'TOPES RALLY AND HOLD ON TO 9-8 WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes scored five times in the seventh to take a commanding five-run lead then held on for dear life before closing out the Omaha Storm Chasers for a 9-8 win on a beautiful Cinco De Mayo Thursday at Isotopes Park. Omaha grabbed a quick lead with two runs in the top of the third, but Albuquerque answered in the bottom of the frame when Dee Gordon beat out an infield single, stole second, and was immediately picked up by a single from A.J. Ellis to cut the Storm Chasers lead to 2-1. One inning later, Trayvon Robinson would tie the game with one swing of the bat, blasting a monstrous solo homer to right-center that knotted the game at 2-2. The Chasers grabbed the lead again with two runs in the fifth but again the 'Topes stormed back. With newest Isotope Eugenio Velez on third and Gordon on second with one out, Trent Oeltjen laced a single to right, easily plating both runners and tying the game at 4-4. Albuquerque's offense finally broke free in the seventh, scoring five runs to seize control of the game. Gordon started the frame with a double and was followed by back-to-back walks to Oeltjen and Corey Smith, loading the bases. That set up Jamie Hoffmann, who delivered the Isotopes their first lead of the game with a two-run single, easily scoring Gordon and Oeltjen to put the home team on top 6-4. After an intentional walk to Robinson loaded the bases again, John Lindsey made the Chasers pay with a single up the middle that plated Smith and Hoffmann to augment the advantage to 8-4 Isotopes. Finally, Velez added a sacrifice fly to center that chased home Robinson and opened up a 9-4 lead. As Albuquerque baseball fans are well aware, not even a five run lead is safe at a hitter-haven like Isotopes Park and the Storm Chasers nearly proved the point in the ninth, scoring four runs to draw within 9-8. Reliever Merkin Valdez would make sure that's where the bleeding stopped, however, finishing off the Chasers and preserving the 9-8 win.

FELIX GROOVY: Right-hander Francisco Felix takes the mound making his third consecutive start since being moved from the bullpen to the rotation, on April 24. In his two previous starts Felix has been solid, allowing five total runs in eight innings (4.0 IP in each start), posting a 5.63 ERA. In his lone start at Isotopes Park on April 24 vs. New Orleans, Felix allowed just four hits over four innings while yielding three runs in a game eventually lost by the Isotopes 10-9.

MEMPHIS MAMA: Tonight the 'Topes welcome their old nemesis the Memphis Redbirds to Isotopes Park for the teams' first meeting of the 2011 season. Last year, Albuquerque was 7-9 against the 'Birds, the Isotopes' first losing record against Memphis since 2006. All-time, the 'Topes are 71-59 against the Redbirds and are a healthy 39-26 against Memphis at Isotopes Park.

TWO HOLE SHUFFLE: Last night, A.J. Ellis became the 10th different Isotope to bat in the second position in the lineup in 26 games. Other than the ninth position, the only other slots to see that kind of variation are the seventh and eighth holes, which have each had eight different Isotopes batting out of them.

HOT CATCHER: Since returning to Albuquerque from the Dodgers, A.J. Ellis has been on a tear, batting .412 (7x17) in five games with the 'Topes. In his last three contests, Ellis has racked up six hits in 10 at-bats (.600 average) with three doubles and five RBI.

BARK IN THE PARK: The Isotopes are teaming up with Animal Humane of New Mexico to bring "Bark In The Park" to The Lab on a busy Mother's Day on Sunday, May 8. Fans can bring their four-legged pals to enjoy a 'Topes game from the Creamland Berm, where Animal Humane will set up water stations and waste receptacles. Dogs must arrive with proof of rabies vaccination, identification, valid license and must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older.

"MOTHER" OF ALL HOMESTANDS: The Isotopes' massive eight-game homestand rolls on with a the first appearance of 2011 by Breakin' BBoy McCoy, who will kick off the weekend with a performance tonight. Saturday will feature Little League Night and Post-Game Fireworks before the 'Topes treat fans to a Mother's Day spectacular on Sunday. In addition to free carnations to the first 1,000 moms, fans will be treated to a pre-game celebrity softball game pitting the cast and crew of "Breaking Bad" against the cast and crew of "In Plain

TODAY'S START: Francisco Felix makes his third start of the season after pitching 4.0 innings in his last outing on April 30 at Nashville when he yielded two runs on seven hits while walking three and striking out four in a 7-6 'Topes loss. Also pitched 4.0 innings in his first start of the season on April 24 vs. New Orleans, allowing three runs on five hits in a 10-9 Isotopes loss. Prior to moving to the rotation, he made three excellent appearances out of the bullpen in which he posted a 1-0 record with a 1.80 ERA (1 ER / 5.0 IP). Joined Albuquerque on April 11 from Extended Spring Training and earned a victory in his first appearance for the 'Topes in 2011, pitching 2.1 innings of relief on April 13 vs. Iowa, allowing a run on two hits while walking one and striking out two in a 10-7 Albuquerque win.

2010: Spent the majority of the season on loan to Saltillo of the Mexican League after making his first appearance at Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee... went 1-3 with a 6.28 ERA (43 ER / 61.2 IP) in 17 games (12 starts) for Saltillo... added to Albuquerque on August 28 and made two starts for the Isotopes, going 2-0 with a 4.26 ERA (6 ER / 12.2 IP)... pitched through the sixth in both outings.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Split the 2009 season between Double-A Chattanooga and Triple-A Albuquerque, going 4-2 with a 3.07 ERA (26 ER / 76.2 IP) in a total of 43 appearances... started the season at Chattanooga, going 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA and two saves in 29 games... was 2-2 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER / 18.2 IP) and a save in nine appearances in May... made a pair of starts for Lookouts, his first since 2007, and went 0-1 with a 4.05 ERA (3 ER / 6.2 IP)... went 3-1 with two saves and a 2.77 ERA (15 ER / 48.2 IP) while holding opponents to a .222 batting average in 27 relief appearances... transferred to Albuquerque on July 25... went 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (8 ER / 21.1 IP) in 14 appearances... earned his only win for the Isotopes in the second game of a doubleheader after pitching a perfect seventh in a 2-1 Albuquerque win... his only save was of the two-inning variety on August 8 vs. Portland... pitched a 0.1 inning of scoreless relief in Game 3 of the Isotopes' playoff series vs. Memphis... pitched for Culiacan of the Mexican Winter League for the fourth straight season, going 2-1 with a 2.43 ERA (11 ER / 40.2 IP) in 32 appearances (one start).

Split 2008 season between Single-A Inland Empire and Triple-A Las Vegas, going a combined 5-4 with a 4.27 ERA and three saves in 40 total games... began season at Inland Empire, posting a 5-3 record with a 3.31 ERA and two saves... was 4-1 with a 2.18 ERA and two saves in 12 games at home, 1-2 with a 4.13 in 13 games on the road... ranked fifth among all California League relievers by holding batters to a .198 average... was 2-0 with a 1.56 ERA in seven games in June... yielded just two hits over 11 straight scoreless innings from June 6 to June 18... held left-handed hitters to a .145 average, while righties batted .238... transferred to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 8 and finished the season going 0-1 with a 5.81 ERA and a save in 15 appearances.
