ISOTOPES WALK-OFF WITH WILD 7-6 WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes scored a run in the bottom of the ninth on a Memphis Redbirds error, capping a wild inning and a 7-6 'Topes walk-off win Saturday night at Isotopes Park. With the game knotted at 6-6 in the bottom of the ninth, Dee Gordon drew a lead-off walk, putting one of the fastest players in the PCL on base. Trent Oeltjen then dropped down a perfect bunt that was fielded by the pitcher Victor Marte and thrown to first, but the toss drew first baseman Nick Stavino into the basepath and into an on-coming Oeltjen, who knocked the ball fire and sent it skittering into right field. Meanwhile, like a flash, Gordon circled the bases, sliding home just ahead of the throw from right field and giving Albuquerque a thrilling 7-6 walk-off win. The wild ninth inning was the perfect ending to a see-saw game that featured four different lead changes. Albuquerque jumped out on top in the second when Justin Sellers smashed a three-run homer over the wall in left-center to give the Isotopes an immediate 3-0 edge. Memphis got one of the runs back in the fourth on a solo homer, but the Isotopes answered in the bottom of the frame on back-to-back doubles by Damaso Espino and Sellers to help the home team to a 4-1 advantage. The 'Birds surged ahead in the fifth thanks to a five-run inning that saw nine men come to the plate. With runners on the corners and one out, Freddie Bynum poked a single to right, scoring Pete Kozma and trimming the lead to 4-2. Stavino then laced an RBI double ahead of a sacrifice fly by Andrew Brown that helped Memphis climb into a 4-4 tie. Tony Cruz then capped the inning with an RBI single of his own to help the 'Birds to a 5-4 edge. Albuquerque would answer in kind thanks to some wildness on the part of Memphis reliever Blake King, who walked the first two batters he faced, then beamed pitcher Ramon Troncoso as he was at the plate to load the bases with no outs. Chuckie Fick immediately came on to replace King but inherited his wildness, uncorking a wild pitch that allowed Espino to trot home from third with the tying run. A Gordon RBI groundout then gave the 'Topes a short-lived 6-5 lead. Stavino would add a solo home run off Troncoso in the seventh to tie the game and set-up the eventual ninth-inning dramatics.

DANA THE DECIDER: Lefty Dana Eveland takes the mound looking to bounce back from his first loss at Isotopes Park in four starts. On May 3 vs. Omaha, Eveland allowed a season-high six runs (five earned) on six hits while walking four and striking out five in a 7-5 'Topes defeat. Most uncharacteristic about Eveland's outing, other than the loss, was the fact he surrendered two home runs. In 17.1 innings-pitched at Isotopes Park previous to his last outing, the left-hander had yielded just one big fly. Eveland has earned a decision in every start he's made this year, going 3-2 in five total appearances.

HIGH WATER: With a record of 17-11, the Isotopes are six games over .500, the most games clear of even they've been all season. Last night, Albuquerque won its 12th home game, giving the 'Topes the best home record at 12-6 of any team in the PCL in terms of wins. A win today would give the Isotopes a season-high four-game winning streak for the second time this year and clinch their third series win in four sets played at The Lab this year.

ONE-RUN WONDERS: The Isotopes have won each of their last three games by one run, lifting their season record in the closest of contests to 6-2.

JUAN OF A KIND: The last time Isotopes fans saw Juan Castro before last night was when he was helped off the field while in tremendous pain after straining his oblique during an at-bat against Iowa on April 13. Less than a month after the scary injury, Castro returned to the 'Topes and promptly got two hits in his first game back last night. Even given the amazing recovery, Castro will still be eased in regular action, playing five innings today before resting tomorrow.

BARK IN THE PARK: The Isotopes are teaming up with Animal Humane of New Mexico to bring "Bark In The Park" to The Lab on a busy Mother's Day today. Fans can bring their four-legged pals to enjoy a 'Topes game from the Creamland Berm, where Animal Humane will set up water stations and waste receptacles. Dogs must arrive with proof of rabies vaccination, identification, valid license and must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older.

"MOTHER" OF ALL HOMESTANDS: The Isotopes' massive eight-game home-stand rolls on with the mother of all Mother's Days. In addition to free carnations to the first 1,000 moms, fans will be treated to a pre-game celebrity softball game pitting the cast and crew of "Breaking Bad" against the cast and crew of "In Plain Sight" (along with some other surprise guests)!

TODAY'S START: Lefty Dana Eveland makes the start coming off his first loss of the season at Isotopes Park on May 3 when he yielded six runs, five earned, on six hits (two of them homers) in 6.1 innings of a 7-5 Isotopes loss. The defat broke a three-game home winning streak for the left-hander after he beat New Orleans on April 26, allowing four runs, two earned, on six hits in five innings while walking three and striking out one in a 13-8 'Topes win. Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents' batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances... with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation... compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland... married... graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
