ISOTOPES SUCCUMB TO IOWA IN 8-5 DEFEAT: The Albuquerque Isotopes saw a late lead disappear thanks to a seventh-inning, four-run rally by the Iowa Cubs that ultimately lifted the visitors to an 8-5 win on a Father's Day Sunday at Isotopes Park. With the 'Topes clinging to a 5-3 lead, a two-out single from Bryan LaHair plated a pair to tie the contest at 5-5. Marquez Smith then came up and was hit by a pitch from Albuquerque reliever Merkin Valdez, who then threw a wild pitch that moved the runners to second and third. Brad Snyder then hit a grounder to 'Topes shortstop Justin Sellers, but the normally sure-handed fielder's throw to first drew Jay Gibbons off the bag and allowed not only Snyder to reach but LaHair to score as well. A quick throw home to try and stop Smith from scoring went wide of catcher Damaso Espino, allowing the Cubs to take a 7-5 lead. Iowa tacked on one more run in the top of the ninth with a solo home run from Bobby Scales. Albuquerque tried to mount a comeback in its half of the ninth, as Ivan De Jesus, Jr. hit a two-out triple to right field and Gibbons walked to put runners on the corners. But Iowa closer John Gaub managed to induce a ground out from Jerry Sands to seal the 8-5 I-Cubs win.

EVELAND ROCKS!: Isotopes ace Dana Eveland should probably be pictured on Wikipedia in the entry on "Quality Starts." The left-hander has got an incredible string of seven straight outings in which he's authored a quality start, which by definition is six innings of work while not allowing more than three earned runs. Over the course of that "quality" streak, Eveland is 3-1 with an ERA of 3.00 (15 ER / 45.0 IP). His only loss in that span was of the hard-luck variety and came in his last outing at Oklahoma City on June 15, when he allowed just two runs on five hits in six innings of work while walking four and striking out six, but still ended up on the short end of a 2-1 'Topes loss. The last time Eveland failed to work through the sixth and gave up more than three earned runs was way back on May 8 in a loss to Memphis.

BASEBALL FOR BREAKFAST: Today's 11:05 AM start is the second pre-noon first pitch the Isotopes have had this season, with the first one also coming against Iowa on April 14 (a 10-6 'Topes loss to the I-Cubs). After today, Albuquerque will have just two more day home games this entire season, July 25 vs. New Orleans and August 21 vs. Memphis. The Isotopes have prevailed in four of their last six day games, advancing their record in the sunshine to 7-7.

SECOND TO NONE: While it paled in comparison to the 11-spot they put up on Saturday, with the Isotopes' second-inning run in last night's loss, Albuquerque is outscoring Iowa 18-1 in the second inning this series. On the season, the 'Topes have outscored the opposition in the second stanza 73-46, with the most total runs they've scored in any one frame all season coming in the second

CAN'T STOP IVAN: The Isotopes' hottest hitter continues to be Ivan De Jesus Jr., who has racked up hits in a season-high seven straight games, but has been especially hot in his last four contests, all multi-hit performances in which he's racked up 10 hits in 18 at-bats (.556 average). He's also been an extra-base machine, doubling in each of his last four games and in five of his last six while adding a triple last night. De Jesus has also been getting it done batting out of the second position in the lineup, racking up a .355 (33x93) with 12 runs, eight doubles, and 14 RBI in 22 games batting out of the two-hole.

A SERIES-OUS STREAK: With a win today, the Isotopes would be victorious in their fifth straight series played at Isotopes Park. The last time Albuquerque split a set at The Lab was on May 2-5, when they took two of four from Omaha. This season, the 'Topes are 6-0-2 in home four-game series.

'TOPES BIG HOMESTAND CONTINUES: Albuquerque's big eight-game homestand continues with matinee baseball today before the Oklahoma City RedHawks come into town for their first visit to Isotopes Park this season. On tap for Tuesday is an Adult Fun Run, where adults can let loose their inner child and run the bases after the game.
