## ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (28-24) AT MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (24-28)

REDBIRDS ROUT ISOTOPES 11-1: In a game that seemed over the minute it began, the Albuquerque Isotopes found themselves in a five-run hole after two innings and could never recover, ultimately falling 11-1 to the Memphis Redbirds on a hot and humid Wednesday night at AutoZone Park. For the second straight start, 'Topes right-hander John Ely struggled, giving up three runs in the very first inning. As a portend of things to come, Adron Chambers took the second pitch of the game from Ely and blasted it over the wall in right field for a lead-off homer that gave the 'Birds a quick 1-0 lead. Two batters later, Andrew Brown hammered a triple off the wall in right and was immediately picked up by a single from Mark Hamilton that extended the lead to 2-0 Memphis. Nick Stavinoha then smacked a double to left, scoring Hamilton and giving the Redbirds a 3-0 cushion after just one frame. Memphis tacked on two more runs in the very next inning when Redbirds starter Brandon Dickson led off the inning with a single and Chambers belted his second home run in as many at-bats to give the 'Birds a 5-0 cushion after just two innings. The 'Birds blew the game wide open in the fourth, scoring three more runs, all with two out, to grab a commanding 8-0 lead. Albuquerque's lone sign of life came in the top of the fifth, when Trent Oeltjen led off the frame by smashing a towering solo homer to center to trim the lead to 8-1. Memphis got the run right back in the bottom of the fifth, however, before adding insult to injury with two runs in the eighth to coast to an 11-1 win.

SEXTON IN CONTROL: Albuquerque will turn to young right-hander Tim Sexton to help try and stop the Isotopes' current three-game slide. One thing the 'Topes can be confident in is that Sexton will not do anything to beat himself. In 11 total innings-pitched in his Triple-A debut and out of a total of 46 batters faced, the right-hander has allowed just one walk while striking out seven. After an excellent first Triple-A start on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs, Sexton was solid in his next outing on May 28 at New Orleans, when he allowed four runs, three earned, on eight hits in five innings of an eventual 5-4 'Topes loss to the Zephyrs. The right-hander departed with the game tied 4-4 in the fifth, only to watch from the dugout as New Orleans plated a run in the eighth to win it.

**MEMPHIS BLUES:** With losses in each of the first games of their series against the Redbirds, the Isotopes have now dropped their last four games played in Memphis dating back to last year. The last time Albuquerque won at AutoZone Park was on May 29, 2010, when the 'Topes crushed the Redbirds 16-6. In their last 15 games in Memphis (including the 2009 playoffs), the 'Topes are 4-11.

TIME TO BREAK THE FUNK: Last night's defeat tied a season-high for consecutive losses set on May 10-12 when the 'Topes dropped three in a row in Las Vegas. The current road trip has turned into a trail of tears for the 'Topes, who have dropped five of the six games they've played since leaving the Duke City on May 27.

THE COLLECTOR: While his home run last night led off the inning, outfielder Trent Oeltjen has been making a habit of coming through in the clutch, namely when there are runners in scoring position and two outs. Oeltjen is batting a robust .444 (8x18) with two triples, a homer, and eight RBI when there are men in scoring position and two away.

**NEXT HOMESTAND JUST A WEEK AWAY:** The 'Topes are back in town next Thursday for an action-packed four-game homestand as the Nashville Sounds make their first trip to the Duke City in 2011. On tap are the first and only visit by Myron Noodleman on Friday, June 10, a spectacular post-game fireworks show on Saturday, June 11, and a tote bag giveaway on Sunday, June 12!

**TODAY'S START:** Right-hander Tim Sexton makes his third career Triple-A starts after a no-decision on May 28 at New Orleans when he allowed four runs, three earned, on eight hits while walking one and striking out four in a 5-4 Isotopes loss.

Enjoyed an excellent outing in his debut with the Isotopes on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs when he pitched six strong innings, allowing one run (an Ian Stewart solo homer) on just three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 Albuquerque win.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20.

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played a second full season at Single-A Inland Empire in 2009, going 8-14 with a 3.96 ERA (69 ER / 157.0 IP) in 27 games (22 starts)... tied for the club lead with eight wins and 22 starts... ranked third on the team with a career-high 100 strikeouts... tossed a career-high 157 innings, tops in the Dodger organization and second in the California League... selected to the California League mid-season All-Star Team, posting a 3.21 ERA (27 ER / 75.2 IP) in 13 games (10 starts) before the All-Star break... won the July Dodger Pride Award for Inland Empire, going 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA (14 ER / 36.1 IP) in six July starts... threw 7.0 innings or more in seven of his outings.

Spent the full 2008 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 5-12 with a 6.04 ERA (95 ER / 141.2 IP) in 28 games (26 starts)... struck out 92 while walking 36 in his 141.2 innings... named California League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 14-20 when he went 2-0 with an 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP).

Began his professional career in 2007 with Single-A Great Lakes, going 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP) in five games (no starts)... rated as the 24th best prospect in the Dodger organization and as having the fifth-best pro debut among all Junior College players from the 2007 draft by *Baseball America*
