ROUND ROCK RIPS ISOTOPES 8-2: The Albuquerque Isotopes lost their starter to injury in the first inning and could never recover, falling 8-2 to the Round Rock Express on a scorching Sunday afternoon at The Dell Diamond. 'Topes left-hander Alberto Bastardo lasted just one third of a frame before spraining his left ankle backing up a play at third that forced him from the game. Things started well enough for the 'Topes, who scored a run in the top of the first when Dee Gordon led off the game with a single, advanced to third on a double by Eugenio Velez, and scored on a groundout off the bat of John Lindsey to give the visitors a 1-0 lead. Round Rock responded in the bottom of the inning with back-to-back one-out singles by Esteban German and Chris Davis that put runners on the corners. As Bastardo was racing over to back-up third base after Davis's knock, the pitcher turned his left ankle in foul territory near the third base line, ending his day after just nine pitches. Consummate utility pitcher Francisco Felix was rushed into action and took over with out in the first, immediately surrendering a double to Chad Tracy that scored German and tied the game at 1-1. Felix escaped further damage in the first inning, but the Express seized control of the contest with a four-run second, building a 5-1 advantage. Albuquerque would draw a bit closer in the fourth on a lead-off, solo homer by J.D. Closser, making the score 5-2, but Round Rock plated three more in the bottom of the frame to take a commanding 8-2 lead. That was plenty for Express starter Neil Ramirez who sailed through six frames, allowing two runs on four hits while walking none and striking out nine to claim the victory.

KEISLER BACK ON THE SPOT: Left-hander Randy Keisler makes his first start since April 21, a span in which he spent a month on the Disabled List before making three relief appearances for the 'Topes upon his return. In his last start, in Iowa, Keisler lasted just 2.2 innings before having to come out of the game with a strained right groin and hamstring. After rehabbing for a month in Arizona, Keisler returned to the Isotopes but as a reliever, making three appearances on the 'Topes current road trip and posting a solid 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP). Due to John Ely's call-up to the Dodgers, Keisler is thrust back into Albuquerque's rotation, where he went 0-2 with a 10.32 ERA (13 ER / 11.1 IP) in three starts to begin the season.

HOMER HAPPENINGS: Through 10 games on their current road trip, the Isotopes have hit 11 home runs, including a dinger in each of their last six games, but have been spreading the production around. Those 11 long balls have been accounted for by seven different players, with Trayvon Robinson leading the way with three. On the flip side, 'Topes pitchers have allowed home run in each of their last seven games, a season-high.

GETTING DEFENSIVE: After committing 31 errors in the month of May, fifth most in the PCL for the month, the Isotopes have started June with some sterling glove-work. Through five games, Albuquerque has only committed three errors, and the 'Topes have been spotless defensively in each of their last three contests.

CASE OF THE MONDAYS: While most of us are shaking out the cobwebs on Monday, the Isotopes have been at the top of their game. Albuquerque is 6-2 in games played on Monday, tied with Thursday's record of 6-2 for the team's day of the week. This will be the 'Topes fourth Monday game played on the road, where Albuquerque is 1-2 to start the work week.

NEXT HOMESTAND RAPIDLY APPROACHING: The 'Topes are back in town this Thursday for an action-packed four-game homestand as the Nashville Sounds make their first trip to the Duke City in 2011. On tap are the first and only visit by Myron Noodleman on Friday, June 10, a spectacular post-game fireworks show on Saturday, June 11, and a tote bag giveaway on Sunday, June 12!

TODAY'S START: Randy Keisler makes his first start since April 21 after over a month on the Disabled List and three appearances out of the 'Topes' bullpen.

Strained his right groin and hamstring in his last start on April 21 and was forced to leave the game, a 9-4 loss at Iowa, after just 2.2 innings. Placed on the Disabled List on April 23. Reinstated from the DL on May 24 and inserted into the Isotopes bullpen. Made three relief appearances in which he posted a 3.38 ERA (2 ER / 5.1 IP).

Roped a pinch-hit RBI double on April 18 in an 8-6 win at Oklahoma City.

Enjoyed a solid outing on April 9 vs. Omaha when he allowed two runs, one earned, on five hits in five innings while walking one and striking out two. He left the game with a 2-1 lead, but Omaha tied the game in the eighth and scored seven in the 10th to take a 10-4 victory. Signed a minor league contract with the Dodgers out of an open tryout at Spring Training on March 3.

2010: Split the season between two independent league teams and Laguna of the Mexican League... was 3-3 with a 3.98 ERA (19 ER / 43.0 IP) in seven starts for Laguna... pitched for Pensacola in the independent American Association, going 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER / 11.0 IP) in two starts... also spent time with Long Island in the independent Atlanic League, going 5-0 with a 3.65 ERA (20 ER 49.1 IP) in eight starts... struck out 43 while walking just 18 in 49.1 innings with the Ducks.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched for Southern Maryland in the independent Atlantic League in 2009, going 2-2 with a 6.89 ERA (24 ER / 31.1 IP) in six starts.

Signed a Minor League contract with the Minnesota Twins on January 11, 2008 but was released during Spring Training... signed on the Cubs and began the season with Triple-A Iowa, going 4-6 with a 3.14 ERA (23 ER / 66.0 IP) in 12 games (11 starts)... fanned 65 while walking 26 and allowed just four home runs in 66 innings.. opted out of his contract on June 10 and was signed by Baltimore.. went 2-3 with a 5.25 ERA (28 ER / 48.0 IP) in 10 games (nine starts) for Triple-A Norfolk... went a combined 6-9 with a 4.03 ERA in 20 starts between both Triple-A teams.

Began the 2007 season at Triple-A Memphis and was recalled to the St. Louis Cardinals on April 9... made four appearances, three starts, for St. Louis before being optioned on April 27... was 5-1 with a 2.52 ERA (11 ER / 39.1 IP) in six starts from June 10 to July 5... tossed six-plus innings on 16 consecutive starts from June 10 to September 2... recalled on July 27 but optioned again on July 31... outrighted to Memphis on September 6.

Starte the 2006 season at Triple-A Sacramento... won three consecutive starts, going 3-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER / 18.0 IP) from April 22 to May 2... contract was selected on May 12 and made 11 relief appearances with the A's before being optioned on June 9... had a four-game winning streak from July 4 to August 11... recalled on July 26 and optioned again on July 28... outrighted to Sacramento on August 8.

In 2005, began the season at Triple-A Louisville... named International Pitcher of the Week from April 18 to April 24... had his contract selected on May 23 and appeared in 24 games (four starts) for the Reds... was 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA (3 ER / 14.0 IP) in four appearances from May 24 to June 7... had career-high six strikeouts and homered off Mark Hendrickson for first Major League home run on June 7 vs. Tampa Bay... placed on Disabled List with left elbow inflammation from June 20 to July 15... did not allow a run in five of seven appearances from August 19 to September 20

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Randy Dean Keisler... was a 1994 graduate of Palmer (TX) High School after attending Navasota (TX) High School prior to his senior year... attended Louisiana State University and was named to the All-Southeastern Conference College World Series Team as a junior.. spent his first two collegiate seasons at Navarro (TX) Junior College... drafted by New York (AL) in the second round of the 1998 draft.
