KEISLER THE KEY TO A 5-2 'TOPES WIN: Behind a strong performance from starting pitcher Randy Keisler, the Albuquerque Isotopes knocked off the Nashville Sounds 5-2, in a rare Saturday afternoon contest at Isotopes Park. The left-hander was dominant through seven innings, allowing just one run on four hits while walking one and striking out six to earn his second straight victory. Keisler's only mistake came in the third inning and allowed Nashville to take the early lead. After Caleb Gindl led off the Sounds' third with a base hit, he moved to second base on a groundout and then came home as Nashville starting pitcher Amaury Rivas knocked an RBI single to put the visitors up, 1-0. One inning later, the Isotopes drew even thanks to a Keisler sacrifice fly that knotted the game at 1-1. The fifth inning saw Albuquerque take the lead for good. With the bases loaded and one out, Trayvon Robinson drew a free pass, plating Ivan De Jesus the easy way from third and giving the Isotopes a 2-1 advantage. After the Isotopes scored a run in the sixth to make the score 3-1, Albuquerque busted the game open in the seventh with two more tallies delivered by Robinson. With runners on first and second with no out, Robinson smashed a double to right that brought in both runners to make it 5-1, 'Topes. Nashville would make some noise in the top of the ninth with a solo homer by Mat Gamel, but Jon Link slammed the door, preserving the 5-2 'Topes triumph.

ELY BACK IN THE FOLD: Right-hander John Ely is back on the bump after a whirlwind trip that saw him make his first career Major League relief appearance with the Dodgers. After getting recalled by Los Angeles on June 4, Ely joined the Dodgers in Cincinnati and saw action the next day against the Reds, coming into the game in the sixth inning in relief of starter Chad Billingsley with the Dodgers ahead 9-4. The right-hander worked three solid innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in an eventual 9-6 Dodgers win, coming just one inning away from securing his first big league save. The appearance out of the bullpen was his first at any level of professional baseball since his very first professional appearance on June 29, 2007 when he pitched an inning of relief for Great Falls (rookie- White Sox organization) against Billings. After that, every other appearance Ely has made in professional baseball has been a start, a string of 108 straight through his five-year career before that relief appearance against the Reds. The right-hander hopes a return to the Isotopes is also a return to form. Since his complete-game gem against Reno at Isotopes Park on May 22, Ely is 0-2 with a 14.14 ERA (11 ER / 7.0 IP) in two starts with

WALKING ON SUNSHINE: Albuquerque will play its eighth home day game of the season today hoping to even up its record in games played in the sunshine at Isotopes Park after posting a 3-4 mark through seven games. The last time the 'Topes played a day game at home, John Ely was the starter and pitched a complete-game on May 22 vs. Reno, allowing just one run on three hits in a 3-1 Isotopes win. After today the Isotopes will play just three more home day games this season (June 20, July 25, and August 21).

**HIGH WATER:** With a record of 35-26 and the Isotopes are nine games over .500 for the first time this season, which is in large part due to a PCL-best home mark of 21-10 this year. A win today would give the Isotopes their fourth consecutive series victory and mark the sixth time Albuquerque has triumphed in a series at The Lab in eight four-game sets played at home this season.

'MAZING MERKIN: Since he suffered a rough outing against Colorado Springs, when he yielded eight runs in a third of an inning, reliever Merkin Valdez has been superb. In his seven appearances since that outing against the Sky Sox on May 24, Valdez has gone 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER / 10.0 IP) and a save while striking out nine. The big right-hander has given up just four hits in his last 5.2 innings-pitched, all scoreless frames.

A BIG, COMPACT, HOMESTAND WRAPS UP: The 'Topes' action-packed four-game homestand wraps up today with 'Topes Tote Bags to the first 3,000 fans courtesy of United RV. Don't fret, though. After four days in Oklahoma City, the Isotopes are right back home this coming Friday for another eight games of fun at Isotopes Park!

**TODAY'S START:** John Ely makes his first appearance back with the Isotopes after a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a seasonlong three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
