**‘TOPES HAMMER EXPRESS, 11-0:** The Albuquerque Isotopes got six shutout frames from spot-starter Randy Keisler and five RBI from outfielder Trent Oeltjen in an 11-0 crushing of the Round Rock Express Monday night at The Dell Diamond. After the Isotopes plated a run in the second on a run-scoring double-play, Oeltjen blasted a two-run homer in the third to help Albuquerque take a 3-0 lead. The hit parade continued in the fourth when Justin Sellers laced a one-out double and came around to score two batters later on a two-out two-bagger by A.J. Ellis to increase the ‘Topes lead to 4-0. Red-hot Oeltjen then added an RBI single, plating Ellis and increasing the lead to 5-0 Isotopes. Albuquerque kept its foot on the throttle, scoring three more times in the sixth, all with two out. With the bases loaded and two down, John Lindsey drew an RBI walk before J.D. Closser administered a two-run single that gave the ‘Topes an 8-0 cushion. The Isotopes would put the cap on the offensive deluge in the seventh, thanks again to a big hit from Oeltjen. After back-to-back walks to Jamie Hoffmann and Sellers, Eugenio Velez hammered a double to right, scoring Hoffmann and increasing the advantage to 9-0. After a walk to Ellis, Oeltjen belted a ground-rule double to right, plating Sellers and Velez to send Albuquerque to a comfortable 11-0 win. With the offense doing its job, lefty Keisler was just as dominant, authoring six shutout frames in which he allowed just six hits and a walk while striking out four to claim his first win of the season in easily his best outing of the season.

**TURNAROUND TIM:** Right-hander Tim Sexton takes the mound looking to build off his first career Triple-A win on June 2 in Memphis when he worked five innings, allowing just two runs on six hits while walking two and striking out three in a 5-4 Isotopes win. Not only did the victory get Sexton on the board, the young right-hander’s performance essentially turned around the entire road trip. Prior to Sexton taking the hill at AutoZone Park, Albuquerque had started the road trip having lost five of six games, including three in a row leading up to Sexton’s start. The starter’s victory over the Redbirds ended up kicking off a three-game winning streak, the ‘Topes’ longest on the road this season.

**EVEN ODYSSEUS WOULD BE TIRED:** Tonight will be the last of an epic, season-high 12-game road trip through the hot, humid belly of the Pacific Coast League and given the way it started a week and a half ago, few would expect the ‘Topes to be playing for the division lead on the trip’s last day. After starting the trip 1-5, Albuquerque has since gone 4-1 and tonight has a chance to claim the team’s first road series win since a rain-shortened three-game set at Nashville on April 28-30 when the ‘Topes took two of three. If Albuquerque can pull off a victory tonight, they’ll be in sole possession of first place in the division for the first time since April 13.

**AWESOME AUSSIE:** In his last six games, Trent Oeltjen is batting .429 (9x21) with five runs, three doubles, three homers, and 10 RBI. With five runs driven in last night, Oeltjen became just the fourth Isotopes to knock in five tallies (Jerry Sands, Trayvon Robinson, and Damaso Espino are the others).

**WALKIN’ IN TEXAS:** A.J. Ellis continues to pile up the free passes with three walks in last night’s win, bringing his total in two games against the Express to four and his total on the current road trip to 10 in eight games. Last night in addition to his three walks, Ellis roped an RBI double, extending his current on-base streak to 17 games. The last time Ellis failed to reach base was way back on May 10. Since then, he’s batted .325 (15x46) with 21 walks.

**NEXT HOMESTAND RAPIDLY APPROACHING:** After a day off tomorrow, he ‘Topes are back in town Thursday for an action-packed four-game homestand as the Nashville Sounds make their first trip to the Duke City in 2011. On tap are the first and only visit by Myron Noodelman on Friday, a spectacular post-game fireworks show on Saturday, and a tote bag giveaway on Sunday!

**TODAY'S START:** Tim Sexton takes the mound coming off his first career Triple-A win, a 5-4 triumph at Memphis on June 2 when he allowed two runs on six hits in five innings while walking two and striking out three.

Enjoyed an excellent outing in his debut with the Isotopes on May 23 vs. Colorado Springs when he pitched six strong innings, allowing one run (an Ian Stewart solo homer) on just three hits while walking none and striking out three in a 5-4 Albuquerque win.

Spent the beginning of the year at Single-A Great Lakes, where he went 3-2 with a 3.64 ERA (19 ER / 47.0 IP). Went 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (2 ER / 11.0 IP) in his last two starts before getting promoted, May 11 vs. Lansing and the second game of a doubleheader on May 18 at Dayton. Struck out 49 while walking just 12 in his 47.0 innings of work with the Loons. All of his five home runs he surrendered with Great Lakes were hit by left-handed hitters, who batted .274 (23x84). Right-handers batted .202 (19x94) with three walks and 29 strikeouts. Transferred to Albuquerque on May 20.

**2010:** Split the year between Single-A Inland Empire and Double-A Chattanooga, going a combined 3-13 with a 5.50 ERA (79 ER / 129.1 IP)... went 3-12 with a 5.06 ERA (57 ER / 101.1 IP) in 25 games (14 starts) with Chattanooga... posted a 3.80 ERA (36 ER / 85.1 IP) in 21 games (10 starts) with the Lookouts before the All-Star Break... dropped seven straight decisions from June 18 to August 3... transferred to Inland Empire on August 10 and finished the year there, going 0-1 with a 7.07 ERA (22 ER / 28.0 IP) in five games (three starts).

**CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:** Played a second full season at Single-A Inland Empire in 2009, going 8-14 with a 3.96 ERA (69 ER / 157.0 IP) in 27 games (22 starts)... tied for the club lead with eight wins and 22 starts... ranked third on the team with a career-high 100 strikeouts... tossed a career-high 157 innings, tops in the Dodger organization and second in the California League... selected to the California League mid-season All-Star Team, posting a 3.21 ERA (27 ER / 75.2 IP) in 13 games (10 starts) before the All-Star break... won the July Dodger Pride Award for Inland Empire, going 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA (14 ER / 36.1 IP) in six July starts... threw 7.0 innings or more in seven of his outings.

Spent the full 2008 season at Single-A Inland Empire, going 5-12 with a 6.04 ERA (95 ER / 141.2 IP) in 28 games (26 starts)... struck out 92 while walking 36 in his 141.2 innings... named California League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 14-20 when he went 2-0 with an 0.75 ERA (1 ER / 12.0 IP).

Began his professional career in 2007 with Single-A Great Lakes, going 3-1 with a 3.57 ERA (9 ER / 22.2 IP) in five games (no starts)... rated as the 24th best prospect in the Dodger organization and as having the fifth-best pro debut among all Junior College players from the 2007 draft by *Baseball America*.

**PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS:** Timothy Edward Sexton... attended Miami-Dade CC in Florida... selected by the Dodgers in the 25th round of the 2007 draft.
