BIRDS BLAST ISOTOPES 10-4: The Albuquerque Isotopes surrendered six total runs in the sixth through the eighth as the Memphis Redbirds turned a close game into a laugher, earning an easy series-opening 10-4 win Tuesday night at AutoZone Park. Memphis drew first blood, scoring a pair of runs in the first and one more in the third to take a 3-0 lead before the Isotopes answered in the top of the fourth. With two on and two out, Trayvon Robinson hammered a three-run blast to right that instantly knotted the game at 3-3. The Redbirds immediately broke the tie in the bottom of the fourth, however, when Aaron Luna lifted a sacrifice fly to center with the bases loaded to give the home team a 4-3 advantage. Albuquerque responded again in the top of the sixth in a rally ignited by a Memphis fielding error. After J.D. Closser led off the inning with a single, Russ Mitchell hit a grounder to third baseman Matt Carpenter, whose throw to second in an attempt to force Closser was missed by the second baseman and sailed into the outfield, allowing Closser to scamper into third and put runners on the corners with one out. A.J. Ellis then lifted a sacrifice fly to center, plating Closser and again tying the game at 4-4. That is where the Isotopes rally would end and also where the game began to get away from Albuquerque as Memphis grabbed the lead right back in the bottom of the sixth on an RBI double by Luna to seize a 5-4 edge. Things got worse one inning later, when the 'Birds added two more tallies before breaking the game wide open with three in the eighth to give the home team a 10-4 triumph.

ELY RIDING THE ROLLER COASTER: In just two starts, right-hander John Ely has experienced his best outing of the season and his toughest. After a brilliant complete-game on May 22 vs. Reno when he allowed just one run on three hits in a 'Topes win, Ely had his shortest outing of the season his last time out at New Orleans on May 27. The reliable right-hander lasted just three innings, giving up six runs, five of them earned, on nine hits while walking two and, incredibly, striking out none in a 6-3 loss to the Zephyrs. While there wasn't a decision involved, the Ely ups and downs actually stretch back to his last four starts, when he followed up an excellent outing at Las Vegas on May 12 in which he allowed two unearned runs on just three hits in seven innings by giving up a season-high six earned runs on 10 hits in a subsequent start at Tucson on May 17.

SPEED DEE-MON: Dee Gordon has swiped 12 bases in his last 13 attempts, raising his total on the season to 20, second-most in the PCL behind Fresno's Tyler Graham, who has 24. In just 51 games, Gordon has not only surpassed the team-high 17 stolen bases that Jamie Hoffmann racked up a year ago, he alone has a quarter of the number of total stolen bases the 2010 'Topes had as a team (80).

TRAY BIEN: On the Isotopes' current road trip, outfielder Trayvon Robinson is batting .353 (6x17) with three homers and six RBI in four games. After going a season-high nine straight games without leaving the yard, Robinson has a homer in each of the last three games in which he's gotten a plate appearance (he was a defensive substitution on May 30 and didn't get an at-bat). Robinson now leads the Isotopes with 11 home runs, one ahead of Jamie Hoffmann's 10.

MEET THE NEWBY: After carrying the Isotopes pitching staff for much of the season, the 'Topes bullpen has struggled of late, with Albuquerque relievers going a combined 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA (9 ER / 10.1 IP) in the last four games. The Isotopes did get an additional arm yesterday in right-hander Joe Newby, who saw his first Triple-A action since 2009 with Tacoma last night in two innings of relief. Last year, Newby pitched for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League, going 6-5 with a 2.48 ERA in 37 games (14 starts). On August 5 of last season, he and closer Ed Warden combined to throw the first no-hitter in Blue Claws history in a 3-1 win over Newark. Newby did most of the heavy lifting, pitching eight-plus innings before walking in Newark's only run in the bottom of the ninth and being lifted for Warden.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander John Ely takes the mound coming off the shortest outing of the season, when he went just three innings, allowing six runs, five earned, on nine hits while walking two and striking out none in a 6-3 lead.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER/ 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game... selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
