ZEPHYRS TOP 'TOPES 5-4: The Albuquerque Isotopes saw an early lead disappear as the New Orleans Zephyrs rallied past the 'Topes for a 5-4 win Saturday evening at Zephyr Field. After spotting the Zephyrs a run in the bottom of the first, the 'Topes roared back in the top of the second thanks to a two-run homer by Jamie Hoffmann that propelled Albuquerque to a 2-1 lead. Osvaldo Martinez ignited a second New Orleans uprising in third, roping a second RBI double to knot the game at 2-2. Josh Kroeger then lined a double to right, giving the Zephyrs a 3-2 edge. Albuquerque regained the lead in the fourth thanks again to the long ball, this one courtesy of Trayvon Robinson, who smashed the Isotopes' second two-run homer of the evening, instantly putting the 'Topes on top 4-3. Once again, the lead would not last, as New Orleans tied the game in the bottom of the fifth thanks to an Isotopes throwing error that allowed a run to score and knot the game at 4-4. The contest would remain deadlocked until the bottom of the eighth, when the Z's surged ahead one final time. After Jesus Merchan led off the inning with a walk and was sacrificed to second, 'Topes reliever Francisco Felix intentionally walked Petersen, giving New Orleans two on with one out. That set up the night's designated Isotopes-killer Martinez, who crushed his third RBI double of the evening, plating Merchan and giving the Zephyrs a 5-4 edge. Z's closer Jose Ceda would make the one-run lead stick, pitching around two singles before slamming the door and clinching the 5-4 win.

EVELAND KEEPS 'EM IN THE YARD: Lefty Dana Eveland makes his team-high 10th start of the season riding a streak of 20.0 consecutive innings without conceding a home run. Making his run even more impressive is it's occurred in some of the biggest launching pads in the Pacific Coast League. After keeping Las Vegas in the yard over six innings at hitter-friendly Cashman Field on May 13, Eveland held Reno and Colorado Springs homer-less in back-to-back starts at Isotopes Park over 14.0 innings. In 54.0 innings-pitched this season, Eveland has given up just five total home runs. Amazingly, while this is the lefty's 10th start on the year, it's just his third on the road, where he had gone 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER / 12.0 IP) this year. The left-hander is also the perfect guy to stop a losing streak. On May 13, Eveland's last road start, the 'Topes were mired in a three-game losing streak before the southpaw pitched a gem, allowing just four hits in six shutout innings in an 8-3 Albuquerque win.

THE SLUGGER THAMES: For the second time this week, the Isotopes lineup will be bolstered by a Major League rehab, as outfielder Marcus Thames joins the 'Topes today on his way back from a strained right quad that had bothered him since Spring Training and finally forced him onto the DL on May 3. In 22 games with the Dodgers before being sidelined, Thames batted .176 (6x34) with four runs, a triple, two homers, and four RBI. The slugging outfielder is the fourth Dodger to join the Isotopes on rehab this year, joining Jay Gibbons, Rafael Furcal, and Casey Blake, who just concluded his rehab and returned to L.A. on Friday.

WALK THIS WAY: Catcher A.J. Ellis has drawn at least one walk in each of his last four games and in nine of his last 10 contests, a span in which he's drawn a total of 14 free passes. In the one game he didn't get a walk, Ellis got a hit, extending his current on-base streak to 10 games. In 20 games with Albuquerque since joining the team from the Dodgers, Ellis has drawn 16 walks.

ROBINSON BACK ON TRACK: After enduring an 0-for-22 stretch, Robinson is starting to get hot again. Robinson has gone 3-for-8 (.375) in his last two games and last night belted his first home run since May 16, a nine-game stretch that had been his longest homer-less drought of the season.

SLOW SERIES START: Albuquerque has dropped the first two games of a series for just the second time this season. The only other time the Isotopes have started a series with two losses was the first two games in Las Vegas on May 10 and May 11.

TODAY'S START: Dana Eveland makes his team-high 10th start of the season coming off a no-decision against Colorado Springs on May 24 when he allowed three runs on five hits while striking out two and walking a season-high five in a 15-6 'Topes loss. Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation...compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
