'TOPES TAKE ANOTHER 13-10 WIN: Another high-powered offensive display helped the Albuquerque Isotopes notch their second straight 13-10 victory over the Iowa Cubs in as many nights on Saturday evening at Isotopes Park. After Iowa plated three in the top of the first and tacked on another in the second to grab a 4-0 lead, the Isotopes roared back in the bottom of the frame, sending 16 men to the plate while banging out 10 hits. The rally started with three straight RBI singles from Jamie Hoffmann, A.J. Ellis, and Justin Sellers, before Eugenio Velez added a two-run single to give Albuquerque a 5-4 lead. Ivan De Jesus, Jr. continued the offensive explosion with an RBI double to right field before Jerry Sands contributed to the hit parade with an RBI single for a 7-4 'Topes lead. Robinson then added another RBI single, Hoffmann knocked in a pair, and Ellis roped another RBI base hit, giving the 'Topes an 11-4 lead without an out even being recorded. The offensive deluge tied a team record for most runs in a frame with 11 set and equaled in the Isotopes' inaugural year of 2003. The 10 knocks in the inning also tied a team mark set in 2003. After plating two more in the bottom of the third to grab a 13-4 advantage, the 'Topes then had to hang on, as Iowa scored six times in the fourth to make it a 13-10 game. That's where the uprising would end, however, thanks to superb work by the Isotopes bullpen. Joe Newby (1-2) came on in relief of starter Tim Sexton with two down in the fourth and worked 3.1 excellent innings in which he gave up a hit and walk while striking out four to earn his first win as an Isotope. Travis Schlichting held the line with a scoreless eighth before Jon Link (6) collected his sixth save of the season with a 1-2-3 ninth, sealing the 'Topes win.

AN ISOTOPES DEBUT FOR IAN: Newest Isotopes pitcher Ian Snell makes his first start of the season and his first appearance at Isotopes Park since joining the team on June 13. Snell initially began the spring in St. Louis Cardinals camp but when he was sent down to the minor leagues, he opted for retirement instead. It didn't take long for the 29 year-old to realize he still had a lot of innings left in him and the Dodgers quickly snatched him up, signing him to a minor league free agent contract on May 25. After a few weeks in Arizona throwing at the Dodgers' Spring Training complex in Glendale, Snell joined the Isotopes in Oklahoma City, where he made his 'Topes debut pitching in relief in the second game of a doubleheader against the RedHawks, giving up one run (on a Brian Dopirak solo homer) in one inning of work. Now that he's been moved to the rotation, the Isotopes will get a pitcher with a wealth of Major League starting experience. In parts of seven season (most with the Pirates and parts of two with Seattle), Snell has started 136 big league games and has amassed 38 Major League wins.

BRING OUT YOUR SLUGGING SHOES: Fans of unbridled offense have no doubt enjoyed the Isotopes' series with the I-Cubs so far as the teams have scored 23 runs (two 13-10 Albuquerque wins) in back-to-back games. Including the four-game set the two teams played at Isotopes Park in April, the 'Topes and Cubs have combined for 110 runs and 155 hits in six games! The last three games at The Lab (including the last game of the 'Topes series with Nashville) have featured a combined 76 runs scored on 102 hits and an average time of game of 3:30.

YOU CAN'T HASSLE THE HOFF: Jamie Hoffmann has enjoyed Iowa pitching so far this series, collecting five hits in nine at-bats against the I-Cubs with three runs, and seven RBI. Last night, he had a season-high four RBI at the end of three innings.

STILL ROLLIN': The Isotopes have now won a season-high five straight games at Isotopes Park, their longest home winning streak since they won a team-record 10 games in a row at The Lab from June 25 to July 24, 2009. With a record of 40-29, tied for the most games over .500 they've been all season at 11, the 'Topes have the second-best record in the PCL to Sacramento's mark of 45-25.

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Ian Snell makes his first start as an Isotope after making one relief appearance for Albuquerque in the second game of a doubleheader on June 14 at Oklahoma City when he allowed one run (on a sixth-inning solo homer by Brian Dopirak) in one inning of work.

Signed with St. Louis to a minor league contract with an invite to Major League Spring Training on January 14. Sent to Minor League camp on March 13 but opted to retire instead. Signed with Los Angeles on May 25.

