'TOPES NIPPED BY NEW ORLEANS, 3-2: The Albuquerque Isotopes again were stymied by some excellent pitching by the New Orleans Zephyrs, who held the 'Topes to just a pair of runs in a 3-2 Z's win on a warm Memorial Day Monday at Zephyr Field. New Orleans grabbed its first advantage in the bottom of the first, when Bryan Petersen hammered a solo homer to left to lead off the frame and give the Zephyrs a quick 1-0 lead. Albuquerque answered in the top of the third, when Justin Sellers drew a lead-off walk and advanced to second on a perfectly placed sacrifice bunt by pitcher Tim Redding. Eugenio Velez then tied the game with a two-out single to right, easily plating the speedy Sellers and making the score 1-1. The home team broke the first tie in the bottom of the fourth courtesy again of a lead-off long ball. Osvaldo Martinez started the frame with a monstrous home run to left, propelling the Zephyrs to a 2-1 lead. Again, Albuquerque answered, this time in the sixth. John Lindsey started the uprising with a one-out single in front of A.J. Ellis, who blasted a double to left. While attempting to corral the spheroid, Zephyrs left fielder Oscar Salazar had the ball bounce out of his glove for an error that allowed Lindsey to lumber home and again knot the contest at 2-2. New Orleans broke the second stalemate in the bottom of the seventh, when Joe Thurston dumped a one-out single to shallow right and immediately swiped second base. With two down, former Isotope Chris Aguila roped a single through the hole at second, scoring Thurston and giving the Z's a 3-2 edge en route to the win.

BASTARDO BRILLIANT ON THE ROAD: Left-hander Alberto Bastardo takes the mound looking to continue a stretch of solid starts, especially on the road. While his overall record of 3-1 with a 4.05 ERA (21 ER / 46.2 IP) is impressive, Bastardo is 2-1 with a 3.33 ERA (9 ER / 24.1 IP) in his four starts away from Isotopes Park. In his last three outings on the road, he's been even better, going 2-1 (with the loss a hard-luck defeat at Las Vegas on May 10) with a 2.65 ERA (6 ER / 20.1 IP). Most importantly, Bastardo has shown no ill effects from a stiff back that caused him to skip a turn in the rotation last week. In his last start, a no-decision on May 26 vs. Colorado Springs, the lefty threw 94 pitches in six strong innings in which he gave up four runs, three earned, on six hits while walking three and fanning a season-high eight in a 5-4 'Topes win.

MEMPHIS MAMA: Albuquerque makes its first visit of the season to Memphis tonight to begin a four-game series with the Redbirds. While the Isotopes took three of four from the 'Birds in a meeting earlier this month at Isotopes Park, AutoZone Park has proved a tough place for the 'Topes. Last year, the Redbirds won five of eight games against Albuquerque in Memphis and historically, the Isotopes are 32-33 at AutoZone.

A LOT LEFT ON: Over their past four games, the Isotopes have left 40 men on base, an average of 10 per game. On May 29, Albuquerque left a season-high 12 on base, but also had games in which the 'Topes left 11, nine, and eight over the course of their series in New Orleans.

VELEZ VOLCANIC: With three more hits yesterday, Eugenio Velez continues to swing a hot stick for the 'Topes. The infielder / outfielder has gotten a hit in each of the last nine games he's started, a stretch in which he's batted .395 (15x38). Of the 18 games he's gotten hits in since he joined the Isotopes May 5, nine have been of the multi-hit variety.

ROAD WEARY: Albuquerque begins its series in Memphis still trying to shake out of its doldrums on the road. In their last 12 games away from Isotopes Park, the 'Topes are 4-8 and have dropped two of their last three series away from the Duke City.
