**ISOTOPES NIP 'BIRDS 3-2:** For the second straight night, the Albuquerque Isotopes were able to hold on to a slim lead and withstand a ninth-inning surge by the Memphis Redbirds to earn a razor-thin 3-2 win Friday night at AutoZone Park. After both teams traded zeros for three innings, the Isotopes got on the scoreboard in the fourth with a two-out uprising. Rehabbing outfielder Marcus Thames started things off with a monstrous home run to left, the second of his rehab, that gave the 'Topes a 1-0 lead. The Isotopes kept the rally going with an RBI double by Russ Mitchell, propelling Albuquerque to a 2-0 lead. Memphis cut the lead in half with a homer by Pete Kozma in the fifth, but Albuquerque responded in kind with a long ball courtesy of John Lindsey in the sixth. With two out in the frame, the big first baseman crushed a towering shot that landed on the berm in left field, boosting the Isotopes lead to 3-1. Like they have all series, the Redbirds would not go quietly into the hot Memphis night. Freddie Bynum led off the seventh with a double, advanced to third on a groundout, and scored on another groundout to bring the home team back within a single run at 3-2. With Merkin Valdez on the mound in the ninth inning, the Redbirds made one last threat. After two quick outs, Donovan Solano singled up the middle and Daryl Jones walked, putting the tying run in the scoring position. The Isotopes would wriggle off the hook, however, as Valdez coaxed Bryan Anderson into a fly out to shallow left to preserve the 3-2 win.

**HARD LUCK REDDING:** Right-hander Tim Redding takes the mound coming off a start that typifies his season so far. On May 30 in New Orleans, Redding tossed a complete game and still ended up on the losing end of a 3-2 Zephyrs triumph. The right-hander allowed just three runs on six hits through a season-high eight strong innings in which he walked none and struck out three. In that contest, Redding surrendered two homers, continuing a recent of trend of susceptibility to the long ball. After allowing just one long ball in his first five starts (24.1 innings), the right-hander has conceded seven homers in his last five outings (31.2 innings), including five homers in his last three games.

**A TEXAS-SIZED SERIES:** For the first time in 2011, the Isotopes will face their arch-rivals the Round Rock Express in a series that could have long-lasting impact on the standings despite it being just the first week of June. The 'Topes enter the Lone Star state just a game and a half behind the Express in the PCL's American Southern Division, but Albuquerque will have its work cut for it in a tough place to play. All-time, the Isotopes are 19-29 at Dell Diamond after going 3-5 there last year. The Express, which are in their first year as top affiliate of the Texas Rangers, have been alone at the top of the division since April 15.

**ROSTER ROULETTE:** The 'Topes begin their big series with the Express having lost two players to the Dodgers. Starting pitcher John Ely and infielder Ivan De Jesus Jr. have joined Los Angeles today in Cincinnati, replacing Jon Garland and Rafael Furcal, who were placed on the DL with right-shoulder inflammation and a left oblique strain, respectively. Rehabbing outfielder Marcus Thames has also left the team to continue his rehab in Chattanooga with the Lookouts. The 'Topes bullpen did get some good news with the return of right-hander Travis Schlichting, who was Designated for Assignment on May 31, cleared waivers, and was outrighted to Albuquerque today.

**TELL US ABOUT ELLIS:** With a pair of walks last night, catcher A.J. Ellis has reached base in each of his last 14 games, batting .350 (14x40) over that span while drawing an incredible 17 walks.

**NEXT HOMESTAND RAPIDLY APPROACHING:** The 'Topes are back in town next Thursday for an action-packed four-game homestand as the Nashville Sounds make their first trip to the Duke City in 2011. On tap are the first and only visit by Myron Noodelman on Friday, June 10, a spectacular post-game fireworks show on Saturday, June 11, and a tote bag giveaway on Sunday, June 12!

**TODAY'S START:** Tim Redding makes the start coming off a complete game loss on May 30 at New Orleans when he pitched eight innings, allowing three runs on six hits while walking none and striking out three in a 3-2 'Topes loss. Earned his first win of the season on April 28 at Nashville, when he allowed just one run on just four hits in six innings while walking none and striking out three in a 5-1 'Topes win. Suffered his second loss on April 22 at Iowa when he allowed six runs, five earned, on a season-high 10 hits in four innings of a 7-2 fog-shortened, six-inning loss to the Cubs. Took the loss in his first outing on April 10 vs. Omaha when he yielded nine runs on eight hits in four innings while walking three and striking out five in a 9-6 'Topes loss.

Made an appearance in right field on April 13 vs. Iowa when the Isotopes ran out of position players due to injuries. Played three innings at the position but did not face any chances. Also made one appearance as a pinch-hitter on April 14 vs. Iowa (grounded out to third). Collected two hits in three at-bats on May 9 vs. Memphis.

**2010:** Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Rockies organization and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the New York (AL) organization... allowed just four home runs in 109.0 combined innings... opened the season with Colorado Springs, making five starts before his release on May 6... signed by the Yankees on May 13 and assigned to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre... in 13 games (12 starts) with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, limited opposing hitters to a .221 average (68x307), including a .189 mark against right-handers (30x159)... finished the season on a five-game winning streak, going 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA (4 ER / 43.1 IP) over six games (five starts) from July 4 to July 31... released by the Yankees on August 5 and finished the season with the Samsung Lions in the Korea Baseball Organization.

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Spent the 2009 season in New York (NL) organization, making 30 appearances (17 starts) for the Mets... made two starts in Spring Training on March 8 and March 12 before landing on the 15-Day Disabled List April 5th (retroactive to March 27th) with a strained right rotator cuff... had two rehabilitation starts (no decisions) with Triple-A Buffalo... made his Mets debut on May 18 at Los Angeles (NL) after being activated from the 15-Day DL earlier in the day... picked up his first hit in a Mets uniform, a single to right field in the fifth inning... picked up his first win as a member of the Mets on June 22 at home vs. St. Louis... tied his season-high with 7.0 innings and allowed 4 runs and 5 hits (the last Mets pitcher to go winless in his first six starts was Hideo Nomo in 1998)... moved to the bullpen after his start on July 2 in Pittsburgh.

Established career highs in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts with the Washington Nationals in 2008... following the season, had calcium deposit removed from the joint of his second toe on his left foot... finished tied for ninth in the NL with 33 starts... did not miss his turn in the rotation the entire season... matched his career-high in wins with 10 (also won 10 games for Houston in 2003)... became first Nats pitcher to record double figures in victories since the 2006 season... Washington went 20-13 in his starts... in his first start of the year, went 7.0 innings to beat the Phillies, 1-0, at Citizens Bank Park on April 2... established career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a 6-4 victory at Florida on April 18... threw career-best 8.0 innings, his first Major League complete game, in a 1-0 loss on July 24 at San Francisco.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Timothy James Redding... is married to Jaime with a daughter, Shea (11/13/01), and son, Brennan (9/15/03)... graduated from Monroe Community College in Rochester, NY, where his No. 17 jersey became the first in school history to be retired on Feb. 1, 2008... his great aunt, Joyce Randolph, played Trixie Norton on the Honeymooners.
