HOFFMANN HOMERS HELP 'TOPES TO 8-7 WIN: A five-run deficit proved no match for the Albuquerque Isotopes' offense as the 'Topes, paced by a pair of homers from Jamie Hoffmann, rallied to overtake the Memphis Redbirds 8-7 for a series-opening win Friday night at Isotopes Park. The Redbirds jumped out to a quick 2-0 lead in the second on a two-run homer, but the 'Topes answered right back in the bottom of the second when Hoffmann led off the frame with a solo blast, cutting the lead to 2-1. After a single by Trayvon Robinson, J.D. Closser delivered a base hit through the hole at second, scoring the runner and tying the game at 2-2. Memphis responded emphatically, scoring five times in the third to seize a commanding advantage. The 'Birds opened the frame with five straight hits, three of them scoring runs, before the biggest blow of the inning was administered by Pete Kozma, who hammered a double to right, scoring a pair to put the Redbirds ahead 7-2. Undaunted, the Isotopes began chipping away in the fourth, when Robinson belted a solo home run to make the score 7-3. After a double by Closser, starting pitcher Francisco Felix hit a single through the hole at short, plating the base-runner and making it a three-run game at 7-4. Albuquerque kept coming in the fifth. Trent Oeltjen led off the frame with a double and was immediately cashed in by a monstrous homer by Corey Smith that cleared the wall in centerfield to bring the surging Isotopes all the way to within a single run at 7-6. Finally, the Isotopes completed the rally in the seventh, when Smith stroke a one-out double, putting the tying run in the scoring position for Hoffmann, who launched a mammoth shot to left-center, giving Albuquerque its first, and only, lead of the game at 8-7. Scott Elbert finished the job in the ninth, mowing down the Redbirds in order to seal the dramatic comeback win and his second save of the season.

ELY SUPERB AT HOME: John Ely makes his third straight start at Isotopes Park coming off a pair of excellent outings in which he pitched extremely well but didn't get a decision either time. The right-hander has pitched through the sixth in each of those last two outings, allowing no more than three runs and six hits in each appearance. Ely's ERA at Isotopes Park is 3.65 (5 ER / 12.1 IP), by far the lowest among 'Topes starters, but also one of the lowest home ERAs on the staff overall. Only reliever Wilken De La Rosa has an ERA lower than Ely's and he's appeared in two games and only amassed 2.2 innings (0 ER / 0.00 ERA).

DOUBLE-DIGIT TRENT: With a pair of doubles last night Trent Oeltjen extended his current hitting streak into double-digits at 10 games, the second longest by an Isotope this year to Travon Robinson's 16-game tear. Over the course of Oeltjen's streak, the outfielder has batted .436 (17x39) with nine runs, four doubles, a triple, a homer, and seven RBI. Oeltjen has also scored a run in each of his last six contests.

TRAY, TRAY AGAIN: Trayvon Robinson's mini, three-game funk is definitely history, as the outfielder has collected a hit in each of his last seven at-bats over the last two games, racking up three singles, a double, a triple, and two homers since Thursday. With a hit in his next at-bat, Robinson will tie the Isotopes record for consecutive at-bats with a hit of eight, set by Robert Andino from June 7-9, 2007 and matched by John Gall from June 14-15, 2008.

HOMERS HAPPEN: Albuquerque has homered in each of its last eight games, the Isotopes' longest home run streak of the season. Last night against Memphis, the 'Topes hammered four round-trippers, the most in a game this season, which raised their total on the season to 35, second-most in the PCL to Reno's 39.

BARK IN THE PARK: The Isotopes are teaming up with Animal Humane of New Mexico to bring "Bark In The Park" to The Lab on a busy Mother's Day tomorrow. Fans can bring their four-legged pals to enjoy a 'Topes game from the Creamland Berm, where Animal Humane will set up water stations and waste receptacles. Dogs must arrive with proof of rabies vaccination, identification, valid license and must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older.

"MOTHER" OF ALL HOMESTANDS: The Isotopes' massive eight-game home-stand rolls on with Little League Night and Post-Game Fireworks tonight before the 'Topes treat fans to a Mother's Day spectacular on Sunday. In addition to free carnations to the first 1,000 moms, fans will be treated to a pre-game celebrity softball game pitting the cast and crew of "Breaking Bad" against the cast and crew of "In Plain Sight" (along with some other surprise guests)!

EVERYONE LOVES A PARADE: As part of tonight's Little League Night festivities, the 'Topes are having a Little League Banner Parade with teams from around the region. Nearly 100 teams will be taking part in today's pre-game parade which will stretch around the field's warning track.

TODAY'S START: John Ely takes the hill for his fifth start of the season coming off his second solid no-decision in a row on May 2 vs. Omaha, when he allowed just two runs on six hits in six innings while walking three and striking out five in an eventual 5-3 Isotopes win.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL)... picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Enjoyed a breakout 2009 season in his first year at Double-A with Birmingham in the Chicago White Sox organization, going 14-2 with a 2.82 ERA (49 ER / 156.1 IP) in 27 starts... tied for first in the Southern League with 14 wins and was first in strikeouts with 125... named Southern League Mid-Season All-Star on July 13... named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on July 20... named to the Southern League Post-Season All-Star team on August 31... traded from the White Sox with right-hander Jon Link for outfielder Juan Pierre on December 18.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/ Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game... selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
