ISOTOPES DROP THIRD STRAIGHT TO 'HAWKS, 11-7: The Albuquerque Isotopes spotted the Oklahoma City RedHawks a six run lead early and ended up futilely chasing the 'Hawks the rest of the night, falling 11-7 in a series-ending loss Friday night at Isotopes Park. Oklahoma City quickly took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning on a Collin DeLome one-out solo home run and quickly added to the advantage with five runs in the second that gave the visitors a 6-0 cushion after just an inning and a half. Albuquerque quickly got to work trying to erase the deficit in the bottom of the second on a two-out RBI single from Justin Sellers that cut the gap to 6-1. The home team then roared back into the game with a four-run surge in the third. Eugenio Velez started off with a single, which was followed by an RBI double from Ivan De Jesus, Jr., cutting the lead to 6-2. Jerry Sands then ripped a two-run homer to pull Albuquerque within 6-4. That brought Trayvon Robinson up to bat, and the outfielder responded with a solo home run that sliced Oklahoma City's lead down to one run, 6-5. Unfortunately for the 'Topes, that would be as close as they would get to the RedHawks for the rest of the night. Oklahoma City took a 7-5 lead in the top of the fourth on a one-out, solo homer from Esposito and tacked on another run in the fifth that made the score 8-5. After Oklahoma City scored another in the sixth, Albuquerque answered with another long-ball, this one a solo blast from Sellers that drew Albuquerque to within 9-6. Again, the teams traded runs in the eighth, this time by swapping home runs. A pinch-hit solo homer by Drew Locke gave the 'Hawks a 10-6 advantage before Sands hammered his second home run of the game, a laser to left, to make the score 10-7 Oklahoma City. A miraculous comeback was not in the offing, however, as the 'Hawks scored one final time in the top of the ninth to cruise to a 11-7 win.

THE REMATCH: Lefty Dana Eveland takes the mound in a pitching match-up that is exactly the same as the one five days ago, when the 'Topes ace dueled Iowa righty Ramon Ortiz at Isotopes Park on June 20. In that contest, it was Eveland that got the upper hand, getting a victory after pitching seven innings in which he allowed three runs, two of them earned, on nine hits while walking two and striking out six. Not only did the triumph give him his seventh victory of the season, tied for the second-most in the PCL. Eveland is now 2-1 with a 3.60 ERA (8 ER / 20.0 IP) in four starts against the Iowa Cubs. We're roughly just half-way through the season and already Eveland is closing in on a career-high in wins. In 2005, the left-hander won 10 games for Double-A Huntsville in just 18 starts. The southpaw recorded nine wins for the Oakland A's in 2008 and had eight wins for Sacramento in 2009, the only seasons in which he'd recorded more victories than he

ONE LAST TIME: Albuquerque heads to Des Moines for the final time in 2011 to begin the final regular season series the 'Topes will play against the Cubs this year. It's been a season set that has been dominated by the home team, with the Isotopes going 6-2 in eight games at Isotopes Park and 1-3 in four games at Principal Park. After this series, Iowa will be the first American Conference team against whom the 'Topes have wrapped up their 16-game season series in 2011.

TURN ON THE POWER: The Isotopes arrive in Des Moines having rediscovered their power stroke. In four games over the just completed series against Oklahoma City, the 'Topes belted 10 homers, a season-high for a four-game set. Leading the charge is still Trayvon Robinson, who hit his team-leading 17th dinger last night and has five in the month of June. Jerry Sands has also been cranking it up, blasting three homers in his last three games, including two last night.

SUPER SELLS: When the calendar page flipped over from May to June, infielder Justin Sellers was batting .187 with 17 hits in 91 at-bats. In the 21 games since that day, Sellers is batting .377, with 23 hits in his last 61 at-bats. He also is enjoying a season-high eight game hitting streak in which he's hit a robust .433 (13x30) with eight runs, three doubles, a homer, and five RBI.

A BUSY WEEK FOR LO: Congratulations to Isotopes manager Lorenzo Bundy, who has been selected to coach for the World Team in the 2011 XM Satellite Radio All-Star Futures Game, part of Major League All-Star festivities in Phoenix, Arizona. The game will match a team of prospects from the US against their counterparts from other countries and will be played at Chase Field on Sunday, July 10 at 3:00 pm. After the Futures Game, Bundy will then head to Salt Lake City, UT to serve as manager of the PCL squad in the Triple-A All-Star Game on Wednesday, July 13.

TODAY'S START: Lefty Dana Eveland makes the start coming off his seventh
victory of the season, second most in the PCL, after getting the win on June 20 vs.
Iowa when he pitched seven innings, allowing three runs, two earned, on nine hits
while walking two and striking out six in a 4-3 'Topes win. Won his team-high
sixth game on June 3 at Memphis, going seven innings in which he allowed two
runs on five hits while walking one and striking out four in a 3-2 'Topes win.
Earned his fifth win of the season on May 29 at New Orleans when he allowed three
runs on four hits while walking one and striking out eight in a 6-5 win, the 'Topes'
only victory in that series. Had a complete game performance in which he allowed
three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on
April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out
a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an
Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits
in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against righthanders... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / $26.0\ \text{IP})$ in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation...compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
