ISOTOPES OUT-SLUG CUBS 13-10: With the help of a six-run second inning and a five-run fifth, the Albuquerque Isotopes had enough offensive muscle to hold off the Iowa Cubs in a 13-10 victory Friday night at Isotopes Park. Iowa jumped ahead with a pair of runs in the top of the first inning, but the Isotopes responded with their first major offensive burst of the evening, which began with Trayvon Robinson drilling a homer over the wall in center field to cut the I-Cubs' lead to 2-1. Two batters later, Damaso Espino tripled to center and then came home on a Justin Sellers double that tied the contest at 2-2. 'Topes starting pitcher John Ely followed with a walk, and after Sellers stole third base. Velez knocked in two runs with a triple to right-center. Now up 4-2, Albuquerque kept pouring it on with an RBI double from Ivan De Jesus, Jr. that plated Velez. That brought up Jay Gibbons, who brought home De Jesus, Jr. with a base hit that made it 6-2, 'Topes. The I-Cubs chopped their four-run deficit in half in the top of the third, however, plating a pair of runs before Tyler Colvin blasted a solo homer in the fifth to bring the Cubs back to within 6-5. Albuquerque quickly got to work rebuilding its lead in the bottom half of the fifth. Gibbons led off the frame with a single and after a walk to Jerry Sands, Robinson singled to load the bases. Jamie Hoffmann then drew a walk, scoring Gibbons and putting the 'Topes on top 7-5. Espino followed with a sacrifice fly, scoring Sands to make it 8-5 'Topes before Sellers continued the surge with a single up the middle that brought home Robinson and increased the lead to 9-5 Albuquerque. Ely then laid down a perfect sacrifice bunt that scored Hoffmann in front of Velez, who capped the inning with an RBI single, scoring Sellers and pushing the lead to 11-5. The 'Topes kept boosting their lead in the bottom of the sixth, when Hoffmann ripped a two-run homer to left to stretch Albuquerque's lead to 13-5. Iowa would not go away quietly. Welington Castillo blasted a two-run homer over the scoreboard in left-center to put Iowa within 13-7 and would add a three-run homer in the ninth to make the score 13-10 before 'Topes reliever Adam Dedeaux closed out the game, preserving the win.

A PERFECT JUNE: Right-hander Tim Sexton makes the start looking to continue what has been a perfect June. In three starts this month, the Sexton is an unblemished 3-0 with a 3.24 ERA (6 ER / 16.2 IP), beginning his Triple-A career with three straight wins, the best start for an Isotope making his Triple-A debut since Daniel Barone won his first seven decisions for the 'Topes in 2008. The only milestone left for Sexton is his first Triple-A home win, as all three of his victories so far have come on the road. In fact, this will be the right-hander's first home appearance since his Triple-A debut on May 23 when he put in an excellent outing against Colorado Springs, allowing just one run on three hits in six innings while walking none and striking out three in a no-decision.

FIRST THING'S FIRST: Last night's win coupled with Round Rock's loss against Omaha has given the Isotopes a two-game lead in the PCL's American Southern Division, their largest of the season. Since taking control of the top spot in the division on June 7, the 'Topes have spent the last 10 consecutive days with a share of first place, also a season high.

DYNAMITE DE JESUS: Ivan De Jesus Jr., has been locked in of late, collecting a hit in each of his last five games and in eight of last nine. Since June 9, De Jesus is batting .361 (13x36), raising his season average from .267 to .297, with four runs, three doubles, and four RBI. In his last two games the infielder has been particularly hot, collecting five hits in his last 10 at-bats.

HOME SWEET HOME: Albuquerque is currently riding a four-game home winning streak, the Isotopes' longest of the season. In their last 13 home games, the 'Topes are 10-3, increasing their record at Isotopes Park this season to 23-10, easily the best in the PCL.

SELLERS SIMMERING: After batting .187 (17x91) combined in the months of April and May, Justin Sellers is batting .349 (15x43) so far in the month of June. In his last five games, Sellers is hitting at a .417 (5x12) clip.

FATHER'S DAY WEEKEND AT THE LAB!: The 'Topes' big Father's Day weekend continues with a spectacular post-game fireworks show presented by Cricket Wireless. TODAY'S START: Tim Sexton takes the mound having won each of his last three starts, the last coming on June 13 at Oklahoma City when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs no eight hits while walking one and striking out two in a 4-3 'Topes win. The right-hander has won each of his three starts in the month of June.

Earned his first career Triple-A win, a 5-4 triumph at Memphis on June 2 when he allowed two runs on six hits in five innings while walking two and striking out three.

Enjoyed an excellent outing in his debut with the Isotopes on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs when he pitched six strong innings, allowing one run (an Ian Stewart solo homer) on just three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 Albuquerque win.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20.

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).
