OMAHA HAMMERS ISOTOPES 11-4: The Albuquerque Isotopes allowed seven runs in the last two innings to turn a tight game into a laugher as the Omaha Storm Chasers drubbed the 'Topes 11-4 Wednesday night at Isotopes Park. After scoring a pair of runs in the third on back-to-back RBI singles, Omaha doubled the advantage in the fourth when Lucas May roped a two-out, two-run single with the bases loaded to give the visitors a 4-0 edge. The Isotopes would make things interesting in the seventh. Trent Oeltjen started the rally with a lead-off single before Corey Smith immediately followed with a double, moving the runner to third for Jamie Hoffmann, who drew a walk to load the bases. With John Lindsey at the plate, Omaha reliever Greg Holland uncorked a wild pitch, allowing Oeltjen to sail home easily with Albuquerque's first run while the other two runners advanced 90 feet. Lindsey then knocked home Smith with an RBI groundout before Damaso Espino added a run-scoring groundout of his own to bring Albuquerque back to within 4-3. Any Isotopes momentum quickly evaporated in the Storm Chasers half of the eighth as the visitors plated five runs to break the game wide open. Omaha sent 11 men to the plate in the frame and scratched out seven hits, the big blow coming from Johnny Giavotella in the form of a two-run single that gave the Chasers a 9-3 cushion. After two more Omaha runs in the top of the ninth made the score 11-3, Albuquerque delivered one last blast thanks

BASTARDO BRILLIANT: Albuquerque's most consistent starter just might be lefty Alberto Bastardo, who has been excellent in four starts so far this season, going 2-0 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP). Now the southpaw can add "out-pitch a Cy Young Award winner" to his resume after a superb outing at Nashville on April 29 when he out-dueled rehabbing righty Zack Greinke. Bastardo allowed just one run on five hits in 7.1 innings, the longest outing by a "Topes starter all season, while walking two and striking out five in a 4-1 Albuquerque win. Greinke joined the Brewers after the "Topes touched him for two runs on seven hits in five innings and a loss, while Bastardo earned his second straight victory in as many starts. In fact, the Isotopes have won every game Bastardo has started this season.

EVEN SUPERMAN HAD KRYPTONITE: The Isotopes need a win tonight to salvage a series split against Omaha, which is the only team that has proven it can beat the 'Topes on a regular basis at Isotopes Park this year. In three previous home series, Albuquerque has won two and split one, with that split coming against the Storm Chasers in the season's opening set from April 7 to April 10. Omaha is also the only team so far this season to win two games in a row over the 'Topes in the Duke City, taking back-to-back games on April 9-10 and May 3-4. Including last season, the Isotopes are 6-9 in their last 15 games

HITTIN' HOFF: Jamie Hoffmann has been swinging a hot bat at Isotopes Park, posting a home batting average this year of .469 (15x32) with 12 runs, four doubles, a triple, a homer, and four RBI in 10 games. In his last six games at The Lab, Hoffmann has batted .476 (10x21) with three multi-hit games over that span.

In addition to free carnations to the first 1,000 moms, fans will be treated to a pre-game celebrity softball game pitting the cast and crew of "Breaking Bad" against the cast and crew of "In Plain Sight" (along with some other surprise guests)!

TODAY'S START: Lefty Alberto Bastardo takes the mound coming off his second win of the season on April 29 in which he out-pitched 2009 Cy Young Award winner Zack Greinke, who was making a rehab assignment for the Nashville Sounds. Bastardo allowed just one run on five hits in 7.1 innings while walking two and striking out five in a 4-1 'Topes win over the Sounds. Earned his first win of the season on April 23 against New Orleans at Isotopes Park when he pitched six innings, allowing four runs on nine hits whie walking none and striking out seven in a 12-8 'Topes win.

2010: Split the season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 12-8 with a 5.68 ERA in 27 starts... tied for the Dodger organizational lead with 12 wins and 27 starts... won the May Dodger Pride Award for Chattanooga, going 3-1 with a 2.56 ERA (9 ER/31.2 IP) in five starts in the month... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week for the period of May 17-23, going 2-0 and allowing only an unearned run with 14 strikeouts in 14.0 innings in his two starts... took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on May 17 at Mobile before giving up a one-out single... ended up pitching seven shutout innings, giving up the one hit while walking two and striking out seven in a 7-0 Lookouts win... transferred to Albuquerque on June 10 and won three straight decisions... transferred back to Chattanooga on August 13 and finished the year in Chattanooga... following the season, played for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Winter League.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Saw action in 2009 at three levels of Dodgers system, starting in Single-A Inland Empire, stoppnig at Double-A Chattanooga and ending the season with an appearance at Triple-A Albuquerque... combined to go 12-5 with a 4.01 ERA (66 ER / 148.1 IP) in all three stops... started the season at Inland Empire, going 6-2 with a 3.84 ERA (32 ER / 75.0 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... selected to the California League Mid-Season All-Star team on June 23... transferred to Chattanooga on June 25 and went 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA (34 ER / 72.1 IP) in 14 appearances (all starts)... tossed a complete-game on August 5 vs. West Tenn., allowing two runs on three hits in nine innings while striking out eight... transferred to Albuquerque on September 6 and made a relief appearance in the last game of the regular season at Iowa on September 7, firing a scoreless inning... was on the Isotopes' playoff roster and was slated to start game four of the first round but did not pitch as the 'Topes were swept in three games.

Spent the entire 2008 season with Single-A Inland Empire of the California League, going 5-8 with a 5.19 ERA (76 ER / 131.2 IP) in 30 appearances (21 starts)... went 5-8 with a 4.70 ERA (55 ER / 105.1 IP) in 21 starts and 0-0 with a 7.18 ERA (21 ER / 26.1 IP) in nine relief appearances... following the season, played in the Venezuelan Winter League for Caribe and Margarita.

Played the entire 2007 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 6-5 with a 4.57 ERA (35 ER / 69.0 IP) in 16 appearances (13 starts)... was 5-2 with a 2.89 ERA (15 ER / 46.2 IP) at home and 1-3 with an 8.06 ERA (20 ER / 22.1 IP) on the road... posted a 3-1 record and a 2.08 ERA (5 ER / 21.2 IP) in four starts in the month of June... held opposing batters to a .218 average over that span... spent two stints on the DL (lasting a month apiece) with a leg injury... played for Caribes in the Venezuelan Winter League.
