# ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (29-24) AT MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (24-29)

ISOTOPES FEND OFF REDBIRDS FOR 5-4 WIN: The Albuquerque Isotopes built a lead and repelled two significant late-inning threats by the Memphis Redbirds for an exciting 5-4 white-knuckle win Thursday night at AutoZone Park. Albuquerque grabbed a quick lead in the top of the second thanks to a lead-off homer by Trent Oeltjen, his second in as many nights, to seize a 1-0 advantage. The Redbirds answered with a run in the bottom of the frame to tie the game, but the Isotopes roared ahead with three tallies in the fifth. With runners on the corners and two down, rehabbing Dodger Marcus Thames smashed a double to center, scoring both base runners and giving Albuquerque a 3-1 lead. Oeltjen then added his second RBI on the evening with a double to right that easily plated Thames and extended the advantage to 4-1. Memphis started chipping away thanks to a homer in the bottom of the fifth, but Albuquerque responded with a crucial insurance tally in the seventh. J.D. Closser started the frame with a ground-rule double to right-center. After a single by Dee Gordon put runners on the corners, Eugenio Velez knocked a base hit to left, plating Closser and putting the 'Topes ahead 5-2. Albuquerque would need every bit of that insurance, as the 'Birds plated a run in the seventh to make the score 5-3 and scored once more in the ninth to draw within a run at 5-4. With the tying run on third and the winning run on second with two out in the ninth, Jon Link struck out Matt Carpenter to end the game and preserve the Isotopes win.

WINNING WITH EVE: Lefty Dana Eveland takes the mound having established himself as Albuquerque's go-to guy when a win is needed. In his last outing, Eveland delivered the Isotopes their only win in four games in New Orleans after holding the Zephyrs to three runs on four hits in four innings while walking one and striking out eight. The triumph was Eveland's fifth of the year, tops on the 'Topes and tied for third most in the PCL. In fact, Albuquerque has won three of the last four games that Eveland has started dating back to May 13 and the only game the 'Topes lost in that span is one they should've won. When Eveland departed a start on May 24 against Colorado Springs, he had a 6-3 lead, but the Sky Sox plated two in the seventh and 10 in the ninth to win 15-6. Of the team-high 10 games the lefty has started this season, the Isotopes have won six.

**DOUBLE THE FUN:** With a season-high-tying six doubles last night, the Isotopes no longer have the fewest doubles in the Pacific Coast League. Albuquerque entered last night's game with 83 two-baggers on the season, one behind Memphis' 84 for the fewest in the league. The last time the 'Topes hit more than one double in a game prior to last night was when they hit three in the series opener at New Orleans on May 27.

CLOSING TIME: After not having a definitive closer for most of the season, Jon Link has settled nicely into that role over the last few weeks. Since May 17, Link has earned saves in all four of his chances, surpassing the injured Roman Colon for the most on the team with four.

**SPLITS-VILLE:** With a win tonight, the Isotopes would salvage a series spit in four games with the Redbirds, their first series split since the 'Topes took two of four games at Tucson on May 14-17. So far this season, the Isotopes have won seven series, lost just three, and split three.

**NEXT HOMESTAND JUST A WEEK AWAY:** The 'Topes are back in town next Thursday for an action-packed four-game homestand as the Nashville Sounds make their first trip to the Duke City in 2011. On tap are the first and only visit by Myron Noodleman on Friday, June 10, a spectacular post-game fireworks show on Saturday, June 11, and a tote bag giveaway on Sunday, June 12!

**TODAY'S START:** Left-hander Dana Eveland makes the start coming off his team-high fifth win of the season on May 29 at New Orleans when he allowed three runs on four hits while walking one and striking out eight in a 6-5 win, the 'Topes' only victory in that series. Had a complete game performance in which he allowed three runs on five hits and lost. In the first game of a doubleheader at Iowa on April 20, Eveland held the Cubs to just three runs in six innings while striking out a season-high eight, but ended up on the short end of a 3-1 'Topes loss. Earned an Opening Day win on April 7 when he allowed four runs, two earned, on seven hits in 5.1 innings while walking two and striking out four in a 10-5 'Topes triumph.

2010: Began the season on Toronto's Opening Day roster and combined to go 3-5 with a 6.79 ERA in 12 games (10 starts) with the Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates... traded twice in 2010; acquired by Toronto from Oakland on February 6 for a player to be named later or cash consideration and again on June 1, when he was dealt to Pittsburgh for RHP Ronald Uviendo... opened the season with Toronto, going 3-4 with a 6.45 ERA (32 ER / 44.2 IP) in nine starts before getting traded to Pittsburgh on June 1... in his three victories, posted a 0.89 ERA (2 ER / 20.1 IP) and a .149 opponents' batting average (10x67)... allowed just two earned runs over his first 13.1 innings-pitched to start the season (1.35 ERA) and earned wins in each of his first two starts (April 10 at Baltimore; April 15 vs. Chicago (AL))... threw seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and four walks while striking out three in a 2-0 Blue Jays win at Chicago (AL) on May 6... went 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER / 9.2 IP) in three games (one start) with the Pirates before getting designated for assignment on June 24 and was outrighted to Triple-A Indianapolis on July 1... was 0-2 with a 7.96 ERA (23 ER / 26.0 IP) in 11 games (five starts) with Indians... traded to the Jays from Oakland in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations on February 6.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Began and finished the 2009 season in the Oakland A's starting rotation, but spent most of the year at Triple-A Sacramento... was 2-4 with a 7.16 ERA in 13 games, nine starts, over three stints with Oakland and 8-6 with a 4.94 ERA in 21 starts with Sacramento... allowed a .365 batting average with Oakland, which was the highest mark of his five seasons in the majors... yielded a .373 (19x51) average against left-handed hitters and .362 (51x141) against right-handers... went 2-1 with a 5.31 ERA and .318 opponents' batting average in five games in Oakland and 0-3 with an 8.75 ERA and .402 opponents batting average in eight games on the road... allowed all four of his home runs on the road and at night... was 2-3 with a 7.65 ERA in his nine starting assignments and 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA in four relief appearances...with Sacramento, won four consecutive starts from June 7 to June 23, posting a 2.42 ERA (7 ER / 26.0 IP) in that span.

With the exception of a two and a half week stay at Triple-A Sacramento in August, spent the entire 2008 season in the Oakland starting rotation...compiled a 9-9 record and a 4.34 ERA in 29 starts... led the A's in strikeouts (118), hits allowed (172) and hit batters (12), tied for the lead in wild pitches (6) and ranked second in wins, games started and innings pitched (168.0).

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Dana James Eveland...married...graduated from Palmdale (CA) High School... attended College of the Canyons... was the recipient of the 2008 Dave Stewart Community Service Award, which is given annually to an A's player for outstanding community work... younger brother, Kyle, a second baseman from Palmdale (CA) High School, was drafted by the Brewers in the 43rd round of the 2005 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
