OKLAHOMA CITY REDHAWKS (30-43) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (42-30)

KEISLER FANS 10 AS 'TOPES ROLL, 11-4: Pitcher Randy Keisler's 10 strikeouts, as well as a big night from the offense, helped the Albuquerque Isotopes win the first of a four-game set with the Oklahoma City RedHawks, 11-4 on Tuesday at Isotopes Park. Keisler took over in the second inning for starter and Dodgers closer Jonathan Broxton, who threw the first inning to start his Major League rehabilitation assignment while coming back from bone bruise in his right elbow. Broxton spotted the RedHawks a run in the first on a walk and a double, but collected two strikeouts in his one inning of work, throwing a total of 23 pitches before calling it a night. After the first, the game belonged to Keisler (4-2), who cruised through six innings, allowing just four hits and two walks while striking out 10 to claim his fourth straight victory in as many appearances. In addition to recording the most Ks by an Isotopes pitcher this season, Keisler paced Albuquerque pitchers to 15 punch-outs on the night, one shy of a franchise record. The Isotopes quickly climbed out of the early 1-0 hole and into the lead with a four-run burst in their half of the first. After scoring a run on a throwing error from Oklahoma City shortstop Anderson Hernandez, Albuquerque roped back-to-back-to-back RBI singles to take a 4-1 lead. The Isotopes increased the lead to 5-1 in the bottom of the third inning as Hoffmann muscled a 0-1 pitch over the wall in left field for a solo home run. An RBI groundout in the fifth extended the lead to 6-1 before the 'Topes tacked on three more in the sixth, one more in the seventh, and punctuated the night with Corey Smith's solo homer in the eighth to take an 11-1 lead on their way to the 11-4 win.

THE COMPLETE PITCHER: Right-hander John Ely takes the mound coming off his third win of the season while coming as close as you can get to a complete game without getting one. Ely worked into the ninth inning on June 17 vs. Iowa, and started the final frame with two strikeouts before the Cubs put two on thanks to a hit and an error, ending the right-hander's night just one out away from a PCL-leading third complete game and the second nine-inning complete game of Ely's season. The right-hander was bolstered in the contest by a team-record-tying 11-run second, easily pacing the Isotopes to a 13-10 win. The Isotopes record for complete games in a season is four, picked up by knuckleballer Charlie Haeger in 2009.

PHENOMINAL FIRST HALF: With 72 games in the books, the Isotopes have played exactly half of their scheduled 144-game

regular season slate and, with a record of 42-30, have easily posted their best first-half record in franchise history. 'Topes' best record through their first 72 games prior to this season was in 2005, when Albuquerque started the year 40-32. In the nine-year history of the Isotopes franchise, they've posted a winning record six times through the first half of the campaign.

DELIGHTFUL DOZEN: For the first time in 2011, the Isotopes are 12 games over .500, the team's high-water mark for the season. Albuquerque continues to be virtually unbeatable at Isotopes Park, posting a PCL-best 26-11 record at home. In their last 22 games at The Lab, the 'Topes have gone an unbelievable 17-5.

TRAY TERRIFIC: Not only has Trayvon Robinson collected a hit in six straight games, a span in which he's batting .500 (11x22) with eight runs, a double, a homer, and four RBI, he's also displaying patience at the plate in the form of walks. Last night, Robinson coaxed a season-high three free passes, reaching base in all five of his plate appearances on the evening (he also had a double and a single). In fact, in 22 total plate appearances this homestand, Robinson has reached base 14 times, an on-base percentage of 636

Had a brief call-up to the Dodgers that saw him make his first Major League relief appearance (and the second relief outing at all since his first professional year in 2007 at Rookie-level Great Falls) on June 5 at Cincinnati. Ely entered the game in relief of Chad Billingsley in the sixth inning with the Dodgers leading 9-4 and worked three innings, allowing two runs on three hits while walking two and striking out four in a 9-6 Dodgers win. If he had worked the ninth, Ely would have been in line to earn his first

TODAY'S START: John Ely makes the start coming off a near-complete game on June 17 vs. Iowa when he pitched 8.2 innings, allowing nine runs (seven earned) on 11 hits while walking one and striking out a season-high eight in a 13-10 Isotopes win.

Had a dominating nine-inning, complete-game win vs. Reno on May 22, just the 10th nine-inning complete game thrown by an Isotope at home in franchise history and the first nine-inning complete game in Ely's career. Ely allowed one run (on a Cody Ransom homer) on just three hits while walking one and striking out seven in a 3-1 'Topes win. Both of the right-hander's first two wins came in complete-game performances.

Nearly threw a no-hitter in the second game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20. Ely took a no-hitter into the seventh and final inning, striking out the first two batters he faced before giving up a double to Marquez Smith. The right-hander got the next batter to preserve the complete-game shutout, the first of his career. Made a spot start for the Dodgers on April 10 at San Diego where he allowed four runs on six hits in 5.2 innings while walking three and striking out five in a 7-2 loss to the Padres. With the defeat, Ely has dropped each of his last six Major League decisions dating back to last year

2010: Rookie right-hander made his Major League debut, going 4-10 with a 5.49 ERA in 18 starts over three stints with the Dodgers... struck out 76 and walked just 40 in 100.0 innings... had his contract purchased from Albuquerque on April 28 and made his Major League debut that day, allowing five runs over 6.0 innings and taking the loss in the Dodgers' 7-3 defeat at New York (NL).. picked up his first big league victory on May 11 at Arizona, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings in the Dodgers' 13-3 win... won both of his next two starts against Houston and Detroit for a season-long three-game winning streak and finished the month of May with a 3-1 record and a 2.18 ERA (8 ER / 33.0 IP) in five starts... made six straight quality starts from May 6 to June 1, which were the most consecutive quality starts for a Dodger rookie since Hideo Nomo's 12 straight from May 17 to July 20, 1995... started his career without allowing a home run in his first 50.1 innings over eight games, which was the longest run by a Dodger pitcher to start a career since Fernando Valenzuela went 82.2 frames without allowing a big fly from September 15, 1980 to the third inning of a game vs. Montreal on May 14, 1981... faced 89 consecutive batters without allowing a walk between April 28 and May 22... was the longest streak for any Dodger rookie since Dave Stewart had a 93-batter streak in 1981... lost his final five decisions of the season, posting an 11.01 ERA (31 ER / 25.1 IP) over his final six starts... ranked among the NL rookie leaders in starts (18, T-5th), innings (100.0, 8th), strikeouts (76, T-10th) and opponents' batting average (.276, 8th)... was 5-4 with a 6.22 ERA (61 ER / 100.0 IP) in 13 starts with Albuquerque.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: John Ely... attended Miami (Ohio) University... went 26-7 with a 3.07 ERA in his three-year collegiate career... ranks second in school history with 284 career strikeouts and tied for fifth with 26 wins... in 2007 as a junior, was a unanimous first-team all-Mid-American Conference selection... as a sophomore, tied for the Miami University club lead with eight victories and earned All-MAC honors... in 2005 as a freshman, named All-MAC second team, tying for the conference lead with 10 wins and leading the league with 108 strikeouts... tossed a league-high six complete games, including four consecutive starts from March 23 to April 17... also selected to the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America team... compiled a 27-5 career record at Homewood-Flossmoor High School, including one perfect game...selected first-team all-state as a high school senior in 2004 and also lettered in cross country.
