‘TOPES SEIZE FIRST PLACE WITH 6-3 WIN: For the first time since April 13, the Albuquerque Isotopes are alone in first place in the PCL's American Southern Division thanks to a 6-3 win over the Round Rock Express Tuesday night at The Dell Diamond. Albuquerque served notice early that it had designs on leap-frogging the Express, scoring a run in the top of the first when Eugenio Velez smacked the first pitch of the game for a lead-off triple and scored on an RBI groundout by Jamie Hoffmann to take a 1-0 lead. The Isotopes extended the advantage in the second, when Trayvon Robinson hammered a one-out solo homer to left, extending the score to 2-0 Albuquerque. The long ball served the ‘Topes in the fourth as well. John Lindsey led off the inning with a solo home run, only to be immediately followed by J.D. Closser, who smashed another homer to give the Isotopes their first back-to-back dingers of the 2011 season and a 4-0 lead. Round Rock finally got on the board in the bottom of the fifth, thanks to a two-run homer by Doug Deeds to instantly cut the ‘Topes’ lead to 4-2. Albuquerque would tack on a pair of key insurance runs in the eighth. After back-to-back singles by Velez and Hoffmann, Trent Oeltjen dropped a picture-perfect bunt down the third base line for a base hit that loaded the bases. Lindsey hit into a double-play that sent home Velez before Closser delivered a clutch, two-out single that plated Hoffmann and increased the lead to 6-2. The Express would mount one last furious rally in the bottom of the ninth, scoring a run on a bases-loaded walk to trim the score to 6-3, but that’s as far as the rally would get.

RIGHT SAID REDD: Tim Redding takes the mound looking to continue what has been a string of superb outings. In his last three starts, the righty has compiled a 3.60 ERA (8 ER / 20.0 IP) and in his last two outings, he’s posted an ERA of 3.21 (5 ER / 14.0 IP) while going 1-1 in that span. The record is a bit misleading, however, as Redding’s loss came in a complete-game gem in which he happened to be on the losing end. After allowing three runs in eight innings in a 3-2 Isotopes loss to the Zephyrs on May 30, Redding got the win in his last outing at Round Rock on June 4, allowing just two runs on seven hits in six innings of work to help Albuquerque to an 8-3 series-opening win over the Express. The bullpen is also a fan of Redding’s, as the starter has pitched through the sixth inning in seven of his last eight outings.

HOME COOKIN’: The PCL’s best home team returns to Isotopes Park, where the ‘Topes have gone 9-3 in their last 12, winning three straight series at The Lab.

SOUND OFF: For the first time in 2011, the Isotopes welcome the Nashville Sounds, Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, to Isotopes Park. The ‘Topes start the set with some momentum against the Sounds, having won two of three against them in the teams’ rain-shortened series in Nashville from April 28 to May 1 earlier this year. The Isotopes hope to use that momentum to turn around a losing record against Nashville at The Lab. With an all-time home record against the Sounds of 30-33, Nashville is the only PCL American Conference team against whom the ‘Topes are sub-.500 at home. Speaking of home, this series will be a home-coming of sorts for a trio of former Isotopes: Sounds pitching coach Rich Gale, who served the same capacity in Albuquerque from 2007-08, outfielder Brett Carroll, a fan favorite from 2007-08, and pitcher Frankie De La Cruz, who is starting the last game of this series on Sunday and set a then-franchise record with 13 wins in Albuquerque in 2008. Pitcher Daniel Herrera also played for the University of New Mexico from 2004-06.

LOOK WHO’S STREAKING AGAIN: With a team and season-high 16-game hitting streak already under his belt, Trayvon Robinson has now hit in 10 straight contests, batting .317 (13x41) with four homers and seven RBI over that span.

MEN OF ARMS: The ‘Topes can thank their pitching staff for their incredible turnaround in the last half of the just concluded road trip. In their last six games, Albuquerque pitchers have posted an ERA of 3.39 (20 ER / 53.0 IP) while Isotope starters have a 2.70 ERA (9 ER / 30.0 IP) in that span. Over the entire 12-game road trip, ‘Topes pitchers posted an ERA of 3.97 (45 ER / 102.0 IP).

