contest, Las Vegas scored 10 runs in the seventh and still lost 18-16.

CLUBBER CLOSS: With his fifth home run yesterday, a Herculean shot that almost landed in the playground above the right field berm, J.D. Closser has accumulated more home runs for a season since he hit 11 for the Sacramento River Cats in 2007. In fact, he's almost racked up as many dingers in 32 games played this year as he had in each of his two previous years with the Isotopes combined. Closser has recorded a hit in each of his last six games, batting a scorching .381 (8x21) with seven runs, four homers, and 10 RBI.

PINCH HIT PROWESS: Thanks to an RBI pinch-hit double last night, John Lindsey stayed a perfect 3-for-3 in pinch-hit appearances this season. In fact, Lindsey is enjoying a little roll of his own, collecting hits in each of his last six games and in 10 of his last 11, raising his average from .176 on May 10 when the hot stretch began to .259 today.

BIG HOMESTAND ROLLS ON!!: The 'Topes continue their eightgame homestand with a day that collectors mark in their calendar each year; the release of the team's annual baseball card set tomorrow. This year's set promises to be the best yet, so be sure to come early.

Reno on May 20 at Isotopes Park when he allowed five runs on eight hits while
walking four and striking out three in 6.2 innings of a 7-6 Isotopes walk-off win.
Earned his first win of the season on April 28 at Nashville, when he allowed just
one run on just four hits in six innings while walking none and striking out three
in a 5-1 'Topes win. Suffered his second loss on April 22 at Iowa when he allowed
six runs, five earned, on a season-high 10 hits in four innings of a 7-2 fog-short-
ened, six-inning loss to the Cubs. Took the loss in his first outing on April 10 vs.
Omaha when he yielded nine runs on eight hits in four innings while walking three
and striking out five in a 9-6 'Topes loss.

Made an appearance in right field on April 13 vs. Iowa when the Isotopes ran out of position players due to injuries. Played three innings at the position but did not face any chances. Also made one appearance as a pinch-hitter on April 14 vs. Iowa (grounded out to third). Collected two hits in three at-bats on May 9 vs. Memphis.

2010: Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Rockies organization and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the New York (AL) organization... allowed just four home runs in 109.0 combined innings... opened the season with Colorado Springs, making five starts before his release on May 6... signed by the Yankees on May 13 and assigned to Scranton/Wilkes/Barre... in 13 games (12 starts) with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, limited opposing hitters to a .221 average (68x307), including a .189 mark against right-handers (30x159)... finished the season on a five-game winning streak, going 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA (4 ER / 43.1 IP) over six games (five starts) from July 4 to July 31... released by the Yankees on August 5 and finished the season with the Samsung Lions in the Korea Baseball Organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the 2009 season in New York (NL) organization, making 30 appearances (17 starts) for the Mets... made two starts in Spring Training on March 8 and March 12 before landing on the 15-Day Disabled List April 5th (retroactive to March 27th) with a strained right rotator cuff... had two rehabilitation starts (no decisions) with Triple-A Buffalo... made his Mets debut on May 18 at Los Angeles (NL) after being activated from the 15-Day DL earlier in the day... picked up his first hit in a Mets uniform, a single to right field in the fifth inning... picked up his first win as a member of the Mets on June 22 at home vs. St. Louis... tied his season-high with 7.0 innings and allowed 4 runs and 5 hits (the last Mets pitcher to go winless in his first six starts was Hideo Nomo in 1998)... moved to the bullpen after his start on July 2 in Pittsburgh.

Established career highs in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts with the Washington Nationals in 2008... following the season, had calcium deposit removed from the joint of his second toe on his left foot... finished tied for ninth in the NL with 33 starts... did not miss his turn in the rotation the entire season... matched his career-high in wins with 10 (also won 10 games for Houston in 2003)... became first Nats pitcher to record double figures in victories since the 2006 season... Washington went 20-13 in his starts...in his first start of the year, went 7.0 innings to beat the Phillies, 1-0, at Citizens Bank Park on April 2... established career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a 6-4 victory at Florida on April 18... threw career-best 8.0 innings, his first Major League complete game, in a 1-0 loss on July 24 at San Francisco.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Timothy James Redding... is married to Jaime with a daughter, Shea (11/13/01), and son, Brennan (9/15/03)... graduated from Monroe Community College in Rochester, NY, where his No. 17 jersey became the first in school history to be retired on Feb. 1, 2008... his great aunt, Joyce Randolph, played Trixie Norton on the Honeymooners.
