'TOPES SWEPT IN TWIN-BILL BY REDHAWKS: The Albuquerque Isotopes' high-powered offense hit a brick wall in Bricktown, as the 'Topes were swept in a doubleheader by the Oklahoma RedHawks by the scores of 2-0 and 5-3 Tuesday evening at Bricktown Ballpark. In the first game, the Isotopes were held in check by a trio of RedHawks pitchers, with lefty Wesley Wright making an emergency start and allowing just one hit over four scoreless innings before handing off to Daniel Meszaros, who added another 1.2 scoreless frames of his own before Jose Valdez finished off Albuquerque with another 1.1 innings of one-hit ball to complete just the third shutout of the Isotopes this season. Meanwhile, Oklahoma City jumped on the scoreboard in the bottom of the first when Oswaldo Navarro drew a bases loaded walk from 'Topes starter Tim Redding to give the home team a 1-0 edge. The 'Hawks doubled their advantage in the fourth thanks to a lead-off double by Drew Locke, who advanced to third on a wild pitch and scored on an RBI groundout to send the RedHawks to a 2-0 win. Unfortunately, the night-cap provided little respite, as again Oklahoma City jumped out on top with two runs in the bottom of the first on a two-run double by Tommy Manzella to put the 'Hawks on top 2-0. Albuquerque finally got on the board in the top of the second when J.D. Closser roped a one-out single, stole second base, and scored when Jamie Hoffmann hit a ball to shortstop Wladimir Sutil, whose attempt to complete a double-play sailed into the stands behind first, allowing Closser to scamper home with the 'Topes' first run. One inning later, the Isotopes tied the game on an RBI single by Jerry Sands to knot things up at 2-2. Oklahoma City again surged ahead in the bottom of the fifth on a two-out, two-run single by Brian Bogusevic to make the score 4-2 'Hawks, but the Isotopes answered when Eugenio Velez drew a bases-loaded walk to cut the score to 4-3. The RedHawks would have the last laugh, however, as Brian Dopriak crushed a solo homer in the bottom of the sixth to send Oklahoma City to a 5-3 game-two win and a doubleheader sweep.

LOOKING FOR SEVEN: Lefty Dana Eveland takes the mound looking for his seventh victory and fourth win in a row, with the last time he tasted defeat way back on May 8. Since that outing, Eveland is 3-0 over six starts while posting a 3.00 ERA (13 ER / 39.0 IP). The southpaw nearly had lucky number seven in his last outing against Nashville on June 10, allowing just three runs on six hits in six innings while walking two and striking out two. While Eveland left with a 6-3 lead, he wound up with a tough-luck no-decision after the Sounds rallied to score three runs in the eighth and send the game to extra-innings, where the 'Topes eventually prevailed in 10 frames 7-6. As great as Eveland's been overall, he's been even better on the road, where he's gone 3-1 with a 2.88 ERA (8 ER / 25.0 IP) in four starts.

A RARE SKID: After dropping both ends of yesterday's doubleheader, the Isotopes have dropped back-to-back games for the first time since

May 30-June 1, when the 'Topes dropped three in a row. The twin-bill sweep was the first since August 6 of last year when Albuquerque fell twice in a doubleheader at home to the Sacramento River Cats and the first sweep on the road since Iowa took two from the Isotopes in Des Moines on June 27, 2008. In fact, Albuquerque has had just eight losing streaks of two or more games (and none more than three) all season. Conversely, the Isotopes have had 11 winning streaks this season of two games or more.

SIMMERING SANDS: Jerry Sands's bat is starting to heat up, which is bad news for the PCL pitchers. Since returning to the Isotopes from the Dodgers on June 10, Sands is batting .304 (7x23) with four runs, two doubles, a homer, and five RBI in six games. Like before he joined the Dodgers, Sands has also been playing all over field, seeing time in left field, right field, and first base.

TIME TO START A NEW STREAK: After collecting a pair of hits in the first game of yesterday's doubleheader to extend his hitting streak to 16 games, Trayvon Robinson was shutout in the second game, ending the streak at 16, tied with himself for the longest streak by an Isotope this season. For his second 16-gamer, Robinson batted .406 (26x64) with 11 runs, three doubles, a triple, six homers, and 17 RBI. Aside from Robinson's two 16-game streaks, the only other Isotope to even hit double-digits so far this year is Trent Oeltjen, who hit in 11 straight games from April 25 to May 7.

FATHER'S DAY AROUND THE BEND: The 'Topes are right back home this Friday for an exciting Father's Day weekend of activity at The Lab. On Friday, the team will be giving away Isotopes hats courtesy of Miller Lite to kick-off a weekend that includes post-game fireworks on Saturday. On Father's Day Sunday, fathers and children are invited to the field for a pre-game catch!

straight win after a no-decision on June 10 at Isotopes Park when he allowed three runson six hits while walking two and striking out two in a 7-6 10-inning Isotopes win. Eveland departed with a 6-3 lead, but Nashville scored three runs late to send the game into extra innings. Won his team-high sixth game on June 3 at Memphis, going seven innings in which he allowed two runs on five hits while walking one and striking out four in a 3-2 'Topes win. Earned his fifth win of the season on May 29 at New Orleans when he allowed three runs on four hits while walking one and striking out eight in a 6-5 win, the 'Topes' only victory in that series. Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER/9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against righthanders... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation...compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
