## **IOWA CUBS (30-37) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (38-29)**

'TOPES TRAMPLE REDHAWKS 8-2: Stymied offensively for most of the series, the Albuquerque Isotopes broke through with eight runs, four of them in the eighth, to beat the Oklahoma City RedHawks 8-2 Thursday night at Bricktown Ballpark. For the first time in the set, Albuquerque scored first, plating a run in the very first inning when Eugenio Velez led off the game with a single, swiped second, and scampered home on a base hit by Jay Gibbons to give the Isotopes a 1-0 lead. Oklahoma City answered with a run in the bottom of the first to tie the game, but the 'Topes seized the lead right back in the top of the second. J.D. Closser led off the frame with a single and scored all the way from first two batters later on a towering double off the wall in center by Russ Mitchell to give Albuquerque a 2-1 advantage. The Isotopes increased the lead in the sixth when Jerry Sands led off the inning with a double and scored on another double by Mitchell to give the visitors a 3-1 edge. Again, the 'Hawks inched closer with a run in the bottom of the seventh to make the score 3-2, but the 'Topes blew the game wide open in a four-run eighth. With A.J. Ellis on second and two out, Oklahoma City reliever Pat Urckfitz intentionally walked pinch-hitter John Lindsey to get to Velez, who made the pitcher pay with a single to right, scoring Ellis and increasing the Albuquerque lead to 4-2. Ivan De Jesus Jr. then followed with a double, plating Lindsey and Velez to increase the lead to 6-2 'Topes. Gibbons capped the scoring with a triple off the wall in right, easily scoring De Jesus and just like that, the Isotopes had a commanding 7-2 lead. For good measure, Albuquerque added one more run in the ninth on an RBI double by Ellis to send the Isotopes to a comfortable 8-2 win.

JOHN ON THE JOB: John Ely takes the mound looking turn around a stretch of three straight Isotopes starts in which he has uncharacteristically struggled. Since his complete-game gem against Reno on May 22, Ely has gone 0-2 with a 16.20 ERA (18 ER / 10.1 IP) in his last three starts with Albuquerque. The right-hander had his toughest outing in his last start, on June 12 when he yielded season-highs in hits (12), runs (9), and earned runs (7) in just 3.1 innings of work, but avoided a third straight defeat when the Isotopes rallied for a 16-14 win over the Nashville Sounds. Part and parcel with Ely's struggles has been a sudden propensity to give up the long ball. After conceding just five homers over his first nine starts (spread across a total of 55.1 innings), the right-hander has allowed four homers in his last two (over 7.1 innings of work).

**HOMEWARD BOUND:** Today the 'Topes begin an eight-game homestand looking to continue their red-hot play at The Lab. Over their last 17 games at home, Albuquerque has gone an incredible 13-4, winning four straight series in the process. Overall, the Isotopes have won six of the eight four-game series they've played at home, including a series win over tonight's opponent Iowa on April 11-14, when Albuquerque closed out the first homestand of the 2011 season by taking three of four from the

CUB CLUBBERS: Perhaps noone is happier to see the Iowa Cubs come pulling into town than outfielders Trayvon Robinson and Jerry Sands, who have each been excellent against I-Cubs pitching so far this year. Robinson is batting .321 (9x27) against the Cubs with seven runs, a double, three homers, and 10 RBI in eight games. Sands only played four games against Iowa before getting called up, but he made the most of them, batting .471 (8x17) with five runs, a double, a triple, two homers and nine RBI

BUSTING OUT: After enduring a season-high 0-for-9 stretch, Eugenio Velez broke out in a big way, racking up three hits in six trips in last night's win over Oklahoma City. The versatile Velez is now second on the Isotopes to Trayvon Robinson with 16 multi-hit games (Robinson has 18).

**REDDING ON THE MOVE:** Just one day after being granted his release by the Dodgers, right-hander Tim Redding signed a minor league deal with the Philadelphia Phillies yesterday and will join the Lehigh Valley Iron Pigs in the International League. Redding was 2-7 with a 6.59 ERA (51 ER / 69.2 IP) in 13 starts with the 'Topes. In his spot in the rotation slides another veteran big-leaguer in right-hander lan Snell, who joined the Isotopes on June 13.

FATHER'S DAY AROUND THE BEND: The 'Topes are back home tonight for an exciting Father's Day weekend of activity at The Lab. Tonight, the team will be giving away Isotopes hats courtesy of Miller Lite to kick-off a weekend that includes post-game fireworks on Saturday. On Father's Day Sunday, fathers and children are invited to the field for a pre-game catch, plus the first 3,000 fans will get 'Topes T-shirts!

**TODAY'S START:** Righty John Ely makes the start after a tough outing on June 12 vs. Nashville when he allowed season-highs in hits (12), runs (9), and earned-runs (7) in just 3.1 innings of work. The Isotopes rallied late, however, to claim a 16-14 win and take Ely off the hook.

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first Major League save, but Josh Lindblom pitched the ninth for LA.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year.

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a  $2.18\ ERA\ (8\ ER\ /\ 33.0\ IP)$  in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
