SOUNDS SOCK ISOTOPES 14-1: After 12 straight games on the road, the Albuquerque Isotopes had an unhappy homecoming, falling 14-1 to the Nashville Sounds Thursday night at Isotopes Park. Nashville plated six runs in the first inning to grab hold of the game as soon as it began. After a two-run homer by George Kottaras made the score 4-0, Caleb Gindl added a two-run shot of his own three batters later to help the Sounds to a quick 6-0 lead. The Sounds added five more tallies in the third in a rally highlighted by yet another long ball by Gindl. After back-to-back singles, Gindl blasted a three-run homer deep over the centerfield fence to give Nashville an 8-0 cushion. An RBI triple by Brandon Boggs and a subsequent single by Jordan Brown made the score 11-0 Nashville after just three innings. Nashville tacked on two more runs in the fifth thanks to a two-run single by Mat Gamel and one more in the sixth on a run-scoring single by Brandon Boggs to increase the Sounds lead to 14-0. Albuquerque avoided the shutout in the ninth when J.D. Closser roped a one-out double and scored on a single by Trayvon Robinson to put the 'Topes on the board 14-1.

ACE ON THE MOUND: Lefty Dana Eveland takes the mound having established himself as the ace of the Isotopes staff, posting a team-high six wins while adding an excellent 3.90 ERA (29 ER / 67.0 IP) in 11 starts. Eveland also boasts a team-high three game winning streak over a span of five starts (with a pair of no-decisions in there) in which he's posted a sterling 2.73 ERA (10 ER / 33.0 IP). Eveland has not yielded more than three earned runs in a start since way back on May 8, which also happens to be the last time he tasted defeat. Plus, with six wins, his next victory will tie him for the Pacific Coast League lead. The secret to Eveland's success in a hitter's league comes down to an uncanny ability to coax ground balls. The southpaw has yielded 1.81 ground-ball outs for every out he's gotten through the air, the best such ratio on the Isotopes staff.

FIRST THING'S FIRST: Even with last night's defeat, the Isotopes enter play today in a flat-footed tie with the Round Rock Express, thanks to an assist from Mother Nature. After the Express jumped out to an 8-1 lead at Iowa, heavy rain suspended the game in the bottom of the fourth. The contest will be completed on June 10. Meanwhile, the 'Topes and Round Rock have identical records of 33-26 and are both two games clear of the New Orleans Zephyrs in the PCL's American Southern Division.

CLOSSER THAN IT APPEARS: J.D. Closser's red-hot 2011 season shows no signs of letting up as the catcher / infielder has racked up hits in each of his last five contests, a span in which he's accumulated three straight multi-hit efforts while going 9-for-21 (.429). He has also gotten a hit in each of his last six home games, batting .450 (9x20) with five runs, three homers, and nine RBI in that span.

GETTING SAND-Y IN ALBUQUERQUE: While the Isotopes' lineup is certainly impacted by outfielder Trent Oeltjen going to the Dodgers, the return of Jerry Sands to Albuquerque will certainly help soften the blow. After joining Los Angeles on April 18 for his Major League debut, the young outfielder appeared in 41 games, batting .200 (25x125) with 11 runs, 10 doubles, two homers, and 17 RBI. On the day he was called-up, Sands started in left field and belted a double off Atlanta starter Tim Hudson for his first Major League hit. On May 21, Sands unloaded his first big league home run, a solo shot off Chicago White Sox ace Mark Buerhle before adding his first Major League grand slam three days later at Houston off J.A. Happ. Sands comes back to Albuquerque looking to regain the form he displayed the last time he was here, a span of 10 games in which he pretty much owned the PCL. In 10 contests from Opening Day, April 7 to April 16, Sands batted .400 (16x40) with 12 runs, two doubles, a triple, five homers, and 17 RBI. From April 9-12, he homered in four straight games, still a team-high.

HOME HEAT: Last night marked the first time the Isotopes have dropped a series-opening game at home all season, breaking a streak of seven straight series-opening wins at The Lab. Even with the set-back, Albuquerque is 6-3 in its last nine home games and 5-2 in its last seven games overall.

A BIG, COMPACT, HOMESTAND: The 'Topes' action-packed four-game homestand rolls on with the first and only visit by Myron Noodleman tonight, followed by a spectacular post-game fireworks show tomorrow, and a tote bag giveaway on Sunday!

TODAY'S START: Dana Eveland takes the mound riding a team and season-high three-game winning streak after getting the victory on June 3 at Memphis, going seven innings in which he allowed two runs on five hits while walking one and striking out four in a 3-2 'Topes win. Earned his fifth win of the season on May 29 at New Orleans when he allowed three runs on four hits while walking one and striking out eight in a 6-5 win, the 'Topes' only victory in that series. Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances... with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation... compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland... married... graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