A BIG, COMPACT, HOMESTAND: The ‘Topes are back in town for an action-packed four-game homestand that includes the first and only visit by Myron Noodleman tomorrow, a spectacular post-game fireworks show on Saturday, and a tote bag giveaway on Sunday!

TODAY'S START: Right-hander Tim Redding takes the mound coming off his second win of the season on June 4 in Round Rock, when he allowed just two runs on seven hits in six innings while walking two and striking out three in an 8-3 'Topes win. Suffered a complete game loss on May 30 at New Orleans when he pitched eight innings, allowing three runs on six hits while walking none and striking out three in a 3-2 'Topes loss. Earned his first win of the season on April 28 at Nashville, when he allowed just one run on just four hits in six innings while walking none and striking out three in a 5-1 'Topes win. Suffered his second loss on April 22 at Iowa when he allowed six runs, five earned, on a season-high 10 hits in four innings of a 7-2 fog-shortened, six-inning loss to the Cubs. Took the loss in his first outing on April 10 vs. Omaha when he yielded nine runs on eight hits in four innings while walking three and striking out five in a 9-6 'Topes loss.

Made an appearance in right field on April 13 vs. Iowa when the Isotopes ran out of position players due to injuries. Played three innings at the position but did not face any chances. Also made one appearance as a pinch-hitter on April 14 vs. Iowa (grounded out to third). Collected two hits in three at-bats on May 9 vs. Memphis.

2010: Combined to go 8-5 with a 2.89 ERA in 18 games (17 starts) with Triple-A Colorado Springs in the Rockies organization and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in the New York (AL) organization... allowed just four home runs in 109.0 combined innings... opened the season with Colorado Springs, making five starts before his release on May 6... signed by the Yankees on May 13 and assigned to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre... in 13 games (12 starts) with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, limited opposing hitters to a .221 average (68x307), including a .189 mark against right-handers (30x159)... finished the season on a five-game winning streak, going 5-0 with a 0.83 ERA (4 ER / 43.1 IP) over six games (five starts) from July 4 to July 31... released by the Yankees on August 5 and finished the season with the Samsung Lions in the Korea Baseball Organization.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the 2009 season in New York (NL) organization, making 30 appearances (17 starts) for the Mets... made two starts in Spring Training on March 8 and March 12 before landing on the 15-Day Disabled List April 5th (retroactive to March 27th) with a strained right rotator cuff... had two rehabilitation starts (no decisions) with Triple-A Buffalo... made his Mets debut on May 18 at Los Angeles (NL) after being activated from the 15-Day DL earlier in the day... picked up his first hit in a Mets uniform, a single to right field in the fifth inning... picked up his first win as a member of the Mets on June 22 at home vs. St. Louis... tied his season-high with 7.0 innings and allowed 4 runs and 5 hits (the last Mets pitcher to go winless in his first six starts was Hideo Nomo in 1998)... moved to the bullpen after his start on July 2 in Pittsburgh.

Established career highs in starts, innings pitched and strikeouts with the Washington Nationals in 2008... following the season, had calcium deposit removed from the joint of his second toe on his left foot... finished tied for ninth in the NL with 33 starts... did not miss his turn in the rotation the entire season... matched his career-high in wins with 10 (also won 10 games for Houston in 2003)... became first Nats pitcher to record double figures in victories since the 2006 season... Washington went 20-13 in his starts... in his first start of the year, went 7.0 innings to beat the Phillies, 1-0, at Citizens Bank Park on April 2... established career-high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings in a 6-4 victory at Florida on April 18... threw career-best 8.0 innings, his first Major League complete game, in a 1-0 loss on July 24 at San Francisco.

PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS: Timothy James Redding... is married to Jaime with a daughter, Shea (11/13/01), and son, Brennan (9/15/03)... graduated from Monroe Community College in Rochester, NY, where his No. 17 jersey became the first in school history to be retired on Feb. 1, 2008... his great aunt, Joyce Randolph, played Trixie Norton on the Honeymooners.