2010: Split the season between Seattle Mariners and Triple-A Tacoma... went 0-5, 6.41 in 12 games, making eight starts with Seattle before being designated for assignment on June 15... was outrighted June 19 and re-signed as a minor league free agent on June 22... went 0-5, 6.11 (24 ER / 35.1 IP) in eight starts... in four relief appearances posted a 7.36 ERA (9 ER / 11.0 IP)... made first relief appearance on May 6 vs. Tampa Bay, allowing two runs in 3.1 innings, his first relief appearance since August 12, 2005 at HOU... made final appearance June 14 at STL, allowing three hits and four runs in 2.0 innings... went 3-4, 6.66 (36 ER / 48.2 IP) in nine starts for Tacoma during the regular season... placed on 7-day disabled list August 5-September 7 with a right elbow strain... part of Tacoma's PCL Championship squad and appeared in three playoff games out of the bullpen (0-0, 4.15, 4.1 IP / 2 ER).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Acquired by Seattle in 2009 from Pittsburgh in a 7-player trade on July 29 along with Jack Wilson in exchange for infielder Ronny Cedeno, catcher/first baseman Jeff Clement, right-hander Aaron Pribanic, right-hander Nathan Adcock, and right-hander Brett Lorin... in final nine starts of season, went 5-1, 3.00 ERA (17 ER / 51.0 IP)... his 3.00 ERA from August 15 to the end of season ranked 8th-best in the AL... his five wins were tied for 6th-best... lost 9 of his first 11 decisions (w/ PIT & SEA) before winning five of his final six... in five-week span, was optioned (June 25) to Triple-A Indianapolis by Pittsburgh, traded (July 29) to Seattle, optioned (July 29) to Tacoma by Seattle and recalled (July 31) to the Majors... made first start with Mariners on August 2 at Texas, recorded a no-decision allowing three hits and two runs in 6.0 IP... charged with first career error September 26 at Toronto; had not made an error in 128 consecutive chances to begin his career... optioned to Indianapolis on June 25... struck out a career-high 17 batters, including an Indianapolis team record 13 straight batters to start the game in his first start with Indy on June 28 vs. Toledo (no-decision)... represented Puerto Rico in 2009 World Baseball Classic making two starts: March 9 vs. Netherlands (4.0 IP, 3H, 1 ER, 5K) & lost to Venezuela March 16 allowing one earned run in 4.0 IP

In 2008, agreed to terms on a five-year contract with Pirates, including club options for the 2011 and 2012 seasons on March 16... made first Opening Day start on March 31 in ATL and received a no-decision (6.0 IP, 4 ER)... struck out season-high 10 batters while picking up first win on April 6 at Florida... on the disabled list June 26 (retro to June 23)-July 8 with a strained right elbow... posted a 3.68 ERA (18 ER / 44.0 IP) in his last eight starts and a 3.67 ERA in five September starts.

Led Pirates staff in 2007 in ERA (3.76), strikeouts (177) and innings pitched (208.0)... shared lead in starts with Tom Gorzelanny... 177 K's were the most by a Pirate right-hander since Kris Benson (184 in 2000)... ranked 8th in the NL in strikeouts and ninth in innings pitched... 3.65 road ERA ranked ninth in the league and his 7.7 K / 9.0 IP ranked 10th... tied for league lead in wild pitches (12)... whiffed a career-high 11 batters in first start but came away with a no-decision (6.0 IP / 2 ER) April 3 at HOU... ranked fourth among NL pitchers with a 1.59 ERA through the end of April... tossed first career complete game, allowing one unearned run in 8-1 victory vs. TEX on July 13... ranked 5th among NL starters with a 2.93 ERA at the break... went 0-5 with an 8.31 ERA (24 ER / 26.0 IP) in his first five starts after the All-Star break, raising ERA to 3.91... posted a 1.64 ERA and surrendered just one home run in his final five starts (33.0 IP)... pitched at least 6.0 innings in 26 of his 32 starts and at least 7.0 frames 18 times.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Graduated from Caesar Rodney High School in Camden, Del., in 2000, where he played football, baseball and basketball... honored by the Delaware Sports Writers Association as its Athlete of the Year for 2006... became the 48th player from Delaware to appear in the Major Leagues when he made his debut in 2004... his 14 wins in 2006 were most by a Delaware right-hander since Huck Betts in 1934... played for Puerto Rico in the 2009 World Baseball Classic (step father is of Puerto Rican descent).
