ISOTOPES COMEBACK FALLS SHORT IN 5-4 LOSS: The Albuquerque Isotopes attempted a late comeback but ultimately fell to the Oklahoma City RedHawks, 5-4, on Wednesday night at Isotopes Park. Down 5-2 in the eighth inning, the Isotopes clawed to within one run when infielder Justin Sellers roped a lead-off single, setting up Joe Becker, who blasted a two-out, two-run homer into the bullpen in left-center that trimmed the lead to 5-4. Jamie Hoffmann gave the 'Topes faithful added hope with a bloop single that put the tying run on board, but RedHawks dominant closer David Carpenter struck out Jerry Sands to end the threat. That would prove to be as close as the Isotopes would get, as Carpenter continued his mastery in the ninth, retiring Albuquerque in order to seal the 5-4 win.

ANOTHER START FOR BROX: Dodgers rehabbing closer Jonathan Broxton will again make the start tonight, but like his outing on Tuesday, will only pitch the first inning and is not to exceed 25 pitches. In his first rehab appearance the hard throwing righty fired the first frame on June 21 and allowed one run on a walk and a double while striking out two. Most importantly, Broxton seemingly effortlessly hovered around 94-97 mph on the radar gun and emerged from the outing feeling good. This will most likely be Broxton's final rehab appearance for the Isotopes.

SEXTON LOOKS TO BOUNCE BACK: After Broxton's inning of work, right-hander Tim Sexton, today's scheduled starter, will take over looking to rebound from the first tough outing in his young Triple-A career. After five straight superb starts and three straight wins, Sexton was touched for 10 runs, seven of them earned, on 13 hits in just 3.2 innings in a start on June 18 against the Iowa Cubs. The right-hander was bailed out by his offense, however, as the 'Topes scored a team-record 11 runs in the second ining en route to a 13-10 win, leaving Sexton with a no-decision. The outing was truly an anomaly so far this season for the righty, who had given up a totaol of 11 runs (10 earned) in each of his other five starts combined before allowing the 10 to the Cubs.

DEEP IN THE 'PEN: The Isotopes currently boast an embarrassment of riches in their bullpen thanks to the arrival yesterday of righty Ramon Troncoso, who was optioned to Albuquerque when Hong-Chih Kuo came off the Disabled List. Troncoso's return to

Triple-A was really just a function of depth among Dodgers relievers and not performance, as the right-hander posted a 3.68 ERA (6 ER / 14.2 IP) in 10 appearances with LA since joining them on May 19, with four runs coming in one outing at Colorado on June 12. The 'Topes bullpen now consists of eight pitchers.

BONO WOULD BE JEALOUS OF 'TOPES' "ONE": Last night's 5-4 loss was just the second one-run defeat the 'Topes have suffered at home all season and the first since a 10-9 defeat to New Orleans way back on April 24. As they have all season, the Isotopes have continued to be dominant in one-run contests in June, going 5-2 with both of their losses coming at the hands of the RedHawks (a hard-luck 2-1 defeat on June 15 at OKC and then last night). On the year, Albuquerque still boasts the best one-run record in the PCL at 18-7.

YOU CAN'T VANQUISH VELEZ: Eugenio Velez continues to display the consistency that would make a metronome envious. The versatile infielder / outfielder has collected hits in each of his last seven games,batting .406 (13x32) with seven runs and nine RBI in that span. He's also thrived in the leadoff role since the departure of Dee Gordon, batting .338 (25x74) with 15 runs in 17 games.

'TOPES BIG HOMESTAND CONTINUES: Albuquerque's series with the Oklahoma City Redhawks rolls on with a pair of great promotions. Tonight, the team will be giving away their annual team poster, a must-have for collectors and fans of all ages. TODAY'S START: Right-hander Tim Sexton takes the mound looking to rebound from his most difficult outing of the season on June 18 vs. Iowa when he lasted just 3.2 innings, allowing season-highs in hits (13), runs (10) and earned runs (seven). Earned a no-decision thanks in part to an 11-run second inning by the 'Topes en route to a 13-10 Isotopes win.

Won his third straight start on June 13 at Oklahoma City when he pitched 6.0 innings, allowing two runs no eight hits while walking one and striking out two in a 4-3 'Topes win. Earned his first career Triple-A win, a 5-4 triumph at Memphis on June 2 when he allowed two runs on six hits in five innings while walking two and striking out three.

Enjoyed an excellent outing in his debut with the Isotopes on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs when he pitched six strong innings, allowing one run (an Ian Stewart solo homer) on just three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 Albuquerque win.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20.

2010: Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Played a second full season at Single-A Inland Empire in 2009, going 8-14 with a 3.96 ERA (69 ER / 157.0 IP) in 27 games (22 starts)... tied for the club lead with eight wins and 22 starts... ranked third on the team with a career-high 100 strikeouts... tossed a career-high 157 innings, tops in the Dodger organization and second in the California League... selected to the California League mid-season All-Star Team, posting a 3.21 ERA (27 ER / 75.2 IP) in 13 games (10 starts) before the All-Star break... won the July Dodger Pride Award for Inland Empire, going 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA (14 ER / 36.1 IP) in six July starts... threw 7.0 innings or more in seven of his outings.

Spent the full 2008 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 5-12 with a 6.04 ERA (95 ER / 141.2 IP) in 28 games (26 starts)... struck out 92 while walking 36 in his 141.2 innings... named California League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 14-20 when he went 2-0 with an 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP).

Began his professional career in 2007 with Single-A Great Lakes, going 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP) in five games (no starts)... rated as the 24th best prospect in the Dodger organization and as having the fifth-best pro debut among all Junior College players from the 2007 draft by *Baseball America*.
